From the Pastor's Desk

VI EASTER SUNDAY. We are one week away from the Ascension and two from Pentecost and this week's liturgy leads us once again to the exciting words of Jesus during the Last Supper. The first point underscored by Jesus is that of the disciples' love relationship with the Lord. Jesus' statement is clear: "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home in him". Jesus puts in close relationship the love for him and the observance of his Word. To find God we do not need miracles, new apparitions or revelations, Jesus repeats: "He who listens and puts into practice the Gospel loves the Lord and the Word they are hearing is not mine, but of the Father who sent me". We know that the Gospel is the Word of

God and this is more than enough to take advantage of salvation. Someone could object that two thousand years ago we received the Gospel and that little or nothing has changed in the world and we still lack the fruits of the Kingdom of God. Years ago, Father Mien, a Russian Orthodox parish priest killed in the early eighties in Zagorsk, wisely said: "Do not believe that the Gospel has already said everything, because in reality we are just beginning to understand it". Could it be true? We are just beginning to really understand the Gospel and the understanding that we are having demands a passionate adhesion and a full participation of all of us. Actually, we do not need more words: we must, and urgently, deepen and love the only Word that the Lord has given us, meaning: HIS WORD! It is what Jesus said to his disciples in their time and he repeats them to us today: "I have told you these things while I am with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I have told you". Jesus had understood that the disciples were forgetful and prone to incomprehension; and we are not different from them. That is why he added that he would send the Holy Spirit as the interior teacher of the disciples and of every believer. Let us prepare ourselves to invoke the Holy Spirit in these coming days so that we will be filled with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and have the fruits of the Holy Spirit transform our lives into a living Gospel

MEMORIAL MASS FOR FR. PETER SORDI, C.S.

We invite you and all his friends to join us in a memorial Mass at Our Lady Of Mount Carmel Church on Saturday, June 1st at 11:00AM. to pray for Fr. Peter and to share a moment of remembrance in his honor.

Fr. Peter who was born on Feb. 6, 1920 in Piacenza, Italy entered into eternal life March 2019 at age of 99. He was ordained priest, 1945 and he spent all his scalabrinian religious, priest and missionary life in our Western Province. Many of his ministerial years, he served in parishes of Chicago: Holy Guardian Angels, Our Lady of Pompei, Sacred Heart Seminary, St. Callistus, O.L. Pompei, OLMC., and the Provincial House. On his fortieth anniversary of priesthood, the superior general wrote: "*You have put into action the precious gifts that God has given you at every level of your forty years of active apostolate as a parish vicar, a professor, a pastor, a provincial superior, a general councilor and a general administrator*". Fr. Sordi was a wise man of great vision and example who served God's people and the migrants with love and dedication. He retired at Arco in Italy in 2012 he wrote: "*It is not easy for me to leave the confreres with whom I shared life and mission for many years. However, at 92 years of age, I think it is better for me to retire and pray for the young ones and the religious who are serving the migrants.*" Wise until the end, he continues now to pray in the house of the Father.

Del Escritorio del Párroco

VI DOMINGO DE PASCUA. Estamos a una semana de la Ascensión y a dos de Pentecostés y la Liturgia de esta semana nos lleva una vez más a las emocionantes palabras de Jesús durante la Última Cena. El primer punto que subraya Jesús es el de la relación de amor de los discípulos por el Señor. La afirmación de Jesús es clara: "Si alguno me ama, guardará mi palabra, y mi Padre lo amará, y vendremos a él, y haremos morada en él". Jesús pone en estrecha relación el amor por él y la observancia de su Palabra. Para encontrar a Dios no necesitamos ni milagros, ni apariciones ni revelaciones nuevas, repite Jesús: "quien escucha y pone en práctica el Evangelio ama al Señor y la palabra que están oyendo no es mía, sino del Padre, que me envío". Sabemos que el

