
We are a faith community bound by the Grace of God the Father who adopted

### From the Pastor's Desk

**PALM SUNDAY.** We enter with this Sunday at the center of the Paschal Mystery of our salvation, which we will celebrate these days with the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday). We will begin today with the blessing of the Palms, the Procession commemorating the solemn entrance of Jesus into the Holy City of Jerusalem with songs of "glory and hosanna" and listening to the narration of the Passion of Our Lord Jesus according to S. Luke. We know that St. Luke is the Evangelist of MERCY and the Passion is also imbued with signs of kindness, meekness and Mercy. Jesus grants the forgiveness to all men and women, even those who are his own enemies ... Jesus is an innocent condemned unjustly, and everyone recognizes him. Let's look at what they say: for the judges is an innocent victim, Herod can not condemn him, he does not find fault, and then he treats him as crazy. Pontius Pilate, for good 3 times will tell the accusers: I find no fault in this man ... but he condemns him to death. One of the crucified ones with Him (the good thief), affirms that he has not done anything bad ... The soldier who was at the foot of the cross stated: this man was just. This Crucified Christ is the heart of the world. He embraced the grief, the pains and the sufferings of humanity. We sinners receive the forgiveness of the patient and painful Christ and from His Heart that embraces the suffering with love for us, beats the heart of the humanity in need of justice, hope and salvation.

Let's live these days of the EASTER TRIDUUM participating in the celebrations:

**HOLY THURSDAY: LAST SUPPER:** Institution of the Eucharist, Ministerial Priesthood, with washing of the feet and adoration.

**GOOD FRIDAY:** Let us participate to the LIVING VIACRUCIS and the Rite of the PASSION of Good Friday.

**SATURDAY HOLY:** Celebration of the blessing of the New Fire, Light, Readings of the History of Salvation, Proclamation of the Resurrection and Sacraments of the CHRISTIAN INITIATION.

Let us pray that with a deep, religious look, that will transform into prayer, it will take us to the PASCUA with a serene and profound joy, the greatest of all: the joy of the TRIUMPH of the Risen One with the joy of New Life for you and me . Amen

Bless Lord our home. May your Son Jesus and the Virgin Mary reign in him.

Through your intercession give us peace, love and respect,  
so that by respecting and loving ourselves we can honor them in our



## Fr. Feccia's Reflection

**Settimana Santa.** La liturgia non esita ad accogliere la tragedia, presentandoci l'ora di Gesù, quell'ora di tenebre e di gloria per la quale egli ha detto di essere venuto. Lo seguiremo passo passo dall'ingresso a Gerusalemme tra le acclamazioni gioiose della folla dei discepoli, fino al Golgota, dove giungerà solo, abbandonato quasi da tutti quelli che gli erano stati vicini, dagli amici più cari, che egli

stesso aveva scelto e per i quali stava donando la propria vita. Gli eventi precipitano e tutto sembra sprofondare nel buio. Eppure, nel cuore della solitudine e dell'agonia, attira e riunisce in sé gli uomini e l'intero universo. Tutto sembra perduto. Tutto sta per ricominciare.

**Domenica delle palme e passione del Signore.** — Insieme ai figli di Israele, la chiesa partecipa oggi al trionfo profetico del Cristo, che entra nella città santa di Gerusalemme per passare da questo mondo al Padre.

I racconti della passione che si leggono in questa domenica costituiscono sicuramente il nucleo primitivo dei vangeli. Intorno ad una storia semplice, ma drammatica, si raccolgono preoccupazioni diverse, che influenzano il modo di riferire e di stendere per iscritto gli episodi della passione. Nell'intento di mostrare che il cristianesimo non ha nulla di un movimento sedizioso o criminale, si mette in evidenza il complotto che conduce alla morte di Gesù, così come l'innocenza del servo crocifisso per i peccatori. Di fronte al popolo d'Israele, si sottolinea la conformità di questa morte con le Scritture, che appaiono realizzare non solo nell'evento centrale della passione, ma anche nei particolari del suo svolgimento. Ci si preoccupa poi di inquadrare storicamente la crocifissione nella cornice della celebrazione della pasqua giudaica: si tratta di un sacrificio, di un nuovo rito di alleanza che si sostituisce all'immolazione dell'agnello, e infine si cerca di mettere in luce il valore dell'umiltà, della preghiera, della perseveranza e delle sofferenze destinate a perfezionare l'umanità di Gesù, per offrire alla chiesa un esempio e un insegnamento salutare.

Oltre a tutto questo, anche altri elementi della fede si chiariscono ai piedi della croce: il rapporto di Gesù con il giudaismo; l'origine e la missione della chiesa; il ruolo degli apostoli in generale, e in particolare di Pietro.

I racconti non si riducono quindi a un susseguirsi di episodi. Segnati dalla personalità di ogni evangelista, presentano un'unica storia, la cui caratteristica dominante è la vittoria di Dio sugli assalti del male, che raggiungono il culmine nella passione di nostro Signore Gesù Cristo.

**Re di padre** — L'entrata di Gesù in Gerusalemme attraverso il monte degli Ulivi (Zc. 14,4) appare come un'investitura regale, che pone le premesse per l'atto di accusa di un processo che si concluderà con una condanna: si è voluto fare re. Gesù è veramente il re della pace, molto più di Salomone. Una pace che non sarà ottenuta con la morte dei nemici, come sempre accade, ma con la morte di colui che l'annuncia.


