### **STATEMENT AGAINST FAMILY SEPARATION**

To all peoples of Good Will:

The Missionaries of St. Charles-Scalabrinians, as Catholic men who consecrated their lives to the service of Migrants and Refugees in the world, and people who strongly believe in a universal fellowship, in solidarity with the US conference of Catholic Bishops, condemn the policy of the current United States administration to break apart families by separating the minors from their parents when seeking admission into the United States on the US-Mexican border.

The Attorney General tried to call believers in Christ to support and honor this insane and wicked practice by quoting the Christian Scriptures. The call to obey the law the apostle Paul presents in the letter to the Romans chapter 13, was never meant to tear apart obedience to the Law from the greatest and most important of all commandments: *Thou shall love the Lord your God (...), and your neighbor as yourself* (Cfr. Mt 22:36-40). As Disciples of Christ we are call to make out of Love the Golden Rule of our lives, for only in Love, the Law (and the whole of life itself), can find true fulfillment.

We pray for those in office, call to serve this *Land of the Free and Home of the Brave*, that they may overturn this blameworthy policy that goes against the basic human sense of protecting those in need, especially those who are most vulnerable and defenseless.

### Pastor's Desk




**This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Birth of John the Baptist**, the little boy that when the young Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth jumped in her womb. He is the one who had the mission to prepare and pave the way for the Messiah. The Baptist is a man of great personality, spirituality and also contrasts: he lived the silence of the desert, but from there he moved the multitudes and challenged them with a convincing voice calling them to conversion. He also presented himself with extreme authenticity, integrity and humility of life.

He always made clear that he was only the voice, not the Word, but at the same time without reservation he was able to announce and denounce injustices, even to the kings themselves. He invited his disciples to go to Jesus to clarify concerns, he himself did not refuse either to talk with King Herod while he was in prison. Silent and humble, though he was also brave in denouncing what was not lawful with his brother's wife and firmed and faithful to the truth unto pouring his blood. "John the Baptist is a great man!, the greatest of those born of a woman," said Jesus. Perhaps the secret of his greatness was in his consciousness of knowing he was chosen by God. As the evangelist Luke states: "The child grew and his spirit strengthened. He lived in the deserts until the day of his manifestation to Israel "(Lk 1.80). All his childhood and youth was marked by the awareness of his mission lived radically and in giving witness. We also admire him in the dialogue he had with the Messiah while baptizing him in the Jordan River, or in his clear focus while preparing for the Lord a well-disposed people or shedding his blood at the end of his life in favor of the truth. The biblical tradition offers us of John some insights, based on that we can ask ourselves the question of his contemporaries: "What will be of this child?" (Lc 1,66). We know all of us, through baptism, have been consecrated, chosen and sent to bear witness to the Lord as his true disciples. In our world and in today's society, where Pope Francis denounces the globalization of indifference, and where children are separated at the border from their parents as they seek refuge and asylum... Instead, they are often returned to their dangerous lands of origins!?!? Saint John with his radical words presents to us the authentic evangelical model love and generosity. May this Feast of Saint John the Baptist help us to embrace his forerunner attitudes, manifested also in his attentive prayer to the Spirit, in his integrity and humility of life, so that we be encouraged through his intercession to open new paths of holiness for ourselves and others .

## Mensaje del Párroco



Este Domingo celebramos la Solemnidad del Nacimiento de Juan el Bautista, aquel pequeño que cuando la joven María visitó a su prima Isabel brincó en su seno. Él es aquel que tuvo la misión de preparar y allanar el camino al Mesías. El Bautista es un hombre de grandes personalidad, espiritualidad y también contrastes: vivió el silencio del desierto, pero desde allí movió las masas y las retó con voz convincente a la conversión. Además se presentó siempre con extrema autenticidad, integridad y humildad para reconocer

que él tan sólo era la voz, no la Palabra, pero no tuvo pelos en la lengua y fue capaz de acusar y denunciar las injusticias, incluso a los mismos reyes; invitó a sus discípulos a ir hacia Jesús, pero no rechazó conversar aun con el rey Herodes mientras estaba en prisión. Silencioso y humilde, fue también valiente en anunciarle lo que no le era licito hacer con la esposa de su hermano y decidido fue fiel y claro con la verdad, hasta derramar su sangre. "¡Juan Bautista es un gran hombre!, el mayor de los nacidos de mujer", afirmó Jesús. Quizás el secreto de su grandeza estuvo en su conciencia de saberse elegido por Dios; como afirma el evangelista Luca: "El niño crecía y su espíritu se fortalecía; vivió en los desiertos hasta el día de su manifestación a Israel" (Lc. 1,80). Toda su niñez y juventud estuvo marcada por la conciencia de su misión vivida con radicalidad en el dar testimonio. Lo admiramos en el dialogo que tuvo con el Mesías mientras lo bautizaba en el Jordán o, en su claro enfoque al preparar para el Señor un pueblo bien dispuesto o, al final de su vida, derramando su sangre en favor de la verdad. Con lo que la tradición bíblica nos ofrece de Juan, podemos hacernos la pregunta de sus contemporáneos: "¿Qué será de este niño?" (Lc 1,66). Todos nosotros, por el bautismo, hemos sido consagrados, elegidos y enviados a dar testimonio del Señor como sus verdaderos discípulos. En nuestro mundo y sociedad de hoy, en donde como recuerda Papa Francisco reina la globalización de la indiferencia, en donde los niños vienen separados de sus papas, los que buscan refugio y asilo regresado a sus peligrosas tierras ... san Juan con sus radicales palabras se presenta para nosotros autentico modelo evangélico y ayuda con sus autenticas palabras de generosidad. Que esta fiesta de san Juan, haga que sus actitudes de Precursor, manifestadas en su oración atenta al Espíritu, en su fortaleza, integridad de vida y su humildad, nos ayuden a abrir horizontes nuevos de santidad para con nosotros mismos y para con los demás.

