From the Pastor's Desk

VI SUNDAY O.T. Continuing this Sunday with the reading of the sermon on the mountain we read the section called "speech of the antithesis", which raises the decisive problem of the relationship between Jesus and the Law, between the Gospel and ethical norms. Jesus speaks of a different justice that is linked to God's way of acting, which does not behave like a cold calculator that focuses between possess and give, faults and merits. God acts with a big and merciful heart that goes beyond all limits, including that of the Law. The problem is not in the relationship between precept and observance, but between love and indifference, between passion and coldness. In reality, the mere observance of the laws is not at stake, but the building of a common life whose fundamental law is reciprocal and transparent love. By the way, Jesus challenges us: "If, then, by presenting your offering at the altar you remember then that your brother has something against you, leave your offering there, in front of the altar, and go first to reconcile with your brother".

Let us make these radical and demanding expressions of Jesus a witness in the spirit of the Gospel with a new heart, a new spirit. I leave you with the words that Cardinal Blaise Cupich sent encouraging us to collaborate in the Annual Catholic Campaign 2020. Dear Father Bizzotto, across the past two years, the Annual Catholic Appeal has invited our Catholic people to hear the call of Jesus, *Come, follow me*, and to become His missionary disciples. This year's theme develops the call and the outreach: ***Come, follow me... and heal our world.*** Certainly, each one of us individually stands in need of healing and so does our wounded Church. Even as we embrace our own healing in Jesus, we are also called to be His healing presence in our broken, fragmented, and sometimes violent world. The Annual Catholic Appeal enables us to be missionary disciples who bring the Lord's healing to those in need. It does so by supporting parishes, Catholic schools, programs of religious education, ministry formation, and initiatives for justice, peace, and respect for all life. The healing outreach extends throughout the world to people devastated by war and natural disasters through Catholic Relief Services. Your leadership as pastor and your willingness to follow well-proven and effective producers has made the Appeal successful. To date, this year's Appeal has raised over \$13,500,000. Thank you for your support. It makes all the difference. As we build on our past collaboration, I ask you once again to follow the Appeal process and procedures. We know that they work. More specifically, your 2020 goal is 7% of the previous year's offertory income. For Fiscal Year 2018-2019, your offertory income was \$297,790. Therefore, your target for the 2020 Appeal is \$20,845. As you know, when contributions exceed the goal, Our Lady of Mount Carmel will receive a rebate from those donated funds. VI DOMINGO T.O. Continuando este domingo con la lectura del sermón de la montaña escuchamos la sección denominada "Discurso de las antítesis", donde se plantea el problema decisivo de la relación entre Jesús y la Ley, entre el Evangelio y las normas éticas. Jesús habla de una justicia distinta que va unida a la forma de actuar de Dios, que no se comporta como un frío calculador que se enfoca entre el **debe y el haber, las culpas y los méritos**. Dios actúa con un corazón grande y misericordioso que va más allá de todo límite, incluso el de la Ley. El problema no se encuentra en la relación entre precepto y observancia, sino entre **amor e indiferencia, entre pasión y frialdad**. En realidad, no está en juego la mera observancia de las leyes, sino la **edificación de una vida común** cuya ley fundamental es el amor recíproco y transparente.

Por cierto, Jesús nos desafía: "**Si, pues, al presentar tu ofrenda en el altar te acuerdas entonces de que tu hermano tiene algo contra ti, deja tu ofrenda allí, delante del altar, y vete primero a reconciliarte con tu hermano**". Hagamos nuestras estas radicales y exigentes expresiones de Jesús para testimoniar y gozar el espíritu del Evangelio con corazón nuevo, de un espíritu nuevo.



VI DOMENICA T.O. Continuando questa domenica con la lettura del **discorso nella montagna** leggiamo la sezione chiamata "**Discorso dell'antitesi**", che solleva il problema decisivo del rapporto tra Gesù e la Legge, tra il Vangelo e le norme etiche. Gesù parla di una giustizia diversa che è legata al modo di agire di Dio, che non si comporta come un freddo calcolatore che si concentra tra tenere e l'avere, difetti e meriti. Dio agisce con un cuore grande e misericordioso che supera ogni limite, compreso quello della Legge. Il problema non è nel rapporto tra precesto e obbedienza, ma tra amore e indifferenza, tra passione e freddezza. In realtà, non è in gioco la semplice osservanza delle leggi, ma la struttura di una vita comune la cui legge fondamentale è l'amore reciproco e trasparente. A proposito, Gesù ci sfida: "**Se, quindi, quando presenti la tua offerta sull'altare, ti ricordi che tuo fratello ha qualcosa contro di te, lascia lì la tua offerta, davanti all'altare, e vai prima a riconciliarti con tuo fratello**". 
