

From the Pastor's Desk

III SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME. This Sunday marks the beginning of the reading of the third Gospel, that of Saint Luke, that will accompany us throughout this liturgical year. Giving a continuous and faithful reading of a Gospel offers us a rich perspective of the teaching, life and mission of Jesus. If you have a chance, do a gift to yourself, read it all at once. The evangelist Luke, who was not an apostle, mentions his **commitment to "having diligently investigated everything from the origins"** of what Jesus had said and done. Reading and listening to these pages allows us to grasp in depth and breadth the feelings of mercy that have moved the Lord Jesus and that still today move the heart of the Christian community. It is Jesus, full of mercy, who speaks to us every time we open the Gospel pages. We hear in today's gospel that it is Saturday and Jesus, "**according to his custom,**" goes to the synagogue. For almost thirty years he had participated in it. But what was about to happen was never seen it before. This time it is Jesus himself who comments on the passage from Isaiah where it says: "**The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim the Good News to the poor, has sent me to proclaim the release of the captives and the sight to the blind, to give freedom to the oppressed and proclaim a year of the Lord's grace.**" After reading, everyone has their eyes fixed on him. Jesus, with solemnity, comments: "**This Scripture that you have just heard has been fulfilled today.**" Jesus does not comment on the passage, he fulfills it! "**This Scripture has been fulfilled today.**" It is the **today of Nazareth** and today of all the places where the Gospel is proclaimed. Each time the Gospel is preached it should be said that this word becomes a reality of salvation for those who listen to it. **It is precisely the poor, the weak, the afflicted, the incarcerated, the migrants, the lame, the ones who need to hear:**

"**Today**" this Scripture that you had just heard has been fulfilled".

"**Today**" I am by your side! The Lord tells them all.

"**Today**" all Christian communities should say that this evangelical page becomes a reality of history.

"**Today**" we want to be more generous ...

"**Today**" we will work in all possible ways to stop wars and conflicts between peoples;

"**Today**" we strive so that the children stop being abandoned;

"**Today**" we strive for refugees to be welcomed;

"**Today**" the Gospel of mercy must travel the streets of the men and women of our day and raise a new hope for peace. "**Today**" disciples should let their hearts be touched by this Gospel and not leave to "**tomorrow**" the "**today**" of God's mercy, goodness and justice. May the anointing we have received in Baptism and Confirmation allow us to bear witness to the Today's gospel.

III DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO. Este domingo marca el comienzo de la lectura del tercero evangelio, el de San Lucas, que nos acompañara a lo largo de todo este año litúrgico. Dar una lectura continuada y fiel de un Evangelio nos ofrece una rica perspectiva de la enseñanza, vida y misión de Jesús. Si tienes chance, hazte este regalo. El evangelista Lucas, que no era un apóstol, menciona su empeño por "haber investigado diligentemente todo desde los orígenes" de lo que Jesús había dicho y hecho. Leer y escuchar estas páginas nos permite captar en profundidad y amplitud los sentimientos de misericordia que han movido al Señor Jesús y que todavía hoy edifican el corazón de la comunidad cristiana. Es Jesús, lleno de misericordia, quien nos habla cada vez que abrimos las páginas evangélicas. Escuchamos hoy, que es sábado y Jesús, "**según su costumbre**", acude a la sinagoga. Durante casi treinta años la había frecuentado. Pero nunca sucedió lo que estaba a punto de ocurrir. Esta vez es Jesús mismo quien comenta el pasaje de Isaías donde se dice: "**El Espíritu del Señor sobre mí, porque me ha ungido para anunciar a los pobres la Buena Nueva, me ha enviado a proclamar la liberación a los cautivos y la vista a los ciegos, para dar la libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar un año de gracia del Señor**". Terminada la lectura, todos tienen los ojos fijos en él. Jesús, con solemnidad, comenta: "**Esta Escritura que acabáis de oír se ha cumplido hoy**". ¡Jesús no comenta el pasaje, lo cumple! "**Esta Escritura se ha cumplido hoy**". Es el hoy de Nazaret y el hoy de todos los lugares donde se proclama el Evangelio. Cada vez que el Evangelio es predicado se debería decir que esa palabra se convierte en realidad de salvación para quien la escucha. **Son precisamente los pobres, los débiles, los afligidos, los encarcelados, los migrantes, los cojos, los que necesitan oír:**

"**Hoy**" se ha cumplido esta Escritura que acababan de oír".

