From the Pastor's Desk

II SUNDAY OF LENT & MESSAGE OF THE POPE (PART 3). The Second Sunday of Lent is known as the Sunday of **TRANSFIGURATION**. We heard the gospel that presents Jesus who climbs the mountain with his three close disciples: **Peter, James and John**. He took them with him, presenting them the mission, that is to say, inviting them to embrace his life, his vocation, his mission, his path. That day he took them to the mountain, to pray. We have not been made aware of the depth and strength of Jesus' feelings in those moments, but the description of the transfiguration makes us "see", or at least intuit, what Jesus felt. The evangelist affirms that **"while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white"** (Lk 9, 29). The change that took place in Jesus was so profound that it could be seen in his clothing. The prayer that he spoke on that day, in addition to being addressed to the Father, became a conversation with Moses and Elijah about **"his departure, which he was going to fulfill in Jerusalem"**. The disciples were there at his side, struggling with their sleep. They did everything possible not to fall asleep: they stayed awake and saw the glory of God. They understood who Jesus was and what relationship he had with the Father. It was truly worthwhile to keep paying attention to that face so different from our faces. From Pedro's mouth came an expression of gratitude and amazement: **"Master, it is good for us to be here, let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah"**. A cloud came and cast a shadow over them and they became frightened. At once a voice came from heaven: **"This is my chosen Son; listen to him"**. When the three opened their eyes, they saw Jesus alone. Yes, only Jesus is the teacher of life; only he can save us. It was without a doubt an incredible experience for those three poor disciples. Let us entrust ourselves to Jesus in this Lenten season, to free us from our selfishness to enjoy his Glory in our life. The transfiguration is the anticipation of the Glory that God gives us if we will remain in Him and fully believe in Him.

3 Part of Pope Lenten Message. *The healing power of repentance and forgiveness.* Creation urgently needs the revelation of the children of God, who have been made "a new creation". For "if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away; behold, the new has come" (2 Cor 5:17). Indeed, by virtue of their being revealed, *creation itself can celebrate a Pasch*, opening itself to a new heaven and a new earth (cf. Rev 21:1). The path to Easter demands that we renew our faces and hearts as Christians through repentance, conversion and forgiveness, so as to live fully the abundant grace of the paschal mystery. This "eager longing", this expectation of all creation, will be fulfilled in the revelation of the children of God, that is, when Christians and all people enter decisively into the "travail" that conversion entails. All creation is called, with us, to go forth "from its bondage to decay and obtain the glorious liberty of the children of God" (Rom 8:21). Lent is a sacramental sign of this conversion. It invites Christians to embody the paschal mystery more deeply and concretely in their personal, family and social lives, above all by fasting, prayer and almsgiving.

II DOMINGO DE CUARESMA & MENSAJE CUARESMA DEL PAPA (PART 3). El Segundo domingo de Cuaresma es conocido como el domingo de la **TRANSFIGURACIÓN**. Hemos escuchado el evangelio que nos presenta a Jesús que sube al monte con sus tres cercanos discípulos: **Pedro, Santiago y Juan**. Se lo llevó consigo, presentándole una misión, es decir los arrancó de sí mismos para vincularlos a su vida, a su vocación, a su misión, a su camino. Aquel día los llevó al monte, para rezar. No se nos ha dado a conocer la

profundidad y la fuerza de los sentimientos de Jesús en esos momentos, pero la descripción de la transfiguración nos hace "ver", o al menos intuir, lo que Jesús sentía. El evangelista afirma que **"mientras oraba, el aspecto de su rostro se mudó, y sus vestidos eran de una blancura fulgurante"** (Lc 9, 29). Fue tal el cambio que tuvo lugar en Jesús que se reflejó incluso en los vestidos. La oración de aquel día, además de con el Padre, fue un coloquio con Moisés y Elías sobre **"su partida, que iba a cumplir en Jerusalén"**. Los discípulos estaban allí a su lado, oprimidos por el sueño. Hicieron todo lo posible para no dormirse: se mantuvieron despiertos y vieron la gloria de Dios, comprendieron quién era Jesús y qué relación tenía con el Padre. Verdaderamente valía la pena seguir fijando la atención en aquel rostro tan diferente de las nuestras caras. De la boca de Pedro salió una expresión de gratitud y estupor: **"Maestro, bueno es estarnos aquí. Vamos a hacer tres tiendas, una para ti, una para Moisés y otra para Elías"**. Una nube envolvió a los tres discípulos y se asustaron. Al momento se oyó una voz que venía del cielo: **"Este es mi Hijo, mi escogido; escúchenlo"**. Al abrir los ojos, los tres sólo vieron a Jesús. Sí, sólo Jesús es maestro de la vida; sólo él puede salvarnos. Fue sin duda una experiencia increíble para aquellos tres pobres discípulos. Abandonámonos en esta cuaresma a Jesús, porque nos saque de nuestro egoísmo para gozar de su Gloria en nuestra vida. La transfiguración es la anticipación de la Gloria que Dios nos regala si viviremos y creeremos plenamente en Él.

