From the Pastor's Desk

Solemnity of the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven. The Lord "ascends" to heaven, after having spent **40 days appearing** to his own and inviting them to believe that **He has Risen** and that God has glorified Him and that He would take His place on the Right Hand of the Father. Concluding his mission on earth and preparing His farewell, before dying, Jesus was entrusting confidence to the disciples, telling them that He would go and prepare a place for them to be where He was going. To reassure them, Jesus added: "**You already know the way**" and He reiterates: "**I am the way, the truth and the life**". The Feast of the Ascension introduces us to the future's Glory that our Lord has conquered us. In effect, He is the first to inaugurate Heaven by entering with all his body, flesh and His life. We could say that from that day begin "**the new heaven**" and "**the new earth**". The Ascension is not only the entrance of a righteous into the kingdom of God, but the glorious enthronement of the Son - **the Savior "seated at the right hand of the Father"**, where you and I also hope to be able to arrive. While, we live the joy of the Ascension, we are preparing with great joy to the Solemnity of Pentecost, invoking the coming of the Holy Spirit that Jesus promised us, when He told us: "**All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me, and breathed on them and said to them: "Receive the Holy Spirit"**(Mt 28,18). It is my hope that the Paschal Spirit strengthens us in being His witnesses and as disciples, we may believe that He has loved and chosen us, and that He sends us to all corners of the world to bear fruits of love and peace. Let us remember that if we do not witness it, love ends. If we do not work for peace, the grass of violence and evil continue spreading. As a result, the true disciple of Jesus is a universal brother, a citizen of the world, who speaks the new language, the language of heaven, the language of love that touches and changes our hearts. 

Mensaje del Párroco

Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Jesús al Cielo. El Señor "asciende" al cielo, luego de haber pasado 40 días apareciendo a los suyos e invitándolos a creer que había resucitado y que Dios lo había glorificado y que tomaría su lugar a la **Derecha del Padre**. Concluyendo su misión en la tierra y despidiéndose de los suyos, antes de morir Jesús había dado confianza a los discípulos diciéndoles que iría a preparar un lugar para que fueran también ellos a donde Él iba. Para tranquilizarlos Jesús añadió: "**Ustedes ya saben el camino**" y les reitera: "**Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida**". La fiesta de la Ascensión nos introduce al futuro de la Gloria que nuestro Señor nos conquistó. En efecto, él es el primero que inaugura el Cielo entrando con todo su cuerpo, con su carne y su vida. Podríamos decir que desde aquel día comienzan "**el cielo nuevo**" y "**la tierra nueva**". La Ascensión no es solo la entrada de un justo en el reino de Dios, sino la gloriosa entronización del Hijo - el Salvador "**sentado a la diestra del Padre**", en donde tú y Yo esperamos también poder llegar.

Mientras, vivimos el gozo de la Ascensión nos estamos preparando con gran júbilo a la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, invocando la venida del Espíritu Santo que Jesús nos prometió, cuando nos dijo: "**Me ha sido dado todo poder en el cielo y en la tierra, y soplando sobre ellos pronunció las palabras, reciban al Espíritu Santo**", (Mt 28,18).

Es mi esperanza que el Espíritu Pascual, nos fortalezca en ser sus testigos y como discípulos creamos que él nos ha amado y nos ha elegido, y nos envía a todos los rincones del mundo para dar frutos de amor y de paz. Acordémonos que Si nosotros no lo comunicamos, el amor termina; si no trabajamos por la paz, crece la hierba de la violencia y el mal. 

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Ascensione del Signore — Anno “B”. L’ascensione non è un episodio che si possa descrivere isolatamente, ma una delle sfaccettature di quest’unico gioiello che è il mistero pasquale. Tra Pasqua e Pentecoste, è la festa dell’intervallo di tempo in cui Gesù risorto scompare agli occhi dei suoi, iniziando con loro un altro tipo di rapporto, talmente efficace che tutto sarà colmato dalla sua presenza. È un momento di passaggio, in cui i discepoli sono chiamati ad abbandonare la sponda familiare dei modi di presenza di prima, per la terra ancora sconosciuta in cui saranno invasi dallo Spirito del risorto. Il nuovo Elia viene tolto loro (Luca), ma l’Emanuele rimane presente alla sua Chiesa (Matteo) innalzato da Dio alla sua dignità regale (Marco).

Dopo la sua ultima apparizione, il Signore lascia apparentemente i suoi, ma la sua presenza invisibile si intensifica, raggiungendo una profondità e un’estensione che non era possibile quando egli si trovava ancora nel suo corpo terreno. Grazie allo Spirito, Gesù sarà sempre presente là dove ha insegnato agli Apostoli a riconoscerlo: nella parola, nei sacramenti, nei fratelli, e soprattutto nella missione. Non si tratta dunque di contemplare il cielo, ma di essere i testimoni del risorto sulla terra degli uomini, di collaborare con lui alla crescita del suo regno.

Mistero divino e soprannaturale, l’ascensione esprime anche il senso profondo di ogni separazione umana. Viene a pensare al finale del *Piccolo Principe*: «Anch’io oggi torno a casa... E quando ti sarai consolato (ci si consola sempre), sarai contento di avermi conosciuto. Sarai sempre mio amico... E qualche volta aprirai la finestra, così, per il piacere di farlo... Sarà come se ti avessi regalato, invece delle stelle, migliaia di campanelli che sanno ridere». (A. de Saint-Ezupery).

La missione della chiesa. — Marco riunisce nel fatto dell’ascensione la gioia di Cristo e la missione della chiesa. Colui che ha toccato il fondo della miseria umana Dio lo ha esaltato; a colui che è stato contraddetto e disprezzato, Dio oggi conferma tutta la sua compiacenza, che già gli aveva annunciato all’inizio della vita pubblica. Ormai non c’è più un minuto da perdere: se tale è il modo di agire di Dio, è urgente annunciare ovunque questa parola di liberazione autentica. Gli uomini sanno ormai che uno di loro è già alla destra di Dio e vi attira irresistibilmente i suoi fratelli.




