## From the Pastor's Desk

### V SUNDAY OF EASTER – REFLECTION: OF THE COMING UP FEAST OF OLMC.

Dear Devotees, parishioners and friends of Our Lady of Mount Carmel:

I hope you all are doing well and enjoying the spring weather that finally is arriving. We already start working in preparing the **126 Anniversary of our Feast of OLMC**. I am pretty sure that in most of us, it is still alive in our hearts the splendor of the meaningful and beautiful celebration of the 125<sup>th</sup> Jubilee Anniversary, we shared last year with our shepherd Cardinal Blase Cupich and many devotees. What a spiritual moment of grace, it was!

I want to commend the entire community for their tremendous dedication, generosity and hard work in preparing the great 125<sup>th</sup> Jubilee Anniversary and I am positive that we will continue doing well in the future with significant activities that we will plan to venerate and honor our Blessed Mother.

While we recognized and commend all those who have carried out our devotion and tradition to La Madonna del Carmine for so many years, **we do realize how much our community has changed and how some adjustments are needed**. Mind you, we enter in a new quarter of century and so we are reflecting on the overall impact of the Feast from the religious, cultural, social and economic outcome. It seems that based on the recently outcome, **we see ourselves forced to readjust our celebration and festival in honor to Our Lady**.

We do realize our difficult are such decisions, but **with a heartfelt compassion, we see ourselves impelled** to determine that we cannot support the Festival as we are accustomed to, **due to some heavy financial burdens**.

I would like on the behalf of the committee and myself **to share with you some of the changes that we are contemplating** for our next Annual Feast Celebration with the intention of treasuring our religious roots and the meaning of the original Feast. **We want to emphasize that the religious and spiritual spirit of the Feast and the religious celebrations will not be impacted, they will remain exactly the same.** These are some of the changes, we would implement:

**We will curtail the street Festival, which means no more the carnival and games.**

**We will eliminate the food stands and the street festival, and have the social event with food, drinks and entertainment the last three nights: Friday, Saturday and Sunday.**

**We will have the car show on Saturday morning as usual.**

**We also plan to offer free refreshments every night after Novena to spend some time together and socialize.**

The Novena will be prayed every night from July 5<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:30PM in the Church followed by coffee. The Caliendo's Band will march through the streets, presentation of the banners, offering of roses, memorial service for deceased members of the Feast Committee and the traditional Sunday morning Mass followed by the short procession and the noon Outdoor Mass followed by Procession and Benediction in Church will be taken place as usual.

Believe me, the committee struggled in these changes, but we all believe, they are necessary due to the high cost of running the Feast and the decreased attendance at the Street Festival. **We want to assure you that we will continue to celebrate this wonderful tradition as it was intended, a Feast to honor and venerate our Blessed Mother.**

In closing, "mille grazie" and I am certain that you continue loving, venerating and supporting La Madonna del Carmine and I pray that the Blessed Virgin Mother of Mount Carmel embraces and presents you and your entire family to Her Son Jesus asking to pour His grace and blessings upon you to experience the tenderness and sweetness of Our Lady loving intercession.



## Fr. Feccia's Reflection

**Quinta domenica di Pasqua** — Non appena Giuda ha abbandonato il cenacolo, nella notte, Gesù affida ai discepoli il suo testamento spirituale, annunciando così la sua partenza per la casa del Padre, condizione indispensabile per la glorificazione di Dio e del figlio dell'uomo. Rimaniamo sorpresi dai termini che scandiscono l'inizio di questo discorso d'addio: «Ora...subito...per poco tempo». Di quale intervallo di tempo si tratta? Senza dubbio del tempo che segue la pasqua, durante il quale Gesù, già nel pieno possesso della sua gloria nel seno del Padre, ne attende ancora, con la sua chiesa, la piena manifestazione. Parole inquietanti vengono pronunciate all'inizio di questa attesa, che è anche la nostra.

Gesù non sarà più con i discepoli, non perché ha deciso di lasciarli soli, abbandonati a se stessi, ma perché devono passare dall'abitudine della sua presenza fisica, alla fede nella sua presenza invisibile, nel cuore stesso dell'assenza. Sperimentare, per mezzo della fede, la sua presenza nell'assenza, è una delle caratteristiche fondamentali della vita cristiana fino alla parusia (*ritorno nel Signore alla fine dei tempi*)

Ma c'è un altro aspetto, altrettanto essenziale: risuscitare la presenza del figlio dell'uomo attraverso la pratica del comandamento nuovo, amandoci gli uni gli altri come egli ci ha amati.

Questo amore reciproco è garanzia e manifestazione della presenza permanente del risorto in mezzo ai suoi. L'amore scambievole è dunque il comportamento specifico dei cristiani nel tempo che va dalla partenza di Gesù al suo ritorno definitivo. È la carità, frutto dell'amore di Gesù per i suoi, che rende i cristiani perfetti discepoli e rivela la presenza invisibile del Signore della chiesa. «*Vedete come si amano*»; insieme all'Eucarestia, non c'è altro segno distintivo, perché si tratta del nostro modo concreto, l'unico valido, di vivere la fede pasquale.

«*Vi dò un comandamento nuovo*», dice il Signore, «*che vi amiate a vicenda, come io ho amato voi*». Gesù glorificato partecipa alla vita del Padre. Dio non vive più soltanto nella sfera celeste; d'ora in poi vive anche nel cuore dell'uomo. Per un ebreo, essere glorificato, significa dare valore alla propria esistenza, rivelare le proprie reali capacità. Il prezzo dell'esistenza, ciò per cui vale la pena d'essere vissuta, è l'amore: l'amore che Gesù ha manifestato per gli uomini, e l'amore che noi testimoniamo gli uni per gli altri.
