From the Pastor's Desk

PENTECOST SUNDAY. We crowned the Easter journey, after having celebrated the **ASCENSION** of the Risen Lord who ascended to heaven with the Solemnity of Pentecost. Exactly fifty days after Easter, the apostles "**were all gathered together in the cenacle.**" They had listened to the recommendation of Jesus, who before ascending to heaven had told them: "**You remain in the city until you will be clothed with power from on high.**" While they were in the cenacle, where they had celebrated the last supper, gathered in prayer, for fear of

the Jews came Pentecost. While the community of disciples and Mary prayed, they were surprised with a tremendous experience and were immersed in a gust of wind that filled the whole house. After the wind appeared "**tongues like fire that were distributed and rested on each one of them**". The Holy Spirit descended on them, and since then the apostles who lived scared, fearful and paralyzed by their feelings, experienced a tremor, as if it were an earthquake. However, they were not tremors and external effects, but the manifestation of the power of God that destroyed in them the barriers and the walls that trapped their hearts and heads. It was a "new energy" that seized them. They left the cenacle and began to communicate the Gospel to all the people they found in the plaza or in front of them. Luke writes in the Acts of the Apostles that there were Jews of all the nations under heaven and he names them, one by one, showing precisely the universality of the new people of God. That day the universality of God's love was clearly manifested. Thus, the Church took her first steps, as a chosen people who is sent to proclaim God's love to all the peoples of the earth. Pentecost immerses us in this mystery of universal mission. The Lord draws all of us from the power on high. so that we can communicate the Gospel of God to all the nations. He gives us a new energy to effectively speak about Jesus to the people of this world. Let Pentecost 2019 pour on each one of us Christians those tongues of fire, capable of communicating the Gospel of Jesus Christ so that we may be clothed in that fire that burns and transforms and forces us to be true witnesses of his love, committed to create a world that is always more human, just and peaceful. Hopefully, the words of Jesus to his disciples will also be truthful for us: "**Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.**" Let us pray that the Lord will empower us with his Spirit to be able to raise up, liberate, heal, sanctify and love in His name and thus, enjoy together a New Pentecost of universality and fraternity as **Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini** always entrusted us. Amen.

DOMINGO DE PENTECOSTES. Coronamos el camino pascual, luego de haber celebrado la **ASCENSIÓN** del resucitado que subió al cielo con la Solemnidad de Pentecostés. Exactamente cincuenta días después de la Pascua, los apóstoles "estaban todos reunidos en el cenaculo". Habían escuchado la recomendación de Jesús, que antes de subir al cielo les había dicho: "**Ustedes permanezcan en la ciudad hasta que sean revestidos del poder de lo alto**". Mientras, se encontraban en el cenaculo, en donde había celebrado la última cena, reunido en oración, por miedo a los judíos llegó Pentecostés,

Propiamente, mientras la comunidad de los discípulos y María oraban, fueron sorprendido con una tremenda experiencia y fueron inmerso en una ráfaga de viento que llenó toda la casa. Junto al viento aparecieron "**unas lenguas como de fuego que se repartieron y se posaron sobre cada uno de ellos**". El Espíritu Santo descendió sobre ellos, y desde entonces los apostoles que vivían asustados, miedosos y paralizados por sus sentimientos, experimentaron una sacudida, como si de un terremoto se tratara. Sin embargo, no eran temblores y efectos externos, sino la manifestacion del poder de Dios que destruyó en ellos las barreras y las paredes que les atrapaban el corazón y la cabeza. Fue una "**nueva energía**" que se apoderó de ellos, salieron del cenáculo y empezaron a comunicar el Evangelio a todas las personas que encontraron en la plaza o que tenían delante. Lucas escribe en los Hechos de los Apostoles que habían judíos de todas las naciones que hay bajo el cielo y los nombra, uno a uno, dando muestra precisamente de la universalidad del nuevo pueblo de Dios. Aquel día se manifestó con claridad la universalidad del amor de Dios. Así daba la Iglesia sus primeros pasos, como un pueblo elegido y enviado a todos los pueblos de la tierra. **Pentecostés nos sumerge en este misterio de misión universal.** El Señor nos reviste a todos del poder de lo alto. para que podamos comunicar el Evangelio de Dios a todos los pueblos. Él nos da una energía nueva para hablar con eficacia de Jesús a las personas de este mundo. Que está Pentecostés 2019 haga descender sobre cada uno de nosotros cristianos aquellas lenguas como de fuego, lenguas capaces de comunicar el Evangelio de Jesuscristo para que seamos revestido de aquel fuego que quema y transforma y nos empuje a ser verdadero testigos de su amor, comprometido a crear un mundo siempre más humano, justo y pacifico. Ojalá, que las palabras de Jesús a sus discípulos sean también valida para nosotros: "Reciban el Espíritu Santo, a quienes perdonen los pecados, les queden perdonados y a quienes se los retengan, les queden retenidos". Recemos porque El Señor nos apodere de su Espiritu para poder levantar, liberar, sanar, santificar y amar en su nombre y así gozar juntos una **Nueva Pentecostés de universalidad y fraternidad** como nos encomendaba siempre el Beato Juan Bautista Scalabrini. Amen.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Domenica di Pentecoste — La solennità di Pentecoste celebra un avvenimento capitale per la Chiesa: la sua presentazione al mondo, la nascita ufficiale con il battesimo nello Spirito. Compimento della Pasqua, la venuta dello Spirito sui discepoli manifesta la ricchezza della vita nuova del Risorto nel cuore e nell'attività dei discepoli; l'inizio dell'espansione della Chiesa e principio della

