From the Pastor's Desk

V SUNDAY OF LENT. This Sunday leads us to the end of Lent and takes us to the week of the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. The Gospel presents us Jesus who once again offers us a passionate story. Jesus is in the Temple teaching. A crowd surrounds him. Suddenly, among the people who listen to him, a group of scribes and Pharisees make their way, pushing a woman caught in adultery. They drag her into the middle of the circle, before Jesus, and they ask him whether or not to apply the law of Moses. They want to trap the young prophet of Nazareth, to discredit him to the greatest number of people who hear him. They think, if he condemns the woman, he would go against the mercy he preaches so much; if he forgives her, he will be against the law. In both cases he will be defeated. Jesus, bowing down, begins to "write with his finger on the ground".

It is a strange attitude: Jesus is silent, as he will do before Pilate and Herod. The Lord of the Word, the man who had made preaching his life and his service until death, is now silent. We do not know what he wrote in the arena. We can imagine the outraged feelings of the Pharisees perhaps guessing what would have been inside the heart of the woman whose hope for survival was linked to that man from whom, on the other hand, did not come out a word or a gesture. After the insistence of the Pharisees, Jesus raises his head and utters a phrase that sheds some light on their thoughts: "**Let any one among you who is without sin, be the first to throw a stone at her.**" And he bows again to write on the ground. His answer disarms everyone. Those words reached everyone in the bullseye: "**They went away one after another, beginning with the elders.**".

Only Jesus remain with the woman. They find one in front of the other: misery and mercy. At that moment Jesus speaks again. He does it with his usual tone, his passion, his tenderness and his firmness. He raises his head and asks: "**Woman, where are they, nobody has condemned you?**" She answers: "**Nobody, Lord.**" The word of Jesus becomes profound, not indifferent but full of Mercy and continues: "**Neither do I condemn you. Go, and do not sin anymore, that is, return to your life, to your path** ". Jesus did not come to condemn, but to forgive and give back life to the poor and sinners. May we embrace with Jesus the path that he has indicated to us, the path of mercy and forgiveness. This is the path that you and I in this Lent want to do in order to enjoy new life and blessings.

Del Escritorio del Párroco

V DOMINGO DE CUARESMA. Este domingo nos lleva al final de la Cuaresma hacia la semana santa de la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesús. El Evangelio nos lleva ante Jesús una vez más, que nos propone una apasionata historia. Jesús está en el Templo enseñando. Una multitud lo rodea. De pronto, por entre la gente que le escucha se abre paso un grupo de escribas y fariseos que empujan a una mujer sorprendida en adulterio. La arrastran al medio del círculo, ante Jesús, y le preguntan a este si hay que aplicar o no la ley de Moisés. Quieren tenderle una trampa al joven profeta de Nazaret, para desacreditarlo ante el mayor número de personas que lo escuchan. Piensan, si condena a la mujer iría en contra de la misericordia que tanto predica; si la perdona, se pondrá en contra de la ley.

En ambos casos saldrá derrotado. Jesús, inclinándose, se pone a "escribir con el dedo en la tierra". Es una actitud extraña: Jesús guarda silencio, como hará ante Pilatos y Herodes. El Señor de la Palabra, el hombre que había hecho de la predicación su vida y su servicio hasta la muerte, ahora calla. No sabemos qué escribió en la arena. Podemos imaginar los sentimientos indignados de los fariseos quizás intuir que había en el corazón de aquella mujer cuya esperanza de supervivencia estaba ligada a aquel hombre del que, por otra parte, no salía ni una palabra ni un gesto. Tras la insistencia de los fariseos, Jesús levanta la cabeza y pronuncia una frase que arroja algo de luz sobre sus pensamientos: "Aquel de ustedes que esté sin pecado, que le arroje la primera piedra". Y se inclina de nuevo para escribir en la tierra. La respuesta desarma a todos. Aquellas palabras alcanzaron a todos en la diana: "Se fueron retirando uno tras otro, comenzando por los más viejos". Tan solo quedan Jesús y la mujer. Se encuentran una delante de la otra, la miseria y la misericordia.

