

From the Pastor's Desk

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION. We are living the Easter season enlightened by the Word of God with joy, happiness and peace. In these 40 days, we have read the significant exhortations and farewell speeches of Jesus that we find in the chapters of the Gospel of Saint John, from 13 to 17, where Jesus encourages his own to believe, be courageous, remain united to him, in order to be able to produce fruits of true evangelical and Christian life. Likewise, motivated in this Easter season with the powerful and exciting experiences of the apostles and the first Christian communities, I believe that in the midst of the times that we are living with epidemic, violence, uncertainty and crisis of authentic values of truth and of justice,

realizing to how the first Christian communities lived in harmony, unity and fraternity. This encourages us all to move forward revived with many hopes for better future. The Risen Lord affirmed his own with his appearances, signs, and teachings to the fidelity of his message. Today, we celebrate how Jesus says goodbye and goes up to heaven, where he promised us that he would prepare a place for us so that all of us could one day be with him forever in the glory of eternity. Yes, we believe that the feast of the Ascension opens for us the future of light and glory. There, where we will find "the new heaven and the new earth"; that is to say: the new Jerusalem where in heaven will be our eternal reward. In the Gospel, Jesus calls us to be witnesses of this mystery of salvation for all peoples, taking the Good News to the last corners of the earth. Each disciple of Jesus must be committed to the mission of universality of our Lord, to achieve that we need to live our universal brotherhood, be citizens of the world and a true sign of God's kingdom. The disciple of Jesus speaks the new language, that of heaven, the language of love that touches, changes and transforms our hearts. Empowered with the spirit of Jesus, they will cast out demons, that is, to eliminate negative thoughts of loneliness, individualism, indifference, habits of revenge, hatred, division, violence, injustice and enmity. We are not expected to be the perfect man or woman to communicate the Gospel, but to be faithful people. We know, God has chosen us as sinners, but with his great mercy, He forgives us and enables us to witness the gospel of love. This is the journey to ascend to heaven and be true disciples of the Lord. He who ascended to heaven opened the door for us and assures us that now the heaven will also be ours. He entrusts to us, the disciples of all times with the task of pushing history and creation towards this perfect glory. With Jesus spirit, we can cast out demons and speak the new language of love; and we can neutralize the tempting snakes and defeat the poisonous evil of life; and so, we can heal the sick and comfort those in need. This is the force that sustains and guides the disciples to the ends of the earth and into the future of history. The Gospel of Mark ends up commissioning the disciples to go and preach his message everywhere, knowing that He will always be with us.

Scalabrin: we remember that it was on the day of the Ascension, that our founder father, Blessed John Baptist Scalabrin, entered the glory of eternity, leaving us to live, believe and bear witness to the commandment of love for the Risen Lord, particularly being Good News of love with our migrant brothers. Let us pray that through the intercession of Blessed Scalabrin, we can serve the migrants with the affection and care that he taught us. This is why, we are happy to be able to thank the Lord and Fr. Pat Murphy (who you know well) for having opened a new migrants' house in Tijuana, Mexico, three days ago. It is a house that trains and certifies many of the deportees who through specific workshops, they will continue improving their own lives.



Del Escritorio del Párroco:

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA ASCENSIÓN. Estamos viviendo iluminados de la Palabra de Dios con gozo, alegría y paz el tiempo pascual. **En estos 40 días**, hemos leído las significativas exhortaciones y discursos de despedida de Jesús que encontramos en los capítulos del evangelio de San Juan, del 13 al 17, en donde Jesús anima a los suyos a creer, ser valientes, permanecer unidos a Él, para poder producir frutos de verdadera vida evangélica y cristiana. Así mismo, motivado en este tiempo pascual con las poderosas y emocionantes vivencias de los apóstoles y las primeras comunidades cristianas, creo que en el medio de los tiempos que estamos viviendo de epidemia, de violencias, incertidumbre y crisis de valores auténticos de verdad y de justicia, escuchar como las primeras comunidades cristianas vivían en armonía, unidad y

fraternidad, nos anima a todos a seguir adelante reanimados de muchas esperanzas por mejores tiempos. Luego, que Jesús resucitado afirmaba los suyos con sus apariciones, gestos, enseñanzas a la fidelidad de su mensaje. Hoy, celebramos como Jesús se despide y sube al cielo, donde nos ha prometido que iba a prepararnos un sitio para que todos nosotros, pudiéramos un día estar para siempre con Él en la gloria de la eternidad. Si, creemos que la fiesta de la Ascensión nos abre a este futuro de luz y gloria, allí en donde encontraremos "el cielo nuevo y la tierra nueva"; es decir: la nueva Jerusalén del cielo será nuestro premio eterno. En el Evangelio Jesús nos hace el llamado a ser testigos de este misterio de salvación para todos los pueblos, llevando la Buena Nueva hasta los últimos rincones de la tierra. Cada discípulo de Jesús debe estar comprometido a la misión de universalidad de nuestro Señor, para alcanzar que todos seamos hermanos universales, ciudadanos del mundo, familiares de todos. El discípulo de Jesús habla la lengua nueva, la del cielo, la lengua del amor que toca, cambia y transforma los corazones; expulsa los demonios, es decir, elimina los pensamientos negativos de soledad, individualismo, indiferencia, costumbres de venganza, de odio, de división, de violencia, de injusticia y de enemistad. No se nos pide ser el hombre o la mujer perfectas para comunicar el Evangelio. Sabemos, Dios nos ha elegido como pecadores, pero con su gran misericordia nos perdona y habilita para comunicar el evangelio del amor. Este es el camino para ascender al cielo y ser verdadero discípulos suyos. El Señor que ascendido al cielo nos abrió la puerta y nos asegura que ahora también será nuestro cielo y nuestra seguridad. Él nos promete el futuro que Él ya ha alcanzado plenamente. A nosotros los discípulos de todos los tiempos nos encomienda la tarea de empujar la historia y la creación hacia este destino común: ellos tienen el poder de expulsar demonios y hablar la lengua nueva del amor; pueden neutralizar las serpientes tentadoras y derrotar las insidias venenosas de la vida; pueden curar a los enfermos y consolar a quien lo necesita. Esta es la fuerza que sostiene y guía a los discípulos hasta los confines de la tierra y hacia el futuro de la historia. El Evangelio de Marcos termina comisionándonos a ir a predicar Su mensaje por todas partes, sabiendo que Él estará siempre con nosotros.

Scalabrin: recordamos que fue en el día de la Ascensión, que **nuestro padre fundador el Beato Juan Bautista Scalabrin** entró en la gloria de la eternidad, dejándonos el ligado de vivir, creer y testimoniar el mandamiento del amor del resucitado, particularmente **siendo Buena Nueva de amor con nuestros hermanos migrantes**. Roguemos porque por intercesión del Beato Scalabrin podamos atender a los migrantes con el cariño y solicitud que el nos enseño. Por eso nos alegra poder agradecerle al Señor y al P. Pat Murphy (que ustedes bien conocen) haber hace tres días abierto **una nueva casa del migrante** en Tijuana, México para capacitar y certificar muchos de los deportados a través de talleres para que puedan seguir mejorando su realidad de vida.


