

## From the Pastor's Desk

**III SUNDAY OF LENT & IV PART OF THE LENTEN MESSAGE OF THE POPE.** This Sunday presents to us the vocational and spiritual founding experience of Moses on Mount Horeb. Moses, as narrates the book of Exodus, was shepherding the flock of his father-in-law and came to the Horeb. There "the angel of the Lord appeared to Moses in fire flaming out of a bush: it was a fire that burned, but did not consume. So, it is with the Word of God: it burns our life, but it does not destroy it; it worries us, but it does not annihilate us. The

Lord said to him: "**I have witnessed the affliction of my people in Egypt and I have heard their cry of complaint against their slave drivers, so I know well what they are sufferings. I have come down to rescue them from the hands of the Egyptians**". Moses stood before a bush of love, a fire that wanted to free the people of Israel from the slavery of Egypt. The Lord, burning with love for his people, asked Moses to help him. In the Horeb God manifested himself to Moses as a God who is close and accompanying his people and never abandoning them. The definition that God gave of himself in the Horeb culminates in Jesus. Jesus is the burning bush, as he affirmed: "**I have come to bring a fire on the earth and how much I wish it were already burning!**" (Lc. 12, 49). He also reminds us: "**I am with you every day, until the end of the world**" (Mt 28, 20). The Gospel presents us Jesus with some parables about the mercy, patience and kindness of God. The history of the tree that has not produced fruit and the master, indignant that he wants to cut it; on the other hand, the gardener who insists that he leaves it for one more year and he shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it. The appeal reaches the heart of the master and he granted it. Jesus, with this parable, helps us to look at our life that sometimes to, it does not bear fruit, but it is saved by his mercy. Lent is an opportune time to let us be touched by the heart for the Gospel and thus renew ourselves and be more fruitful.

**Pope Lenten Message (Part 4) Fasting**, that is, learning to change our attitude towards others and all of creation, turning away from the temptation to "devour" everything to satisfy our voracity and being ready to suffer for love, which can fill the emptiness of our hearts. **Prayer**, which teaches us to abandon idolatry and the self-sufficiency of our ego, and to acknowledge our need of the Lord and his mercy. **Almsgiving**, whereby we escape from the insanity of hoarding everything for ourselves in the illusory belief that we can secure a future that does not belong to us. And thus to rediscover the **joy of God's plan for creation** and for each of us, which is to love him, our brothers and sisters, and the entire world, and to find in this love our true happiness. Dear brothers and sisters, the "**Lenten**" period of forty days spent by the Son of God in the desert of creation had the goal of making it once more that garden of communion with God that it was before original sin (cf. Mk 1:12-13; Is 51:3). May our Lent this year be a journey along that same path, bringing the hope of Christ also to creation, so that it may be "**set free from its bondage to decay and obtain the glorious liberty of the children of God**" (Rom 8:21). Let us not allow this season of grace to pass in vain! Let us ask God to help us set out on a path of true conversion. Let us leave behind our selfishness and self-absorption, and turn to Jesus' Pasch. Let us stand beside our brothers and sisters in need, sharing our spiritual and material goods with them. In this way, by concretely welcoming Christ's victory over sin and death into our lives, we will also radiate its transforming power to all of creation.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

With this letter I write to you about a development that should disturb us greatly, both as citizens and as disciples of Jesus, the Lord of life.

Recently, two bills have been introduced in the Illinois House and Senate. The first, **House Bill 2495 and Senate Bill 1942**, both identical pieces of legislation, seeks to strip unborn persons of any protection – or even consideration – under the law and declare abortion to be a “fundamental right” and matter of health care. The end result is that an abortion could be obtained at any stage of pregnancy, including late term, for any reason and without any regulation. The law would no longer guarantee any modicum of humanity or compassion for any unborn person in Illinois, even if they are partially born. This legislation also repeals the **Abortion Performance Refusal Act**, which protects doctors, nurses and hospitals who refuse to permit, recommend, perform or assist in abortion. In so doing, rights of conscience, especially religious objections, will be lost.

The second piece of legislation **House Bill 2467** and its identical **Senate Bill 1594**, repeals the **Illinois Parental Notice of Abortion Act**. This law, upheld unanimously by the Illinois Supreme Court just six years ago, has the common-sense purpose of ensuring that parents would be part of the life-altering decision of their minor child in the case she seeks an abortion. This effective law has reduced abortions performed on minors by fifty-seven percent.

