From the Pastor's Desk

XIV SUNDAY O.T. & FEAST OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL. We reflect with Jesus who continues his journey to Jerusalem with the determination to invite us to follow him with promptness, decision and fidelity. We witness the sending of the 72 disciples to all nations. The number 72 comes from the belief that it was the number of nations thought to be at the time. That is why Jesus sends the 72 thinking of covering all nations, the entire peoples. The Gospel does not exclude anyone, it is for everyone. We admire that already in its first steps towards Jerusalem his universal mission is revealed. Today, like yesterday Jesus looks at the crowds of the peripheries of the big cities and tells the disciples: "**The harvest is great, and the workers are few**". It is the invitation to collaborate in his mission. The disciples went through the cities "**two by two**", with the mandate love and serve. This has transformed the disciples into universal brothers and sisters who forced them to assume as their own the joys, hopes, anxieties and pains of the people they encountered along the way. Jesus does not hide from the 72 the problems they will find: "**Go, be aware that I send you as lambs in the midst of wolves**". We know that it is not an easy task to go to mission in the spirit of a "lamb" and be asked by Jesus to change the life of a "wolf". It is not easy to defeat individualism, indifference and self-interest. Just as it is not easy to overcome the fear, insecurity and violence that seems to seduce many of our cities in a perverse wave of arrogance, competition, strength and individual interests; darkening ever more the presence of God and opening the doors to evil. It is our hope that these days of Novena in preparation for the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel will fill us with the only strength that only the Lord can give us, which, without a doubt, we believe is the only force that can change the world and our heart, Jesus' grace. Hopefully, you and I as the disciples affirm: "**Lord, even the devils submit to us in your name**", and Jesus will reply loudly: "**I saw Satan fall from heaven like lightning ... overcoming evil**", but Jesus also repeats to us: "**Rejoice rather that your names be written in the book of God's heaven**", for the generous response of apostolic work you did as laborers in God's Kingdom. May Our Mother Mary help us with her motherly wisdom and intercession to eliminate evil and enjoy true messianic peace. Amen.



XIV DOMINGO ORDINARIO y FIESTA DE LA VIRGEN DEL CARMEN. Nos encontramos con Jesús que sigue su camino hacia Jerusalén con la determinación de invitarnos a seguirlo con prontitud, decisión y fidelidad. Es el envío de los 72 discípulos a todas las naciones. El numero 72 viene de la creencia que era el número de las naciones que se pensaba había en la tierra. Por eso Jesús envía los 72 pensando de abarcar todas las naciones, todos los pueblos. El Evangelio no excluye a nadie, es para todos. Admiramos que ya en sus primeros pasos

hacia Jerusalén se pone de manifiesto su misión universal. Hoy como ayer Jesús mira a las muchedumbres de las periferias de las grandes ciudades y les dice a los discípulos: "**La mies es mucha y los obreros pocos**". Es la invitación a colaborar en su misión. Fueron por las ciudades "**de dos en dos**", bajo el signo del envío, del amor y del servicio. Eso transformó a los discípulos en hermanos y hermanas universales que los empujó a asumir como propias las alegrías, las esperanzas, las angustias y los dolores del pueblo que encontraron en el camino. Jesús no oculta a los 72 los problemas que encontrarán: "**Vayan, pero sapan que los envío como corderos en medio de lobos**". Sabemos que no es tarea fácil ir a misionar en el espíritu de un "**cordero**" como pide Jesús para cambiar la vida a un "**lobo**". No es fácil derrotar el individualismo, la indiferencia y el interés por uno mismo. Así como no es fácil vencer el miedo, la inseguridad y la violencia que parece seducir muchas de nuestras ciudades en una ola perversa de mal, de ídolos, de arrogancia, de competencia, de fuerza y de intereses individuales; oscureciendo siempre más la presencia de Dios y abriendo las puertas al mal. Es nuestra esperanza que estos días de **Novena en preparación a la Fiesta de la Virgen del Carmen** nos llene de la única fuerza que solo el Señor puede darnos, que, sin duda creemos es la única fuerza que puede cambiar el mundo y nuestro corazón, el poder de Jesús. Ojalá tú y Yo como los discípulos podamos afirmar: "**Señor, hasta los demonios se nos someten en tu nombre**", y Jesús nos repetirá en voz alta: "**Yo veía a Satanás caer del cielo como un rayo... venciendo el mal**", pero también nos repite Jesús: "**alérgense más bien que sus nombres estén escritos en el libro del cielo de Dios**", por la generosa respuesta de trabajo que hicimos como obreros de su Reino. Nuestra Madre María nos ayude con su sabiduría maternal e intercesión a luchar para eliminar el mal y gozar de una verdadera paz mesiánica. Amen.

