From the Pastor's Desk

VIII SUNDAY OF O.T. & LENT PREPARATION. This Sunday's gospel continues with the discourse of Jesus to the disciples which began with the beatitudes. All of today's passage forms a unity in which Jesus offers a series of maxims of human and spiritual wisdom. The **image of the blind who cannot lead another blind person** resonates with all of us, especially those who have some responsibility to guide others, to know how to keep our eyes open on the Gospel, to be attentive to our own interior life, to see what is good and

beautiful around us-otherwise we are blind without the possibility to help anyone. The accusation toward the Pharisees is clear. They are blind guides who are unable to guide anyone. But the teaching is for all of us: whoever is blind, that is, whoever allows himself to be guided only by their own narrow mind or pride, whoever is focused only on themselves, falls into the attitude stigmatized in the Gospel. Jesus reminds us then that no disciple should think of becoming greater than the master. This means that every disciple, even those who have grown in wisdom, should not fall into the temptation of not needing to hear the Gospel. Actually, disciples should become true gospel, in order to be "like the teacher." It is as the apostle said: **"it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me"** (Gal 2:20). Love, fruit of God's grace open the eyes of our heart to see, to be moved and to encounter others with mercy.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 6TH WITH THE IMPOSITION OF ASHES-BEGINNING OF LENT. Pope FRANCIS offers the following message to help us live the Lenten season 2019. Theme: "*For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the children of God*", (Rm 8: 19). (Part 1) Dear Brothers and Sisters each year, through Mother Church, God "gives us this joyful season when we prepare to celebrate the paschal mystery with mind and heart renewed... as we recall the great events that gave us new life in Christ" (*Preface of Lent I*). We can thus journey from Easter to Easter towards the fulfilment of the salvation we have already received as a result of Christ's paschal mystery – "for in hope we were saved" (Rom 8:24). This mystery of salvation, already at work in us during our earthly lives, is a dynamic process that also embraces history and all of creation. As Saint Paul says, "the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the children of God" (Rom 8:19). In this perspective, I would like to offer a few reflections to accompany our journey of conversion this coming Lent. ***The redemption of creation.*** The celebration of the Paschal Triduum of Christ's passion, death and resurrection, the culmination of the liturgical year, calls us yearly to undertake a journey of preparation, in the knowledge that our being conformed to Christ (cf. Rom 8:29) is a priceless gift of God's mercy. When we live as children of God, redeemed, led by the Holy Spirit (cf. Rom 8:14) and capable of acknowledging and obeying God's law, beginning with the law written on our hearts and in nature, *we also benefit creation* by cooperating in its redemption. That is why Saint Paul says that creation eagerly longs for the revelation of the children of God; in other words, that all those who enjoy the grace of Jesus' paschal mystery may experience its fulfilment in the redemption of the human body itself. When the love of Christ transfigures the lives of the saints in spirit, body and soul, they give praise to God. Through prayer, contemplation and art, they also include other creatures in that praise, as we see admirably expressed in the "Canticle of the Creatures" by Saint Francis of Assisi (cf. *Laudato Si'*, 87). Yet in this world, the harmony generated by redemption is constantly threatened by the negative power of sin and death.

VIII DOMINGO DE T.O. Y PREPARACION A LA CUARESMA. El Evangelio de este domingo continúa con el discurso de Jesús a los discípulos, que empezó con las "bienaventuranzas". Los pasajes de hoy constituyen una unidad en la que Jesús expone una serie de **máximas de sabiduría humana y espiritual**. La **imagen del ciego** que no puede guiar a otro ciego nos recuerda a todos -y en especial a los que tienen alguna responsabilidad como guías- que debemos saber tener los ojos fijos en el Evangelio, estar atentos a nuestra vida interior, ver lo que hay de bueno y de hermoso a nuestro alrededor; de lo contrario, seremos ciegos sin

posibilidad de ayudar a nadie. Queda clara la acusación a los fariseos de ser guías ciegos incapaces de guiar a otros. Pero la enseñanza es para todos: el que está ciego, es decir, el que se guía sólo por su avaricia o por su orgullo, aquel que está centrado sólo en sí mismo, cae en la actitud que estigmatiza el Evangelio. Jesús, por otra parte, recuerda que **ningún discípulo debe creer que puede ser más que el maestro**. Eso significa que ningún discípulo, incluso aunque haya hecho progresos en sabiduría, debe caer en la tentación de pensar que ya no necesita escuchar el Evangelio. En todo caso, el discípulo debe convertirse él mismo en evangélico; entonces "será como el maestro". Es lo que dijo el apóstol: "**Ya no vivo yo, sino que Cristo vive en mí**" (Ga 2, 20). El amor, fruto de la gracia de Dios que vive en nosotros nos abre los ojos del corazón para ver, para conmovernos y para ir al encuentro de los demás con misericordia.

