From the Pastor's Desk

IV SUNDAY O.T. This Sunday we continue with the narration of the first preaching of Jesus in Nazareth. Before the negative reactions of Jesus fellow residents, for having presented himself as a Master and for speaking with authority: "This Scripture that you have just heard has been fulfilled today". Unbelief holds back God's love, taking away the power to his words, rendering them ineffective. In a way, it kills them. Just as the Nazarenes pushed Jesus out of their city, and tried to kill him so that he would not return in the midst of them claiming an authority over their lives, the same thing happens every time we do not accept the Gospel with a sincere and open heart. In our present world, it seems that many do not have space for God and they want to expel him from their lives or refuse to put into practice the Gospel and ignore or criticize their witnesses so that they do not disturb their tranquility, as those inhabitants of Nazareth did. It is true, we prefer silence and indifference as Pope Francis emphasizes, so that our weaknesses, our sins and interests are not exposed. There is no doubt, unbelief is like a conspiracy of silence: it does not tolerate the Gospel message inviting us to convert or challenge our heart. It is not a conspiracy of someone who has never known or heard the Lord; on the contrary, unbelief comes from who knows him and it is a sin of the believers of the ones who has the knowledges. It is like to fear the closeness of a human, neighbor and real alive God. Some would like a more distant God and Gospel so far away that it would not confront us in anything in our doing, and it would support the "selfish mentality" of our world. Yet, we know that the message of the Gospel is enclosed in a single word: "the love of God". I hope that you and I be committed helping to create a "culture of evangelization" that will lead us to let the spirit of God invades us and helps us to create a world that is always more similar to the doing of God.

Del Escritorio del Párroco

IV DOMINGO T.O. Este domingo continúan con la narración de la primera predicación de Jesús en Nazaret, acogiendo las reacciones negativas de los conciudadanos de Jesús, por haberse presentado él como Maestro y por haber hablado con autoridad: "Esta Escritura que acababan de oír se ha cumplido hoy". La incredulidad ata el amor de Dios, reduce a la impotencia sus palabras haciéndolas ineficaces.

En cierto modo las mata. Igual que los nazarenos empujaron a Jesús fuera de su ciudad, y trataron de matarle para que no volviera en medio de ellos reivindicando una autoridad sobre sus vidas, lo mismo sucede cada vez que nosotros no acogemos el Evangelio con un corazón sincero y disponible. En nuestro mundo actual parece que muchos no tiene espacio para Dios y lo quieren expulsar de sus vidas o se reúsan de poner en práctica el Evangelio y ignoran o critican a sus testigos para que no perturben su tranquilidad, como hicieron aquellos habitantes de Nazaret. Es verdad, preferimos el silencio y la indiferencia como subraya Papa Francisco, para que no queden al descubierto nuestras debilidades, nuestros pecados e intereses. No cabe duda, la incredulidad es como una conjura del silencio: no tolera que el Evangelio hable y cambie nuestro corazón y no se trata de una conjura de quien no ha conocido o escuchado nunca al Señor; al contrario, la incredulidad viene de quien le conoce, es un pecado de los creyentes. Es como un miedo a un Dios vivo, vecino, humano. Algunos le gustaría más un Evangelio tan lejano que no nos dijera nada, o vacío de su fuerza, que pactara con la mentalidad de este mundo de forma que no nos pidiera nada. Y sin embargo el Evangelio se encierra en una sola palabra: el amor de Dios. Ojalá que tu y Yo nos ayude a crear siempre mas una cultura de evangelización que nos lleve a dejar que el espíritu de Dios nos invada y ayude a crear un mundo siempre mas semejante al actuar de Dios.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Quarta domenica del T.O. — Ciclo “C” — «Oggi si è adempiuta questa Scrittura». Quale? «Lo Spirito del Signore è sopra di me; per questo mi ha mandato per annunziare ai poveri un lieto messaggio... e predicare un anno di grazie del Signore». (Is. 61, 1-2): l’evangelista condensa tutto il discorso di Gesù di Nazaret in queste brevi parole. Dobbiamo rassegnarci a non conoscere

più dettagliatamente il contenuto, limitandoci ad osservare la reazione della gente. Dapprima riservati, poi più che reticenti, i contadini di Gesù avanzano pretese decisamente campanellistiche: perché non ripete nel suo villaggio i prodigi che ha compiuto a Cafarnao? Poi l’atmosfera si surriscalda, al punto che gli ascoltatori tentano di ucciderlo, quando egli si appella ai grandi profeti del passato che hanno concesso i loro miracoli ai pagani per meglio denunciare l’incredulità del loro popolo.

Cerchiamo di non accontentarci di una lettura superficiale di questo brano, che contiene la presentazione di un tema fondamentale, l’abbozzo di una sinfonia che Luca svilupperà nel suo vangelo, e poi nel libro degli Atti. Si tratta già del destino di Gesù e del suo messaggio, della sua tragica fine, ma anche del fuoco che Egli è venuto a portare nel mondo, e che dopo la Pasqua si propagherà a Gerusalemme, «in tutta la Giudea e la Samaria fino agli estremi confini della terra» (Atti 1,8).

L’«oggi» di questo vangelo che si apre su orizzonti universali, riguarda dunque anche noi. È come il leggero rullio della nave ancora nel porto, ma la chiama lontano, al di là dei mari, verso iole ancora sconosciute. Non confiniamo Gesù a Nazaret nel primo secolo della nostra era mentre la sua parola è per ogni razza, per ogni cultura, per tutto il mondo e per tutte le epoche della storia.

Il rifiuto dei concittadini — Il discorso che Luca mette in bocca a Gesù in questa lettura è un discorso programmatico ed è in linea con l’intuizione fondamentale che l’autore ha posto alla base del suo vangelo e del libro degli Atti, che la salvezza dapprima proposta agli ebrei, deve estendersi a tutte le nazioni. Questa rivelazione suscita scetticismo e opposizione tra i cittadini di Gesù, che avrebbero voluto da lui, non l’annuncio di un impegno di liberazione, ma segni sensibili del suo potere, cioè miracoli come aveva fatto a Cafarnao fra i pagani.

È sempre così: l’uomo considera la religione come un investimento umano, e si mette a contrattare con Dio, cercando solo il proprio interesse.