Sunday Reflection

I discepoli messaggeri della salvezza

Cristo chiama per mandare. L'essere discepolo di Gesù non è un privilegio per sé, ma un servizio per il regno di Dio. Gesù manda i suoi discepoli per «annunciare» che il regno di Dio è vicino.

La missione: un annuncio di speranza

L'uomo aspira alla pace ma fa la guerra; l'uomo vuole essere amato ed amare, ma di fatto molte volte non è amato e non ama. L'uomo vuole la giustizia, l'uguaglianza, ma commette ingiustizia, produce strutture ingiuste ed oppressive.

L'uomo, nella profondità del suo essere, è ricerca del Dio vivente, ma produce idoli morti, nega e rifiuta la Sorgente.

L'uomo vuole la vita a tutti i livelli in pienezza, senza fine, e invece incontra la malattia e la morte. Il discepolo di Cristo annuncia che le contraddizioni più amare dell'esistenza saranno risolte, che le aspirazioni più profonde dell'uomo saranno realizzate, «per l'intervento gratuito di Dio», in un modo insospettato e inaudito, riportando vittoria completa sul male. Ciò che all'uomo è impossibile, è possibile a Dio (prima lettura). La salvezza viene annunciata e realizzata in un mondo dominato dalla logica del peccato. Per questo la salvezza ha un momento negativo: la liberazione da tutte le forze demoniache che alienano l'uomo da se stesso e da Dio (vangelo).

Questa salvezza non sarà realizzata però di colpo. Il male non sarà vinto immediatamente. Non sarà combattuto con armi potenti, mediante il potere, come pensavano gli Ebrei.

La croce è la gloria del missionario

Il messaggero della salvezza si trova fra queste forze demoniache, «è come un agnello in mezzo ai lupi»: non c'è missione senza persecuzione, senza sofferenza, senza croce. La croce è la «gloria» del missionario e di ogni cristiano (seconda lettura) perché lo pone in una esistenza nuova. La croce «per il regno di Dio», accettata con amore, è il «segno» della vittoria sul male e sulla morte.

Per il cristiano la certezza della sua risurrezione riposa nel fatto che egli è crocifisso dalla prova e dalla contestazione.

La prova non è, per san Paolo, solo un'ascesi, una occasione di vita morale e neppure una semplice imitazione della croce di Gesù, ma è il luogo della speranza e della profezia del regno che viene, e che i messaggeri del vangelo proclamano con la parola e con la vita per confermare che il mondo nuovo è già iniziato e che è possibile.

Alla logica del mondo vecchio oppongono la logica di Dio. In un mondo di lupi, dominato dall'aggressività, la loro presenza è condanna radicale della violenza bestiale.

In un mondo in cui «l'uomo è il denaro che ha e gli abiti che porta», essi vanno vestiti da poveri, senza portafogli e bagagli, contenti della ospitalità che ricevono. La vicinanza del regno li dispensa dal preoccuparsi per il loro avvenire terrestre: la loro povertà ha un significato profetico, come anche la cura dei malati. Il segno che il regno di Dio è presente è il fatto che l'uomo è liberato dal peccato e dalle sue conseguenze. Questa liberazione è però lenta e richiede per essere attuata sofferenza, morte e pazienza. Non è una liberazione trionfale come la sognavano gli Ebrei del tempo di Gesù.