3 Parte del Mensaje Cuaresmal de Papa Francisco. La fuerza regeneradora del arrepentimiento y del perdón. Por esto, la creación tiene la irrefrenable necesidad de que se manifiesten los hijos de Dios, aquellos que se han convertido en una "nueva creación": «Si alguno está en Cristo, es una criatura nueva. Lo viejo ha pasado, ha comenzado lo nuevo» (2 Co5,17). En efecto, manifestándose, también *la creación puede "celebrar la Pascua"*: abrirse a los cielos nuevos y a la tierra nueva (cf. Ap 21,1). Y el camino hacia la Pascua nos llama precisamente a restaurar nuestro rostro y nuestro corazón de cristianos, mediante el arrepentimiento, la conversión y el perdón, para poder vivir toda la riqueza de la gracia del misterio pascual. Esta "impaciencia", esta expectación de la creación encontrará cumplimiento cuando se manifiesten los hijos de Dios, es decir cuando los cristianos y todos los hombres emprendan con decisión el "trabajo" que supone la conversión. Toda la creación está llamada a salir, junto con nosotros, «de la esclavitud de la corrupción para entrar en la gloriosa libertad de los hijos de Dios» (Rm8,21). La Cuaresma es signo sacramental de esta conversión, es una llamada a los cristianos a encarnar más intensa y concretamente el misterio pascual en su vida personal, familiar y social, en particular, mediante el ayuno, la oración y la limosna.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Seconda Domenica di Quaresima — Ciclo "C" — Nella liturgia della Quaresima, il racconto della trasfigurazione assume tutto il suo significato, dopo la rievocazione delle tentazioni di Gesù nel deserto. Nel vangelo di Luca, infatti, l'insieme degli episodi della confessione di Pietro, del primo annuncio della passione e della trasfigurazione, rappresenta una tappa della «*salita*» a Gerusalemme, dove il mistero

di Gesù toccherà il culmine, come suggerisse l'ultima tentazione, che Luca colloca sul pinnacolo del tempio. Non si arriva senza fatica a Gerusalemme: bisogna «*salire*» come il sacerdote sale i gradini dell'altare per offrire il sacrificio. La trasfigurazione si inserisce in una pausa del cammino, durante la quale Gesù si raccoglie alla presenza del Padre per scoprire, alla sua luce, ciò che è chiamato a diventare. È sicuramente questo il motivo per cui Luca ha sottolineato, come in altre occasioni importanti, che la trasfigurazione di Gesù ebbe luogo «*mentre pregava*». Si può indovinare, almeno in parte, il contenuto della preghiera. Mentre i suoi tre compagni, presi dal sonno, come in seguito sul monte degli Ulivi, sembrano reagire soltanto al termine dell'episodio. Gesù parla con Mosè ed Elia «della sua dipartita che avrebbe portato a compimento a Gerusalemme». Prima di affrontare con coraggio il cammino del calvario, Gesù vive un momento di pienezza, in cui la realtà del suo essere scelto da Dio gli appare con assoluta evidenza, immergendolo nel mistero di morte e di risurrezione che lo attende. Di qui la trasformazione del suo volto e la gioia che lo avvolge.

Anche a noi non basterà tutta la vita per diventare ciò che siamo. In questo lungo cammino, ci sarà di aiuto la preghiera. Contemplando il volto pasquale di Gesù, finiremo per scoprire, a poco a poco, il vero volto della nostra anima. A condizione di non rinnegare nelle tenebre ciò che avremo visto, un giorno, nella luce.

Mostra il tuo volto, o Signore — Questa preghiera nessun ebreo ha usato formularla, per paura di morire. Due profeti, tuttavia hanno corso questo rischio: Mosè ed Elia. Ma non hanno visto Dio, dice la Bibbia, se non di spalle. In un leggero soffio di brezza. La loro domanda non ha mai perduto la sua attualità: essi la formularono incessantemente per noi, ma al momento di venire esauditi, scoprirono che il Dio da essi cercato è un uomo che sta per morire. Il vero volto di Dio si rivela nella morte del suo Figlio: è una rivelazione amara per il popolo ebraico e per ciascuno dei più illustri rappresentanti, compreso Pietro: segno che Dio si identifica con nessun progetto o ritratto che l'uomo fa a suo riguardo.


