

## From the Pastor's Desk

**II SUNDAY OF EASTER AND SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY.** We continue to enjoy the day of Easter this Sunday with the meaningful "greeting and gift of the Risen Lord, that with his gestures and words, wishes us: "Peace be with you and receive the gift of the Holy Spirit". We also have the first encounter of the apostles with the Risen Lord. Then, they shared the remarkable news to Tomas announcing: "**We have seen the Lord**" and he, perplexed and distrustful, affirms: "**if I do not see the sign of the cross in his hands and ... I will not believe**". Eight days later, Jesus appears again and challenging Tomas' disbelief, He called him by

name and said: "**Here are my hands, put your finger here ... and do not be unbelieving, but believe**". Tomas immediately replied with a powerful profession of faith to the reproach of Jesus and to his resistance to believe, affirming: "**My Lord and my God**". I believe that these words mark the authentic profession of faith of the believers who are able to profess it without demanding proof. Jesus precisely reiterates: "**blessed are those who believe without having seen**". While we treasure the paschal joy of the Risen Christ and renew our faith in Him, let us also focus on this Sunday to the feast of the Divine Mercy. For the occasion Pope Francis reminds us that we commemorate this Sunday the 90th anniversary of the Lord's appearance to Sr. Faustina Kowalska. Remembering that, "**ninety years ago, the Lord Jesus manifested himself to Saint Faustina Kowalska, entrusting her with a special message of Divine Mercy**". Through Saint John Paul II the message reached the whole world and it is in reality the Gospel of Jesus Christ, dead and risen, which gives us the mercy of the Father. Let us open our hearts to Him, saying with faith: "**Jesus, I trust in you**". It was precisely on February 22, 1931, that the Lord Jesus miraculously manifested Himself to Saint Faustina Kowalska who was in her cell in the Plock convent of the Congregation of the Sisters of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mercy in Stary Rynek. Saint Faustina wrote in her Diary: "**At dusk, while I was in my cell, I saw the Lord Jesus dressed in a white robe: one hand was raised and blessing, while the other touched the robe on His chest, which, when withdrawing it slightly, it revealed two large rays, one red and the other grey. Mute, I kept my eyes fixed on the Lord; my soul was filled with fear, but also with great joy. After a moment, Jesus said to me: Paint a picture after the pattern you see, with the words: Jesus, I trust in You. I want this image to be venerated first in your chapel, and then throughout the world**". Pope Francis continues: "**let us ask Christ for the gift of mercy. Let Him embrace us and penetrate us. Let us have the courage to return to Jesus, to find His love and His mercy in the sacraments**". Let us remember that "**humanity will not know peace until it turns to the source of HIS mercy**". Let us feel His closeness and His tenderness and then we too will be more **capable of mercy, patience, forgiveness and love**. We pray in these difficult times of Covid epidemic and the massacre of so many shootings as well as for the many children and people who seek dignity, security and peace that the mercy of God strengthens us all. I hope that the fire of the Divine Mercy make you and I committed in creating an ever more just, Christian, peaceful and humane world in the Risen Lord. Amen.

### Del Escritorio del Párroco:

### II DOMINGO DE PASCUA Y DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA.

Continuamos gozando el día pascual en este domingo con el gran “saludo y regalo del Resucitado que, con sus gestos y palabras, nos desea: “La Paz esté con ustedes y reciban el don del Espíritu Santo”. Tenemos, también, el primer encuentro de los apóstoles con el Resucitado. Luego, ellos le compartieron la hermosa noticia al compañero Tomás anunciándole: “Hemos visto al Señor” y este perplejo y desconfiado, afirma: “si no veo en sus manos la señal de la cruz y ...no creeré”. A los ocho días se presenta nuevamente Jesús y desafiando la incredulidad de

