

From the Pastor's Desk



**“They were amazed by His words,  
because He taught as one who has authority ....”**

This Sunday the evangelist Mark presents us the Good News of the Kingdom that Jesus came to proclaim. The ministry of Jesus impacts, because it comes, says the people, from a man who exercises his activities with power. We notice in this Sunday Gospel that Mark presents us the prototype of a **day of ministry of Jesus in Capernaum**. It tells us, it is a **day full of gestures, words, deeds, presences, liberations**, because we see that Jesus is not only **limiting Himself to some activities in words, rather to a mission**, which the evangelist stresses, **offers liberation** from physical, religious and social evil and suffering, that grips the person. Our **life as disciples of Christ**, therefore, should not be limited only to words and good promises, but also in the example of Jesus, rooted in our own lives of faith, **reach out in solidarity to the needy and vulnerables** to help, love, and be compassionate to them. **“Every time you did something to the least of my brothers, Jesus reminds us, you did it to me”**(Mt 25:40).



### Fr. Feccia's Reflection



**Quarta Domenica del T.O. anno "B"**— Gesù trascorre il sabato a Cafarnao con i suoi primi discepoli, e manifesta la sua autorità fuori del comune, insegnando e guarendo malati e ossessi. Così, fin dall'inizio del suo ministero, la sua fama si diffonde in quella terra di Galilea, che dopo la Pasqua diventerà il luogo della missione universale.

Gesù si reca nella sinagoga ed insegna. Dopo la catechesi della legge impartita da uno scriba, probabilmente Gesù ha letto un testo profetico e l'ha commentato, come a Nazaret (Lc. 4,16s) provocando stupore e ammirazione negli ascoltatori. A differenza degli scribi, che si preoccupano prima di tutto di spiegare la lettera del testo sulla base dei commenti dei loro maestri, Gesù si esprime come uno che sa di che cosa parla e non si limita a ripetere quello che gli è stato insegnato. Facendo riferimenti solamente a se stesso, si dimostra libero nei confronti della legge, che interpreta con autorità. La guarigione di un ossesso che interrompe con le sue grida, conferma la potenza del santo di Dio e non può che suscitare la domanda: Chi è mai costui? Chi è questo uomo?

Dobbiamo riconoscere che il racconto evangelico ci mette un po' in difficoltà. Oggi la medicina e la psicologia del profondo riconducono a un livello puramente patologico ciò che l'antichità attribuiva al mondo soprannaturale. L'indemoniato di Cafarnao probabilmente non è altro che uno schizofrenico. Ma che cosa spiega con questo? Satana non potrebbe forse agire attraverso lo sdoppiamento di una personalità psicotica? Evitiamo di non cadere in un nuovo tipo di sdoppiamento ricorrendo esclusivamente ad altre scienze umane e alle filosofie del dubbio e per liberarci dalle idee preconette e dalle risposte prefabbricate che Gesù viene oggi, a parlarci con autorità.

**Gesù esce allo scoperto**—Ecco la prima manifestazione di Gesù, il messia: l'uomo nuovo, nel mondo dominato dal male fisico e morale. Il demonio rappresenta la forza di odio, di morte e di cattiveria. Il Cristo le condanna e le domina. La malattia è il sintomo della debolezza che ci vota alla morte. Egli annuncia un ordine nuovo e lo mette in moto. Ormai la guerra è dichiarata e la vittoria è sicura.