En aquel momento Jesús vuelve a hablar. Lo hace como de costumbre, con su tono, su pasión, su ternura y su firmeza. Levanta la cabeza y pregunta: "Mujer, ¿dónde están? ¿Nadie te ha condenado?". Ella responde: "Nadie, Señor". La palabra de Jesús se hace profunda, no indiferente sino llena de Misericordia y continua: "Ni tampoco yo te condeno. Vete, y en adelante no peques más", es decir, vuelve a la vida, a tu camino. Y añade: "No peques más". Jesus no ha venido a condenar sino a perdonar y devolver la vida a los pobres y pecadores. Abrazamos con Jesus el camino que nos ha indicado, el camino de la misericordia y del perdón. Es el camino que tú y yo en esta cuaresma queremos hacer para gozar con el vida nueva.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Quinta Domenica di Quaresima — Ciclo “C” — Ancora una volta, gli scribi e i farisei tendono un tranello a Gesù per screditarlo agli occhi del popolo. Collocando a questo punto l'incontro del Cristo con la donna adultera, la liturgia quaresimale le prelude alla passione: il sinedrio non si è ancora riunito, ma questo è già un primo episodio del processo contro Gesù: Se assolverà la donna sorpresa in flagrante adulterio, lo si accuserà di non rispettare la legge di Mosè, se la condannerà, dovrà rinunciare alla propria scelta di misericordia verso i peccatori. Gesù rivelerà invece la sua straordinaria saggezza. Egli sa che cosa c'è nel cuore dell'uomo, come potrebbe ignorare che «*non c'è sulla terra un uomo così giusto che faccia solo il bene e non pecchi*» (Qo 7,20). Il figlio dell'uomo, infatti è venuto precisamente per salvare ciò che era perduto. Agli accusatori che lo incitano a pronunciarsi, egli oppone in primo luogo, come più tardi davanti ai giudici, un silenzio assoluto: si direbbe che voglia costringere ognuno a riflettere. Perché non esiste il peccato in sé. Esistono soltanto i peccatori: innanzitutto la donna, che non può negare la colpa commessa, ma anche i suoi accusatori, che non possono sottrarsi all'esame di coscienza che tutti, a questo punto sono invitati a fare: «*Chi di voi è senza peccato, scagli per primo la pietra contro di lei*».

È una risposta decisiva, di fronte alla quale nessun seguace della legge, fosse anche il più zelante, può arrogarsi il diritto di pronunciare la condanna. Chi potrebbe pretendere di non avere nulla da rimproverarsi? Così vengono ridotte in polvere le iniziative degli avversari di Gesù (Ger. 17,13); quanto alla donna non viene abbandonata alle fatali conseguenze del suo peccato; ma viene invitata a reinventare personalmente la propria vita: «*Neanche io ti condanno: va' e d'ora in poi non peccare più*». È una parola liberatrice che ci obbliga a lasciare cadere le pietre che avevamo in mano. Senza negare la realtà, essa apre un futuro a chi non aveva più il coraggio di sperare.

Il tempo di grazia. Oggi si è così indulgenti verso l'adulterio, che l'atteggiamento di Gesù non ci sorprende più. Ma c'è forse un malinteso fra il suo modo di fare e il nostro? Gesù, da parte sua, non relativizza il peccato dell'adultera. Non cerca di rassicurarla dichiarandole, per esempio, che tutto ciò è senza importanza. Al contrario le dice: «*D'ora in poi non peccare più*». Tuttavia non vuole rinchiudere gli uomini nel loro peccato: crede nella possibilità di conversione per ciascuno di noi. Gesù non tranquillizza, ma chiama ad una vita rinnovata, ad un amore ricostruito al di là degli egoismi e delle incomprensioni reciproche.