Tomas lo reta llamándolo por nombre y le dice: “Aquí están mis manos, acerca tu dedo... y no siga dudando”. Tomás remite inmediatamente con una poderosa profesión de fe al reproche de Jesús y a su resistencia en creer, afirmando: “Señor mío y Dios mío”. Creo, que estas palabras marcan la auténtica profesión de fe de los creyentes que son capaces de profesarla sin exigir pruebas. Justamente Jesús reitera: “dichosos son más los que creen sin haber visto”. Mientras, hacemos tesoros del gozo pascual del Cristo vivo y renovamos nuestra fe en Él, hagamos nuestro también el llamado en este domingo, dedicado desde años a la Divina Misericordia. Por la ocasión Papa Francisco, nos recuerda, que recorre el 90 aniversario de la aparición del Señor a la Hna. Faustina Kowalska. Recuerda, “hace noventa años, el Señor Jesús se manifestó a Santa Faustina Kowalska, confiéndole un mensaje especial de la Divina Misericordia. Mediante San Juan Pablo II el mensaje llegó a todo el mundo y es el Evangelio de Jesucristo, muerto y resucitado, que nos da la misericordia del Padre. Abramos nuestro corazón a Él, diciendo con fe: “Jesús, confío en Ti”. Fue el 22 de febrero de 1931, que milagrosamente el Señor Jesús se manifestó a Santa Faustina Kowalska que estaba en su celda del convento de Plock de la Congregación de las Hermanas de la Santísima Virgen María de la Misericordia en Stary Rynek. Escribió Santa Faustina en su Diario, “Al anochecer, mientras estaba en mi celda, vi al Señor Jesús vestido con una túnica blanca: una mano estaba levantada para bendecir, mientras la otra tocaba la túnica sobre su pecho, que, al retirarla ligeramente, dejaba ver dos grandes rayos, uno rojo y otro pálido. Muda, mantuve los ojos fijos en el Señor; mi alma estaba embargada de temor, pero también de gran alegría. Después de un momento, Jesús me dijo: Pinta una imagen según el modelo que ves, con las palabras: “Jesús, confío en Ti”. Deseo que esta imagen sea venerada primero en su capilla, y luego en todo el mundo”. Continua Papa Francisco, “Pidamos a Cristo el don de la misericordia. Dejemos que nos abrace y nos penetre. Tengamos el valor de volver a Jesús, de encontrar su amor y su misericordia en los sacramentos”. Recordemos, que “la humanidad no conocerá la paz hasta que no se dirija a la fuente de SU misericordia”. Sintamos su cercanía y su ternura y entonces también nosotros seremos más capaces de misericordia, paciencia, perdón y amor”. Rogamos porque en estos tiempos difíciles de epidemias de Covid y de masacre de balaceras como de muchos niños y personas que buscan dignidad, seguridad y paz. Ojalá que el fuego de la misericordia divina haga que tú y yo nos comprometamos a crear un mundo siempre más justo, cristiano, pacífico y humano en el Señor Resucitado. Amen.