sua fecondità, essa si rinnova misteriosamente oggi per noi, come in ogni assemblea eucaristica e sacramentale e, in molteplici forme, nella vita dei singoli e dei gruppi sino alla fine dei tempi. La «pienezza» dello Spirito è la caratteristica dei tempi messianici, preparati dalla segreta attività dello Spirito di Dio che «*ha parlato per mezzo dei profeti*» e ispira in ogni tempo gli atti di bontà, giustizia e religiosità degli uomini, finché trovino in Cristo il loro senso definitivo.

Lo Spirito dell'alleanza universale e definitiva. —È d'obbligo collegare l'evento del Sinai e quello di Gerusalemme all'assemblea delle 12 tribù corrispose quella dei 12 apostoli, nuovo Israele: fuoco e vento manifestano la presenza del Dio vivente; è data la legge dell'alleanza, legge di libertà che qualifica i figli di Dio. Non più limitata ad un popolo scelto per far conoscere il vero Dio, l'alleanza è aperta a tutti i popoli e a tutte le razze; non più caratterizzata nel segno della carne (la circoncisione), essa è spirituale e si esprime nella fede e nel battesimo; non più rinnovata da uomini mortali nel corso della storia, essa è fondata sul Cristo «*che rimane in eterno*». E proprio perché è spirituale e definitiva, ogni sua incarnazione attuale nella Chiesa del nostro tempo con le sue istituzioni e nelle diverse Chiese del nostro tempo sparse su tutta la terra con le loro peculiarità, ha valore sacramentale (cioè porta salvezza) ma anche relativo e caduco.

Lo Spirito della fedeltà e del coraggio. Il battesimo nello Spirito illumina la comunità degli amici di Cristo nel suo mistero di Messia, Signore e Figlio di Dio; fa loro comprendere la sua risurrezione come il compimento dei progetti di salvezza di Dio non solo per il popolo d'Israele ma per tutto il mondo; li spinge ad annunciarlo in tutte le lingue e in ogni circostanza senza temere né persecuzioni, né morte. Come gli Apostoli, e i martiri e tutti i cristiani che hanno dato ascolto fino in fondo la voce dello Spirito di Cristo, diventano testimoni: di ciò che hanno visto, di ciò che hanno trasmesso e che hanno verificato nella loro esistenza. Nel mondo di oggi ogni nostra comunità è chiamata a collaborare con lo Spirito della nuova vita per rinnovare il mondo: nell'attività quotidiana come nelle vocazioni straordinarie, e questo senza perdersi di coraggio perché «*Io Spirito viene in aiuto alla nostra debolezza*»(Rm. 8,26) corregge e potenzia il nostro sforzo, fa convergere tutto al bene comune (2nd lettura) perché ogni dono viene da Lui, unico Spirito del Padre e del Figlio.

Tutta la nostra vita di cristiani è dunque sotto il segno dello Spirito che abbiamo ricevuto nel battesimo e nella cresima, nostra Pentecoste: in essa devono maturare i frutti dello Spirito» (Gal. 5,22a): amore, pace, gioia, pazienza, benevolenza, bontà, fedeltà, mitezza, dominio di sé... come fu per Cristo Jesu.

Vieni, Spirito Santo— La prima effusione dello Spirito avviene nella sera di Pasqua. Il soffio (alito) di Gesù simbolizza lo Spirito, principio della nuova creazione (Gn. 1,22) in cui Cristo deve il suo titolo di secondo Adamo allo Spirito che possiede in seguito alla risurrezione. Come in Atti 1,8; 13,2-4 il conferimento dello Spirito agli Apostoli è segno di missione. Essi, in forza dello Spirito, saranno i portatori di quella salvezza che Gesù come Agnello, ha realizzato nella sua passione e che si concretizza nel perdono dei peccati e del dono dello Spirito.