As citizens of a state and people of faith who care about the common good, I urge you to join me and my brother bishops in an effort to defeat this radical departure from current law and practice in our state. ## Del Escritorio del Párroco

**III DOMINGO DE CUARESMA & IV PARTE DEL MENSAJE CUARESMAL DEL PAPA.** Este domingo nos presenta la experiencia fundante y vocacional de Moisés en el monte Horeb. Moisés como narra el libro del Éxodo, estaba apacentando el rebaño del suegro y llegó hasta el Horeb. Allí "el ángel del Señor se le apareció en forma de llama de fuego, en medio de una zarza": era un fuego que quemaba pero no consumía. Así es con la Palabra de Dios: quema nuestra vida, pero no la destruye; nos inquieta pero no nos aniquila. El Señor le dijo: "He

visto la opresión de mi pueblo en Egipto y he oído sus quejas contra los opresores y conozco bien sus sufrimientos. He descendido para librar a mi pueblo de la opresión de los egipcios". Moisés se encontraba ante una zarza de amor, un fuego que quería liberar al pueblo de Israel de la esclavitud de Egipto. El Señor, ardiendo de amor por su pueblo, le pide a Moisés que lo ayude. En el Horeb Dios se manifestó a Moisés como un Dios cercano y que acompaña su pueblo, sin abandonarlo jamás. La definición que Dios dio de sí mismo en el Horeb llega en Jesús a su culminación: Jesús es la zarza ardiente; como afirmó: "He venido a arrojar un fuego sobre la tierra y ¡cuánto desearía que ya estuviera encendido!", Lc 12, 49). Ademas nos recuerda: "Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo" (Mt 28, 20). Jesús, en el Evangelio, nos presenta algunas parabolas sobre la misericordia, paciencia y bondad de Dios. La historia del árbol que no ha dado fruto y el amo, indignados que quiere cortarlo; y lo oposición del viñador que insiste para que espere un año más. Su súplica llega al corazón del amo y se convenció. Jesús, con esta parábola, nos ayuda a mirar a nuestra vida que a veces no da fruto, pero que es salvada por su misericordia. La Cuaresma es un tiempo oportuno para dejarnos tocar el corazón por el Evangelio y así renovarnos y ser más fructuosos.

**Mensaje Cuaresmal del Papa (Part 4).** Ayunar, o sea aprender a cambiar nuestra actitud con los demás y con las criaturas: de la tentación de "devorarlo" todo, para saciar nuestra avidez, a la capacidad de sufrir por amor, que puede colmar el vacío de nuestro corazón. Orar para saber renunciar a la idolatría y a la autosuficiencia de nuestro yo, y declararnos necesitados del Señor y de su misericordia. Dar limosna para salir de la necesidad de vivir y acumularlo todo para nosotros mismos, creyendo que así nos aseguramos un futuro que no nos pertenece. Y volver a encontrar así la alegría del proyecto que Dios ha puesto en la creación y en nuestro corazón, es decir amarle, amar a nuestros hermanos y al mundo entero, y encontrar en este amor la verdadera felicidad. Queridos hermanos y hermanas, la "Cuaresma" del Hijo de Dios fue un entrar en el desierto de la creación para hacer que volviese a ser aquel jardín de la comunión con Dios que era antes del pecado original (cf. Mc 1,12-13; Is 51,3). Que nuestra Cuaresma suponga recorrer ese mismo camino, para llevar también la esperanza de Cristo a la creación, que «será liberada de la esclavitud de la corrupción para entrar en la gloriosa libertad de los hijos de Dios» (Rm 8,21). No dejemos transcurrir en vano este tiempo favorable. Pidamos a Dios que nos ayude a emprender un camino de verdadera conversión. Abandonemos el egoísmo, la mirada fija en nosotros mismos, y dirijámonos a la Pascua de Jesús; hágámonos prójimos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas que pasan dificultades, compartiendo con ellos nuestros bienes espirituales y materiales. Así, acogiendo en lo concreto de nuestra vida la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte, atraeremos su fuerza transformadora también sobre la creación.