## II DOMENICA DI PASQUA E DOMENICA DELLA DIVINA MISERICORDIA.

Continuiamo a vivere il giorno pasquale con gioia in questa domenica ottava di pasqua con il "grande saluto pasquale e dono del Risorto che, con i suoi gesti e le sue parole, ci augura: **"La pace sia con voi e soffiando su di loro disse: ricevete il dono dello Spirito Santo"**". Abbiamo anche il primo incontro degli apostoli con il Risorto. Loro condividono la buona notizia con il compagno Tommaso annunciandogli: **"abbiamo visto il Signore"** e questi perplesso e diffidente afferma: **"Se non vedo il nelle sue mani il segno dei chiodi... non crederò"**. Otto giorni dopo Gesù riappare e, sfidando l'incredulità di Tommaso, lo chiama per nome e gli dice: "Metti qui il tuo dito e guarda le mie mani, ... e non essere incredulo, ma credente!" Tommaso risponde con una professione di fede al rimprovero di Gesù e alla sua resistenza a credere, affermando: **"Mio Signore e mio Dio"**. Credo che queste parole segnino l'autentica professione di fede dei credenti che possono professarla senza esigere prove. Gesù ribadisce precisamente: **"beati quelli che non hanno visto e hanno creduto"**. Mentre facciamo tesoro della gioia pasquale del Cristo vivente e rinnoviamo la nostra fede in Lui, accogliamo l'invito di questa domenica, a essere uomini e donne di MISERICORDIA. Da anni questa domenica è dedicata alla Divina Misericordia. Per l'occasione Papa Francesco ci ricorda che celebriamo i 90 anni dall'apparizione del Signore a Sr. Faustina Kowalska. Ricordate: **"novant'anni fa, il Signore Gesù si manifestò a Santa Faustina Kowalska, affidandole uno speciale messaggio di Divina Misericordia"**. Attraverso San Giovanni Paolo II il messaggio è arrivato al mondo intero ed è il Vangelo di Gesù Cristo, morto e risorto, che ci offre la **Misericordia del Padre**. Apriamo il nostro cuore a Lui, dicendogli con fede: **"Gesù, confido in te"**. Fu il 22 febbraio 1931 che il Signore Gesù si manifestò miracolosamente a Santa Faustina Kowalska che era nella sua cella nel convento di Plock della Congregazione delle Suore della Beata Vergine Maria della Misericordia a Stary Rynek. Scrive Santa Faustina nel suo Diario: **"Al tramonto, mentre ero nella mia cella, ho visto il Signore Gesù vestito di una veste bianca: una mano la teneva alzata come per benedire, mentre l'altra che si toccava la veste sul petto rivelava con due grandi raggi, uno rosso e l'altro bianco i segni dei sacramenti. Mutò rimasi, con gli occhi fissi sul Signore; la mia anima era piena di paura, ma anche di una grande gioia. Dopo un momento, Gesù mi disse: dipingi un'immagine secondo lo schema che vedi, con le parole: Gesù, confido in te. Desidero, che questa immagine sia venerata prima nella vostra cappella, e poi in tutto il mondo"**. Papa Francesco continua: **"chiediamo a Cristo il dono della misericordia e lasciamo che ci abbracci e penetri con il suo sguardo profondo nel nostro cuore e abbiammo il coraggio di tornare a Gesù, di trovare il suo amore e la sua misericordia nei sacramenti"**. Ricordiamoci che **"l'umanità non conoscerà la pace finché non volga alla fonte della SUA misericordia"**. Sentiamo la sua vicinanza, tenerezza e allora anche noi saremo più capaci di misericordia, pazienza, perdono e amore. Preghiamo perché in questi tempi difficili delle epidemie del Covid e delle stragi di sparatorie e di tanti bambini e persone che cercano dignità, sicurezza e pace; possiamo con il fuoco della Divina Misericordia a impegnarci a creare un mondo sempre più giusto, cristiano, pacifico ed umano nello spirito del Signore Risorto. Amen.

## CÓMO REZAR LA CORONILLA A LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

La Coronilla a la Divina Misericordia se reza con un rosario común. El rezo de la Coronilla es precedido por dos oraciones tomadas del Diario de Santa Faustina y seguido por una oración final.

