From the Pastor's Desk

SUNDAY OF CORPUS CHRISTI. Last week we reflected on the mystery of the HOLY TRINITY and this Sunday we meditate the mystery of the HOLY EUCHARIST, the Body and Blood of Jesus. Saint Paul is the first one to offer the narration of the Last Supper in the letter to the Corinthians, where he proposes the words of Jesus: "**This is my body**", "**This is my blood**". This is the mystery of our faith. The Eucharist we believe is the source and the culmination of our faith, as the documents and tradition of the Church remind us and together with the devotion of the people of God. We know that the Eucharist is the fruit of the great love of Jesus who

gave everything for us. In obedience and fidelity to the Father He offered himself and gave his body for our salvation and shed his blood for our redemption. The traditional processions of Corpus Christi that run through many of our streets, is an invitation to take into account that his sacrifice was made for our salvation and for a true and meaningful life of love and dignity. We know that, even if you do not decorate your route and do not throw flowers in your path, we all join him as the "body of Christ", in the hope that his passage through the streets of our cities and the world awakens in us solidarity with the most vulnerable and needy in our midst. It is our hope that Christ provide for all of us the opportunity to live with security, tranquility and true peace. Making our own the words of the sacred scripture: "**If you want to honor the body of Christ, do not despise him when he is wounded, despised and naked**". Do not honor the Eucharistic Christ with silk vestments, while outside the temple you neglect this other Christ afflicted by the cold and the nakedness". Remember, all of us are the real body of Christ and Christ is not divided. Neither, we should not divide him, but be the beautiful Eucharistic family of God.





DOMINGO DE CORPUS CHRISTI. La semana pasada reflexionamos el misterio de la SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD y este domingo meditamos el misterio de la SS. EUCHARISTIA, "Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesús". San Pablo es el primero que hace la narración de la última cena en la carta a los Corintios, en donde propone las palabras de Jesús: "**Este es mi cuerpo**", "**Esta es mi sangre**". Este es el misterio de nuestra fe. La Eucaristía creemos es la fuente y el culmen de nuestra fe como nos lo recuerda los documentos y tradición de la Iglesia y de toda la devoción del pueblo de Dios. Sabemos que la Eucaristía es el fruto del gran amor de Jesús que lo dio todo por nosotros. En obediencia y fidelidad al Padre que se ofreció y entregó Su Cuerpo por nuestra salvación y derramó Su Sangre por nuestra redención. Las tradicionales procesiones del Corpus Christi que recorren muchas de nuestras calles son una invitación a tomar en cuenta que Su sacrificio fue hecho por nuestra salvación y por una vida plena en el amor y la dignidad de vida. Sabemos que, aunque no se adorne su recorrido y no se tiren flores a su paso, todos nos unimos a Él "cuerpo de Cristo", en la esperanza que su paso por las calles de nuestras ciudades y del mundo despierte en nosotros la solidaridad con los más vulnerables y necesitados para que todos vivamos en la seguridad, tranquilidad y verdadera paz. Haciendo nuestras las palabras de la sagrada escritura: "Si quieren honrar el cuerpo de Cristo, no lo desdeñe cuando está herido, despreciado y desnudo. No honre al Cristo eucarístico con vestiduras de seda, mientras fuera del templo descuidan a este otro Cristo afligido por el frío y por la desnudez". Todos somos el cuerpo real de Cristo y Cristo no está dividido, si es que no lo dividimos nosotros. Así sea.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

SS. Corpo e Sangue di Cristo — Che cosa ci suggerisce Gesù moltiplicando i pani per la folla, nel deserto? Di organizzare una campagna contro la fame nel mondo? Oggi, in seguito a ripiegamento aggressivo del mondo occidentale su i propri privilegi alimentari, i due terzi dell'umanità sono sotto-alimentati. E il mondo che dispone di cibo in abbondanza coincide esattamente con i paesi cristiani di antica data, così come la società tecnicamente più evoluta.

Ma ci sono altri tipi di fame, meno materiali, che i solo mezzi tecnici non sono i grado di soddisfare. Se ci si preoccupa così poco di chi manca del pane quotidiano, ci si preoccupa forse di più di chi è privo di amore? Quando Gesù si è rifiutato di congedare la folla senza averle procurato da mangiare, col suo gesto di accoglienza non le ha offerto forse anche il pane dell'amore? È stato spesso notato, in Luca, un parallelismo tra la moltiplicazione dei pani e l'episodio di Emmaus. Sembra effettivamente che l'evangelista abbia voluto fare, della condivisione del pane di Emmaus, una ripresa allusiva di quel miracolo, lanciando così ai cristiani che ormai conoscono l'eucarestia, un segno dell'amore divino che si dona agli uomini.

Quando il Cristo è entrato nella sua passione, quando ha collocato le prime pietre della sua Chiesa, non ha tenuto una conferenza stampa sulla salvezza del modo. Era venuto il momento di tacere e di dare una prova tangibile del proprio amore. Non facciamo del Vangelo un libro che sbiadisce nella nostra memoria. Finché il vangelo è un annuncio che attende da noi la risposta dell'amore, che solo può assicurare la presenza indefettibile di Gesù.

Gesù il Messia — La moltiplicazione dei pani fa sorgere nelle folle la speranza che Gesù sia veramente il messia atteso da secoli, quel messia che, si pensava, avrebbe liberato il popolo eletto su un piano essenzialmente politico e sociale. Gesù non può accettare questo piano; e appena terminato quel pranzo straordinario, segno del suo amore, si ritira, come farà dopo l'ultima cena, e abbandona definitivamente la predicazione alle folle, per consacrarsi esclusivamente alla formazione degli apostoli.

L'offerta del pane e del vino, atto spontaneo di culto al Creatore

Una delle figure più tipiche della Bibbia è il re-sacerdote non ebreo Melchisedek che offre a Dio pane e vino, e benedice Abramo capostipite del popolo eletto, e da Abramo riceve la decima di tutto ciò che aveva con sé (prima lettura). Il brano deve essere completato con la rilettura che ne fa il salmo responsoriale (109) e la Lettera agli Ebrei (cc. 5—7).

Questa figura di Melchisedek, che compare inattesa e in maniera misteriosamente velata nella Genesi, è simbolo di un sacerdozio umano originario, vero e sacro, tanto da poter benedire lo stesso Abramo. Infatti, è al tipo del suo sacerdozio che viene collegato il sacerdozio regale dei Messia. Vi è perciò qui una prospettiva molto più vasta e lungimirante che non quella del sacerdozio di Aronne nel popolo ebraico.


Anche il Cristo è in questa linea, sebbene il suo sacerdozio e il suo sacrificio siano in una sfera più alta e abbiano un'efficacia che sorpassa infinitamente ogni altra efficacia e a questa conferiscono significato e valore. Così è considerato il Messia nel salmo responsoriale che prelude già al rapporto più intimo e unico fra Cristo e Dio. D'altra parte, nella figura e nel gesto di Melchisedek, assunti e avvalorati da Gesù, ci viene mostrato che i valori creaturali e umani sono accetti a Dio e hanno un positivo significato di relazione tra gli uomini e Dio.