Evangelio es la Palabra de Dios y esto es más que suficiente para aprovechar la salvación. Alguien podría objetar que ya hace dos mil años que hemos recibido el Evangelio y que poco o nada ha cambiado en el mundo y nos falta para gozar los frutos del Reino de Dios. Hace años, el padre Mien, párroco ruso ortodoxo asesinado a inicios de los años ochenta en Zagorsk, decía con sabiduría: "No crean que el Evangelio lo ha dicho ya todo, porque en realidad apenas estamos empezando a comprenderlo". Verdad? Apenas estamos empezando a comprender realmente el Evangelio y la comprensión que vamos teniendo requiere una adhesión apasionada y una participación total de todos nosotros. En realidad, no necesitamos más palabras: debemos, y con urgencia, profundizar y amar la única Palabra que el Señor nos ha donado, es decir: SU PALABRA! Es lo que Jesús dijo a sus discípulos de entonces y nos repite hoy a nosotros: "Les he dicho estas cosas estando entre ustedes. Pero el Paráclito, el Espíritu Santo, que el Padre enviará en mi nombre, les enseñará todo y les recordará todo lo que yo les he dicho". Jesús había entendido que los discípulos eran olvidadizos y propensos a la incomprendición; y nosotros no somos distintos de ellos. Por eso añadió que enviaría al Espíritu Santo como maestro interior de los discípulos y de todo creyente. Preparémonos a invocar en los próximos días al Espíritu Santo para que nos llenes de sus dones y haga que sus frutos del Espíritu transforme nuestra vida en un Evangelio vivo.



Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Sesta domenica di pasqua — Quando san Giovanni scriveva il suo vangelo, era uno dei pochi discepoli ancora viventi che avevano conosciuto il Signore. I primi destinatari del quarto vangelo non si trovavano dunque in una situazione diversa dalla nostra: anch'essi dovevano cercare soltanto nella fede la certezza che il risorto è presente dovunque nel mondo, ma in un modo tutto

particolare con una «presenza nell'assenza». Dobbiamo confessare che facciamo molta fatica a vivere questa realtà: più o meno consapevolmente, portiamo sempre dentro di noi il vecchio sogno di un regno visibile e ben localizzabile. Eppure dovremmo sapere che, ritornando al Padre, il Cristo non ha cessato di agire. La morte non ha interrotto l'azione feconda della sua parola nel mondo, che era appena iniziata. Ma bisognava che egli se ne andasse, perché questa parola liberata da ogni limite di tempo e luogo, si diffondesse su tutta la terra, si acclimatasse sotto ogni cielo, germogliasse e portasse frutto dal suo terreno d'origine, dovunque trovasse un solco pronto ad accoglierla. Si tratta ormai di una parola vivente, animata dallo Spirito che richiede e stimola la nostra iniziativa e ci spinge, non a ripetere senza stancarci, ma a cercare nuovi significati, a sviluppare implicazioni inedite, che verranno alla luce nella misura in cui faremo riferimento al vangelo per giudicare le situazioni, per decidere le nostre scelte; come la scienza progredisce, così la nostra conoscenza del vangelo progredisce. Il tempo della *presenza nell'assenza*, dunque, è anche quello della nostra responsabilità: senza irrigidirci su posizioni già acquisite, dobbiamo assumere, nella fede e nella speranza, il rischio di dare risposte coraggiose ai problemi sempre nuovi che la vita ci pone. È un raschio che bisogna correre nello Spirito. La nostra condizione è esaltante e mera-vigliosa: «*Abbiamo deciso, lo Spirito santo e noi...*» (Atti 15,28).

Gesù promette una presenza intima e rivelante dello Spirito — Al centro del brano odierno sta la domanda di Giuda: «*com'è accaduto che devi rivelarti a noi e non al modo?*» (V. 22)

Dopo la promessa della pace, quella che solo Cristo sa dare, viene la promessa dello Spirito (v.26): essa è una garanzia di assistenza su tutto ciò che la chiesa intraprende. Lo Spirito è dato alla chiesa, quando essa cerca di amare il suo Signore e ubbidirgli. È nell'ubbidienza di amore a Cristo, dopo la prova della passione, la chiesa scopre la gioia (v.28). D'ora in poi Cristo si manifesta attraverso la chiesa quando essa ama il Signore nell'obbedienza della fede e quando vive la gioia piena che suscita lo Spirito in lei.