### Oraciones de la Coronilla a la Divina Misericordia

1. ***La señal de la Cruz:*** En el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
  2. ***Oración al principio (opcional):*** Expiraste, Jesús, pero la fuente de vida brotó para las almas y el mar de misericordia se abrió para el mundo entero. Oh fuente de vida, insondable Misericordia Divina, abarca al mundo entero y derrámate sobre nosotros. Oh Sangre y Agua que brotaste del Corazón de Jesús, como una Fuente de Misericordia para nosotros, en Ti confío. Primero se reza una vez el Padre Nuestro, el Ave María y el Credo de los Apóstoles.
  3. ***Padre Nuestro:*** Padre Nuestro, que estás en el cielo, santificado sea Tu nombre; venga a nosotros Tu reino; hágase Tu voluntad en la tierra como en el cielo. Danos hoy nuestro pan de cada día; perdona nuestras ofensas, como también nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden; no nos dejes caer en la tentación, y líbranos del mal. Amén.
  4. ***Ave María:*** Dios te salve María, llena eres de gracia, el Señor es contigo, bendita eres entre todas las mujeres y bendito es el fruto de tu vientre, Jesús. Santa María, Madre de Dios, ruega por nosotros pecadores, ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte. Amén.
  5. ***Credo de los Apóstoles:*** Creo en Dios, Padre Todopoderoso, Creador del cielo y de la tierra. Creo en Jesucristo, Su único Hijo, nuestro Señor, que fue concebido por obra y gracia del Espíritu Santo, nació de Santa María Virgen, padeció bajo el poder de Poncio Pilato, fue crucificado, muerto y sepultado, descendió a los infiernos, al tercer día resucitó de entre los muertos, subió a los cielos y está sentado a la derecha de Dios Padre Todopoderoso. Desde allí ha de venir a juzgar a vivos y muertos. Creo en el Espíritu Santo, la santa Iglesia Católica, la comunión de los santos, el perdón de los pecados, la resurrección de la carne y la vida eterna. Amén.
  6. ***En las cuentas grandes del Padre Nuestro*** antes de cada decena: Padre Eterno, Te ofrezco el Cuerpo y la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de Tu Amadísimo Hijo, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero.
  7. ***En las 10 cuentas pequeñas de cada decena:*** Por Su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero.
  8. ***Repita el "Padre Eterno" y "Por Su dolorosa Pasión":*** (Números 6 y 7) Rece cuatro decenas más.
  9. ***Después de cinco decenas, la doxología final (tres veces):*** Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.
- Oración final (opcional):*** Oh Dios Eterno, en quien la misericordia es infinita y el tesoro de compasión inagotable, vuelve a nosotros Tu mirada bondadosa y aumenta Tu misericordia en nosotros, para que en momentos difíciles no nos desesperemos ni nos desalentamos, sino que, con gran confianza, nos sometamos a Tu santa voluntad, que es el Amor y la Misericordia Mismos.

## How to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is a glorious way to enter into the abundant Mercy of God. It only takes a few minutes and can easily be prayed almost anywhere. Using a rosary, follow the guide below to offer this wonderful prayer. It is especially good to pray it at the three o'clock hour.

### Optional Opening Prayers:

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls,  
and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy,  
envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat 3 times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy  
for us, I trust in You!

### Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed.

For each of the five decades (*On each "Our Father" bead of the rosary, pray*)

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord,  
Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(*On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray*)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

### Concluding prayer (Repeat 3 times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

### Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon  
us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become  
despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy  
itself. Amen.

## La Coroncina alla Divina Misericordia

### Coroncina della Misericordia

Per recitare la Coroncina della Divina Misericordia si può usare una semplice corona del Rosario. Si segue questa sequenza:

1. Segno della Croce

2. Padre Nostro

3. Ave Maria

4. Credo (Simbolo degli apostoli)

5. Su ogni grano maggiore del Rosario, quando si dice normalmente il Padre Nostro, si dica: Eterno Padre, Ti offro il Corpo e il Sangue, l'anima e la Divinità del Tuo diletissimo Figlio e Signore nostro Gesù Cristo, in espiazione dei nostri peccati e di quelli del mondo intero.

6. Su ogni grano minore del Rosario, quando si dice normalmente l'Ave Maria, si dica:

**Per la Sua dolorosa Passione, abbi misericordia di noi e del mondo intero.**

7. Invocazione. Alla fine della corona, si dice la preghiera seguente tre volte:

Santo Dio, Santo Forte, Santo Immortale, abbi pietà di noi e del mondo intero.

8. Preghiera conclusiva (facoltativa)

Dio, Padre Misericordioso, che hai rivelato il Tuo amore nel Figlio Tuo Gesù Cristo, e l'hai riversato su di noi nello Spirito Santo Consolatore, Ti affidiamo oggi i destini del mondo e di ogni uomo. Chinati su di noi peccatori, risana la nostra debolezza, sconfiggi ogni male, fa' che tutti gli abitanti della terra sperimentino la Tua Misericordia, affinché in Te, Dio Uno e Trino, trovino sempre la fonte della speranza. Eterno Padre, per la dolorosa Passione e la Resurrezione del Tuo Figlio, abbi misericordia di noi e del mondo intero.