"**Hoy**" ¡estoy a tu lado! Les dice el Señor a todos ellos.

"**Hoy**" Todas las comunidades cristianas deberían decir que esta página evangélica se convierte en realidad de la historia.

"**Hoy**" queremos ser más generosos...

"**Hoy**" trabajaremos de todas las formas posibles para que cesen las guerras y los conflictos entre pueblos;

"**Hoy**" nos empeñamos para que los niños dejen de estar abandonados;

"**Hoy**" nos empeñamos para que los refugiados sean acogidos;

"**Hoy**" el Evangelio de la misericordia debe recorrer las calles de los hombres y mujeres de nuestros días y suscitar una nueva esperanza de paz.

"**Hoy**" los discípulos deben dejarse tocar el corazón por este Evangelio y no dejar a "**mañana**" el "**hoy**" de la misericordia y de la bondad e justicia de Dios. Que la unción que hemos recibido en el Bautismo y Confirmación nos permita testimoniar el **Hoy** del evangelio

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Terza Domenica del T.O. — Anno “C” — «*Vangelo di Gesù Cristo secondo Luca*». Per cogliere il significato di queste parole bisogna innanzitutto rendersi conto che un vangelo è qualcosa di ben diverso da una raccolta di aneddoti relativi a Gesù e al suo insegnamento. Ogni evangelista è un testimone del figlio di Dio e si propone di rispondere alla domanda che affiora nell'animo di ogni uomo a cui è stato dato di incontrare Gesù, sia sentendo parlare di Lui, sia scoprendolo attraverso la vita di uno dei suoi discepoli: «*Signore, chi sei?*» Ciascuno di questi testimoni espone la propria fede nel Cristo sulla base di una storia—quella dei gesti e delle parole di Gesù, ma anche in funzione della propria esperienza e del proprio ambiente di vita. Per questo ogni evangelista ha una sua originalità, un suo accento diverso da quello degli altri. Ma solo una vera risposta personale è valida. Tuttavia c'è un solo vangelo, perché c'è un solo Cristo a cui rimandano tutte le Scritture. Un giorno, nella sinagoga di Nazareth, tocca a Gesù commentare la lettura della Legge. Che cosa dirà? Si metterà a fare dotte considerazioni sull'antichità del testo, sull'epoca in cui è stato redatto? Niente di tutto questo. Gesù afferma semplicemente: «*Oggi si è adempiuta questa Scrittura*». Colui nel quale «tutte le promesse di Dio sono divenute «sì» (2Cor. 1,20). Gesù non può leggere la parola divina senza metterla in pratica, senza realizzarla immediatamente. Fioriscono così i miracoli a favore dei poveri, dei prigionieri, dei ciechi, degli oppressi.

Anche noi non possiamo leggere il vangelo al passato. Dobbiamo leggerlo al presente, nell'oggi della nostra vita davanti a Dio. Allora anche il nostro tempo sarà «*un anno di grazia del Signore*».

Un popolo in festa — Per la prima volta dopo l'esilio, Israele di nuovo riunito come un popolo in festa celebra la liturgia della parola e prende parte in un pasto comune. Si trova qui la struttura tradizionale dell'assemblea liturgica. Il popolo viene convocato come in altri tempi a Sichem o a Gerusalemme, ma allora era per celebrare l'alleanza passata: oggi, il popolo è rivolto all'avvenire, a una gioia che il presente ancora non può offrire, col paese da ricostruire e le piaghe dell'esilio ancora aperte.
