



TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The Eucharistic Prayers at the heart of our liturgy have a long history, beginning with the extemporaneous prayers of the early Christians. The presiders gave thanks from their hearts, not from any prearranged text, over the gifts of bread and wine. When the assembly had the sense that enough was said, someone would call out "Amen!" and that was that. For the most part, the plan flowed directly from Jewish meal prayers, which always recalled God's mighty deeds. Some other markers and signposts were added almost everywhere fairly early, like the presider's call to attention: "Lift up your hearts!"

Scholars have provided us with translations of many early texts. These have actually helped us craft new liturgical prayers, because until the liturgical reforms of forty years ago, no one could recall any prayer but the Roman Canon, now called Eucharistic Prayer I. For hundreds of years in the West, it was our only Eucharistic Prayer, and it was only in Latin. But the history of our Eucharistic Prayers is amazingly fruitful, and models have come down to us that have yielded new insights and expressions. The old custom of improvising texts according to a master plan has not endured, but we have now rediscovered a plan of standardizing the text while allowing for a great variety.



TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

En 1769 los misioneros franciscanos establecieron la primera misión en lo que hoy es la ciudad de San Diego, California. Bajo la dirección de fray Junípero Serra, los hermanos menores pudieron establecer otras ocho misiones, incluyendo la ciudad de San Francisco, en 1776.

Junípero o José Miguel Serra, fue hijo de padres campesinos de la Isla de Mallorca, España. Ingresó a la orden de los hermanos menores(Franciscanos) a los dieciséis años y con el tiempo, llegó a ser profesor de filosofía, pero su verdadero deseo era ser misionero en el continente americano, lo que hoy conocemos como hemisferio occidental.

En 1749, su orden religiosa lo envió a México como administrador del Colegio Apostólico. Poco a poco se fue desprendiendo de sus cargos académicos para establecer misiones entre los indígenas. Aunque algunos afirman lo contrario, Junípero fue arduo defensor de los nativos. En California, más de una vez tuvo problemas con los soldados españoles, debido a que estos abusaban de los amerindios, problemas que lo llevaron a defender los derechos humanos de los nativos ante el Virrey en México. Sus esfuerzos por cristianizar los indígenas de California tuvieron como resultado más de 6000 bautizados durante sus quince años en esa región.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection



Dodicesima domenica del T.O. — Anno “A” — Il Cristo non ha promesso ai suoi un fascino speciale, capace di renderli facilmente vittoriosi in ogni circostanza, la precarietà e le persecuzioni accompagneranno sempre il loro cammino. Se il vangelo è una forza di contestazione del male in tutte le sue forme, la chiesa non può evitare la porta stretta del mistero pasquale, la croce che conduce alla gloria. I compromessi col potere politico ed economico si pagano inevitabilmente con la perdita del sapore e del vigore della testimonianza.

Ma pur nella condivisione delle persecuzioni del messia quale sicurezza già ci viene data! «*Non temete, non abbiate paura!*» Opera di Dio l’apostolato porta in sé la certezza del successo. Basta annunciare in piena luce la condizione divina del Cristo, un tempo nascosta e segreta, oggi manifesta nella sua risurrezione. Senza timore, perché non bisogna avere paura che del peccato. I persecutori possono uccidere il corpo, ma la vera vita appartiene a Dio, che veglia come un padre anche sulla più piccola delle sue creature.

In passato, il martirio era un liturgia: si saliva sul rogo come sull’altare. Interrogatori e supplizi era un’occasione di proclamare la fede in Cristo, prima dell’offerta sacrificale. Il martirio faceva una buona propaganda al vangelo. Oggi abbiamo piuttosto l’anonimato di un carcere o di un campo da cui nessuno ritorna. Le tecniche che violentano l’uomo fino alla giuntura dell’anima e del corpo permettono perfino di trarre profitto da certe «*confessioni spontanee*». Ma la voce dei martiri, chiamati ad un più grande eroismo e a una più grande purezza, continua a salire fino al cielo. All’ultimo giorno, il Cristo stesso presenterà i suoi testimoni al Padre.

Non è più tempo di paure — «*Non abbiate paura!*»: questo è il tema unico della lettura. Non si tratta di un timore qualsiasi: si tratta proprio della paura che può afferrare il cristiano nel momento in cui deve confessare la sua fede dinanzi agli uomini. Il pericolo sarà allora di conservare nel segreto la buona notizia, che invece deve essere portata a conoscenza di tutti. Ciò che rovina la chiesa, non sono i persecutori, ma i ghetti. Ciò che è stato confidato agli apostoli, non deve restare gelosamente custodito in circoli chiusi, ma deve essere proclamato apertamente, con i fatti prima ancora che con le parole. Per le comunità cristiane, la vergogna non è l’insuccesso o la persecuzione, ma la fuga dinanzi al rischio del vangelo.

La persecuzione

Il popolo di Dio ha sperimentato, durante tutta la sua storia, la violenta opposizione dei popoli vicini. Il mistero della persecuzione, pur essendo connesso al mistero della sofferenza in genere, ne è distinto. La sofferenza costituisce un tormentoso problema, perché tocca tutti gli uomini anche i giusti e gli innocenti. La persecuzione colpisce i giusti *proprio perché giusti*; raggiunge specialmente i profeti a causa del loro amore a Dio e della loro fedeltà alla sua parola. Geremia occupa fra i perseguitati un posto speciale: egli ha espresso meglio degli altri lo stretto legame che esiste tra la persecuzione e la missione profetica.

Una figura profetica: il Servo sofferente

Il *Servo sofferente* compie il piano di Dio con l’accettazione dei maltrattamenti che il popolo gli infligge. La ragione profonda che spiega il dramma del giusto perseguitato è messa in luce dal libro della Sapienza: il giusto è diventato per l’empio «insopportabile solo al vederlo» (*Sap* 2,14); è «di imbarazzo» (*Sap* 2,12), un testimone del Dio vivente che si preferisce misconoscere.


Condannando Gesù al supplizio della croce, gli Ebrei continuano l’ingiustizia dei loro antenati che hanno perseguitato i profeti, e così tentano di opporsi al piano di Dio. Ma il calcolo dell’uomo peccatore si rivela sbagliato. I «principi di questo mondo», crocifiggendo il «Signore della gloria», diventano, in realtà, gli strumenti della Sapienza divina (*1 Cor* 2,8), perché la morte di Cristo diventa salvezza del mondo e gloria di Dio.