MIERCOLES 6 DE MARZO CON LA IMPOSICION DE LA CENIZA COMENZAMOS LA CUARESMA. Papa Francisco nos ofrece este mensaje para vivir bien este tiempo litúrgico. Presentaremos en partes su mensaje: Tema: "*La creación, expectante, está aguardando la manifestación de los hijos de Dios*" (*Rm 8,19*). (Parte 1) *Queridos hermanos y hermanas*: cada año, a través de la Madre Iglesia, Dios "concede a sus hijos anhelar, con el gozo de habernos purificado, la solemnidad de la Pascua, para que [...] por la celebración de los misterios que nos dieron nueva vida, lleguemos a ser con plenitud hijos de Dios" (Prefacio I de Cuaresma). De este modo podemos caminar, de Pascua en Pascua, hacia el cumplimiento de aquella salvación que ya hemos recibido gracias al misterio pascual de Cristo: "Pues hemos sido salvados en esperanza" (*Rm 8,24*). Este misterio de salvación, que ya obra en nosotros durante la vida terrena, es un proceso dinámico que incluye también a la historia y a toda la creación. San Pablo llega a decir: "La creación, expectante, está aguardando la manifestación de los hijos de Dios" (*Rm 8,19*). Desde esta perspectiva querría sugerir algunos puntos de reflexión, que acompañen nuestro camino de conversión en la próxima Cuaresma. ***La redención de la creación.*** La celebración del Triduo Pascual de la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Cristo, culmen del año litúrgico, nos llama una y otra vez a vivir un itinerario de preparación, conscientes de que ser conformes a Cristo (cf. *Rm 8,29*) es un don inestimable de la misericordia de Dios. Si el hombre vive como hijo de Dios, si vive como persona redimida, que se deja llevar por el Espíritu Santo (cf. *Rm 8,14*), y sabe reconocer y poner en práctica la ley de Dios, comenzando por la que está inscrita en su corazón y en la naturaleza, ***beneficia también a la creación***, cooperando en su redención. Por esto, la creación -dice san Pablo- desea ardientemente que se manifiesten los hijos de Dios, es decir, que cuantos gozan de la gracia del misterio pascual de Jesús disfruten plenamente de sus frutos, destinados a alcanzar su maduración completa en la redención del mismo cuerpo humano. Cuando la caridad de Cristo transfigura la vida de los santos -espíritu, alma y cuerpo-, estos alaban a Dios y, con la oración, la contemplación y el arte hacen partícipes de ello también a las criaturas, como demuestra de forma admirable el "Cántico del hermano sol" de san Francisco de Asís (cf. Enc. *Laudato si'*, 87). Sin embargo, en este mundo la armonía generada por la redención está amenazada, hoy y siempre, por la fuerza negativa del pecado y de la muerte.

Ottava Domenica del T.O. — Ciclo "C" — Tutti abbiamo toccato con mano quanto possa essere ambigua la parola umana. Mezzo privilegiato di comunicazione e di comunione, può svelare o coprire, offrire la verità o distillare la menzogna. Di rado essa esprima autenticamente quello che abbiamo dentro, perché può andare dalla trasparenza del cristallo all'opacità del vetro smerigliato. «*Parole, parole, parole*», esclama Amleto di fronte alla vacuità di certi discorsi.

Chiamati a far risplendere la verità del vangelo, i discepoli di Gesù devono preoccuparsi prima di tutto della rettitudine del proprio animo, perché «*la bocca parla dalla pienezza del cuore*». È per mezzo della parola che insieme essi costruiscono la comunità in cui trovano reciproco sostegno. Se vogliono aiutare gli altri a vivere secondo il vangelo, bisogna che l'abbiano sufficientemente assimilato per camminare sicuri alla sua luce, per purificare il proprio sguardo attraverso una chiara consapevolezza delle proprie carenze, per fare in modo che ai discorsi corrisponda la coerenza della vita. Allora soltanto, perché illuminato e sincero, l'impegno della loro carità produrrà frutti buoni, e farà trovar loro le parole, e soprattutto i gesti, che provocano la conversione personale e costruiscono la comunità dei credenti.

In un momento in cui sentiamo più che mai una diffidenza istintiva nei confronti delle dichiarazioni gratuite o della retorica che si compiace di se stessa, è una fortuna per i cristiani che Gesù abbia lasciato loro, molto più che una dottrina da conoscere, ma una vita da imitare. O meglio, una parola da vivere nel loro cuore, dove il Cristo abita per mezzo della fede, e dove impegnano per lui il proprio amore e la propria libertà. Meglio una vita senza parole che una parola senza vita, un discorso vuoto e astratto, anche se pronunciato sotto l'egida di qualche *oremus*.

La pagliuzza e la trave — Terribile la tendenza dell'uomo a giudicare i suoi fratelli: quanta presunzione e quanti errori. Si guarda la pagliuzza, dimenticando la trave, si dividono i buoni dai cattivi, si catalogano gli uomini, si giudica in base a criteri insufficienti, deformati dall'egoismo o dall'ignoranza personale. Bisogna finirla una buona volta, imparando a rispettare gli altri e a perdonare, sull'esempio di Dio che offre il suo perdono a tutti senza distinzioni.