### PRONUNCIAMIENTO EN CONTRA DE LA SEPARACION FAMILIAR

A toda la Gente de Buena Voluntad:

Los Misioneros de San Carlos-Scalabrinianos, como hombres Católicos que han consagrado su vida al servicio de los Migrantes y Refugiados en el mundo, y como gente que creé firmemente en una fraternidad universal, en solidaridad con la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos, condena la política de la actual administración de los Estados Unidos de Norteamérica, que consiste en dividir las familias al separar los menores de edad de sus padres cuando buscan admisión en los Estados Unidos, en la Frontera con México.

El Fiscal General hizo un llamado a los creyentes en Cristo a apoyar y honrar esta práctica tan insana y tan ruin, y lo hizo citando las Sagradas Escrituras. El llamado a obedecer la ley que el apóstol Pablo presenta en el capítulo 13 de la carta a los Romanos, no puede justificar la obediencia a la Ley separada del más grande y más importante de todos los mandamientos: *Amaras al Señor tu Dios (...)* y *a tu prójimo como a ti mismo* (Cfr. Mat 22:36-40). Como discípulos de Cristo, somos llamados a hacer del Amor la Regla de Oro en nuestras vidas, pues solamente en el amor, la Ley (y la vida misma), pueden encontrar auténtica plenitud.

Rezamos por todos los que se encuentran gobernando, y que han sido llamados a servir esta *tierra de libres y hogar de valientes*, para que tengan el coraje de revertir esta política tan culposa, pues va en contra del sentido humano tan básico de proteger a los necesitados, especialmente a los más vulnerables e indefensos.

Giovanni è figlio di Zaccaria, il muto, e di Elisabetta, la sterile: la sua nascita annuncia l'arrivo dei tempi messianici nei quali la sterilità diventerà fecondità, e il mutismo diventerà esuberanza profetica.

Il vangelo gli dà il soprannome di «Battista», perché egli annuncia un nuovo rito di abluzione (Mt 3,13-17) nel quale il battezzato non si immerge da solo nell'acqua, come nei riti e nei battesimi ebraici, ma riceve l'acqua lustrale dalle mani di un ministro. Giovanni intendeva così mostrare che l'uomo non si può purificare da solo, ma che ogni santità viene da Dio. Giovanni Battista è pure ricordato come un uomo di grande mortificazione. Forse egli era stato iniziato a questa disciplina nelle comunità religiose del deserto.

Ma la tradizione ha ricordato soprattutto il suo carattere profetico. Egli è profeta nel senso in cui questa parola era intesa nell'Antico Testamento; anzi Giovanni è il più grande dei profeti di Israele, perché ha potuto additare l'oggetto stesso delle sue profezie (Mt 11,7-15; Gv 1,19-28). Per far risaltare questa appartenenza di Giovanni alla grande discendenza dei profeti dell'Antico Testamento, Luca ci dà un racconto della sua nascita che permette di vedere sullo sfondo il profilo delle grandi vocazioni degli antichi profeti. Ma il profeta non è soltanto l'annunciatore del futuro messianico; è essenzialmente il portatore della parola di Dio e il testimone della presenza di questa Parola creatrice nel mondo nuovo.

In ogni Messa l'annuncio della parola di Dio ripete il tema che il Battista faceva risuonare sulle rive del Giordano: « Convertitevi! ». Il racconto della Cena del Signore, al centro della Preghiera eucaristica, è un brano di quel vangelo che deve condurre anche noi a domandare con fede alla Chiesa: « Che cosa dobbiamo fare? » (At 2,37). La risposta di Cristo, corpo-dato e sangue-sparso, è: « Fate questo in memoria di me! ». La vita e il martirio del Battista sono una di quelle innumerevoli risposte-memorale che sempre salgono al Padre, per Cristo con Cristo e in Cristo, nello Spirito.
