From the Pastor's Desk



This is a special weekend for our parish. We are celebrating the **Golden Jubilee of the Consecration of our Church and Shrine**. We, - the community of faith of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, - has its roots in the faith of a strong and dedicated woman Emanuella De Stefano who started the **devotion of "La Madonna del Carmine"** in the neighborhood, in the early days of 1894, which blossom into the vibrant community of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. At the end of the 19th Century a Small Chapel was erected to host the image of the Blessed Mother. The growing membership forced the search for a new location. In the beginning of the 20th century, the **Chapel was moved to a new and present location**. Realizing our insufficient the Chapel was, activities started to provide a more appropriate worshipping place. 1907 a new Church was built, which it served the community until 1967, when a **cornerstone was laid to build the Beautiful Modern Style Church** that we enjoy today. It was completed and consecrated on June 9, 1968. In these 50th years, the **Parish, once an Italian community, has embraced immigrants of all backgrounds**, their descendants and all God's people who come and worship in our community. We are grateful to God, because our parish has nourished the life of many men and women of different ethnicities whom at OLMC have born to new life in Baptism, nourished themselves in the Eucharist, received the fullness of the Spirit at Confirmation, joint their lives in Marriage, buried their loved ones and experienced God's consolation in the witnesses of faith of many committed Christians and Scalabrinian Priests and Brothers who served at OLMC with dedications for many years.

This joyful Golden Celebration, under the protection of our Lady of Mount Carmel and the **Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini**, father of the migrants, be for you and I an opportunity to renew our gratitude, faith and commitment to continue incarnating and witnessing the Gospel of Jesus.

Mensaje del Párroco

Este es un fin de semana muy especial para nuestra Parroquia-Santuario. Estamos celebrando el **Jubileo de Oro de la Consagración de Nuestra Iglesia y Santuario**. Nosotros - la comunidad de fe de Nuestra Señora de Monte Carmelo – que tiene sus raíces en la fe de una mujer fuerte y dedicada Emanuella De Stefano, quien comenzó la devoción de "La Madonna del Carmine" en nuestro Village de Melrose Park, en los primeros días de 1894, desde luego en donde floreció la vibrante comunidad que conocemos: La Parroquia de Nuestra Señora de Monte Carmelo.

A fines del siglo XIX, se erigió una pequeña Capilla para cubijar la imagen de la Santísima Madre. La creciente membresía forzó la búsqueda de una nueva ubicación. En el comienzo del siglo XX, la **Capilla se trasladó a un lugar nuevo, que es el actual**. Pronto la Capilla fue insuficiente, así se pusieron manos a la obra para proporcionar un lugar de culto más apropiado. En 1907 se construyó una Nueva Iglesia, que sirvió a la comunidad hasta 1967. Pronto se colocó una piedra angular para construir la hermosa Iglesia de estilo moderno que disfrutamos hoy. Fue completada y consagrada el 9 de junio de 1968. En estos 50 años, la Parroquia-Santuario, que un tiempo era principalmente una comunidad italiana, fue acogiendo a inmigrantes de todas las etnias, sus descendientes y todos el pueblo de Dios, que aquí encontraron su segunda familia. Estamos agradecidos con Dios, porque Nuestra Parroquia ha enriquecido la vida de muchos hombres y mujeres de diferentes orígenes que en OLMC han nacido a una nueva vida en el Bautismo, se alimentaron de Jesus en la Eucaristía, recibieron la plenitud del Espíritu en la Confirmación, unieron sus vidas en el sacramento del matrimonio, enterraron a sus seres queridos y experimentaron el consuelo de Dios en los testimonios de fe de muchos cristianos comprometidos, sacerdotes y hermanos scalabrinianos que sirvieron la Iglesia de OLMC con dedicaciones durante muchos años.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Decima Domenica del T.O. — Anno “B” — Il brano evangelico di oggi ci presenta un episodio del ministero di Gesù che non mancherà di sorprenderci: sua madre e i suoi cugini si recano a Cafarnao per prenderlo con sé e ricondurlo alla ragione. Possibile che la sua famiglia sia cieca fino a questo punto? Non si rendono conto che il messia non deve essere ostacolato nel suo cammino, che nessuno può impedirgli di compiere la sua missione?

Per capire il loro atteggiamento, bisogna ricordare che i primi trent'anni di Gesù erano trascorsi nell'oscura banalità di una vita simile a quella di tutti gli altri. Poi, all'improvviso, questo uomo abbandona il suo villaggio e si mette a percorrere il paese avanzando pretese enormi, come quella di correggere la Legge e le venerabili tradizioni del popolo eletto. Come accettare tutto questo? In effetti, lo zelo di Gesù per la casa di suo Padre appare eccessivo, quasi folle, e la sua famiglia ha molti buoni motivi per essere preoccupata. Ma egli non cesserà di sconcertarli, fino alla suprema follia della croce. Maria ed alcuni parenti si lasceranno trascinare fino al Calvario. Quanta fatica per accettare questo uomo, e quanto ancora ne dovranno fare per comprenderlo!

Ben diversamente grave e inquietante è il giudizio perentorio pronunciato dagli scribi. L'evangelista non ha dubbi: è una bestemmia contro lo Spirito Santo, la cui gravità deriva dal fatto che non si tratta più semplicemente di un errore sulla persona di Gesù, ma di un rifiuto positivo e deliberato della grazia e della rivelazione. Chiamare satana il figlio di Dio significa collocarsi al di fuori della salvezza.

La scelta si pone ancora oggi: con il Cristo o contro di Lui? Bisogna essere un po' pazzi per seguirlo, non bisogna essere troppo «*ragionevoli*» se si vuole appartenere alla vera parentela di Gesù: quella che trova in Lui la propria famiglia e la propria casa.

Una nuova famiglia — Dopo aver scelto i Dodici come apostoli, Gesù fonda la nuova famiglia dei figli di Dio. Condizione per essere ammessi: accogliere la parola di Cristo, il fratello maggiore. Non tutti però, credono: i suoi concittadini, i suoi stessi parenti non comprendono la sua missione e lo giudicano pazzo o un indemoniato. Tuttavia, Gesù è categorico: chi rifiuta la salvezza che egli propone, non ne troverà un'altra. Poiché la fede cristiana è un libero impegno, non sono più legami naturali che fanno l'unità, ma l'obbedienza allo Spirito di Dio che si rivela in Cristo. Tutti coloro che accolgono la parola di Gesù sono figli adottivi di Dio e fratelli tra loro.


