Pastor's Desk

We are at the heart of our Jubilee Anniversary of the 125 years of Veneration and of the Feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. We thank all of you who are participating in our prayerful Novena. Fr. Brian Walker, O.P. the preacher with his wisdom and experiences is motivating us to live our faith with responsibility and to enjoy the maternal love of the Virgin Mary in living the great commandment of love in charity and hospitality.

This XIV Sunday of Ordinary Time, in the vivid experience of Jesus we are challenge to open our hearts to others. Jesus arrives in Nazareth, accompanied by his disciples, and surprisingly no one came out to meet him. Jesus experienced rejection from his own people, from those who believed they knew him better than anyone else. Jesus felt "despised", his people did not accept him as the bearer of the Good News and of the message of the salvation of God. The pre-concepted idea they had created of their neighbor Jesus made them reluctant to open themselves to the mystery that Jesus was revealing. Jesus reminded them of a saying that, probably, we all know: "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place, among his own kin and in his own house." Jesus also said: "He was amazed at their lack of faith." I believe it is the first time that Jesus experienced a collective rejection, not only of the religious leaders, but of all his people. Jesus did not expect this from his people. Their disbelief even blocked His ability to heal: "he was not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people". As we joyfully continue with our NOVENA and FEAST, let us ask the Our Lady of Mount Carmel to help us to open ourselves to Jesus' Grace and through her intercession be filled with God's blessings that will help us to journey as men and women of faith, charity and hope. **Happy Anniversary and Happy Holiday. Mensaje del Párroco



Nos encontramos en el vivo de nuestra celebración del Jubileo de los 125 años de Venerar la Virgen del Carmen. Agradecemos a todos aquellos que se unieron a nosotros en oración en la Novena. P. Brian Walker, O.P. con sus vivencia y experiencia nos está motivando a vivir nuestra fe con responsabilidad y a gozar el amor maternal de la Virgen para testimoniar el gran mandamiento del amor en la caridad y hospitalidad.

También este XIV domingo del Tiempo Ordinario nos provoca con la misma vivencia de Jesús a abrir el corazón a los demás. Jesús llega a Nazaret, acompañado de sus discípulos, y nadie sale a su encuentro, como testimoniamos en la crisis humanitaria de nuestros días. Jesús experimenta el rechazo en su propio pueblo, su propia gente, de los que creían conocerlo mejor que nadie. Jesús se siente “despreciado”, los suyos no lo aceptan como portador del mensaje de Buena Nueva y de la salvación de Dios. Esto or que ya se han hecho una idea de su vecino Jesús y se resisten a abrirse al misterio que se encierra en su persona. Jesús les recuerda un refrán que, probablemente, todos conocemos: *“No desprecian a un profeta más que en su tierra, entre sus parientes y en su casa”*. Jesús también: *“se extraña de su falta de fe”*. Creo sea la primera vez que Jesús experimenta un rechazo colectivo, no solo de los dirigentes religiosos, sino de todo su pueblo. Jesús no se esperaba esto de los suyos. Su incredulidad llega incluso a bloquear su capacidad de curar: *“no pudo hacer allí ningún milagro, sólo curó a algunos enfermos”*. Mientras continuamos gozosos con nuestra novena y fiesta pidamos a la Virgen nos ayude a abrirnos a la gracia de su Hijo Jesús y por intercesión de la Virgen del Carmen seamos colmados de bendiciones que nos ayuden a caminar como hombres y mujeres de fe, caridad y esperanza. **Feliz Aniversario y Feliz Fiesta. BENDICIONES!!!**

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Quattordicesima Domenica del T.O. — Anno "B" — Il racconto del vangelo è semplice e scarno. Il ministero di Gesù in Galilea si conclude con un fallimento, col rifiuto da parte dei suoi concittadini. Eppure l'inizio era stato buono. Lo stupore di fronte alla sapienza e ai miracoli di quell'uomo, che credevano di conoscere tanto bene, aveva portato gli abitanti di Nazaret a porsi la domanda giusta, che avrebbe potuto condurli alla fede: *«Dove gli vengono queste cose?»* Sarebbe bastato

che si ricordassero di ciò che era stato annunciato da Mosé: *«Il Signore tuo Dio susciterà un profeta pari a me; a lui darete ascolto»* (Det. 18,15). Per parlare agli uomini, normalmente Dio sceglie delle persone che sono loro vicine. La fede degli abitanti di Nazaret, invece, si arresta proprio davanti al carattere consueto e familiare della presenza di Gesù; non è così che essi immaginavano un uomo di Dio, una profeta. Anche Gesù rimane sorpreso; di fronte al loro scetticismo, si trova come disarmato, incapace di fare miracoli...

Questo racconto può insegnarci due cose. In primo luogo che si può paralizzare una persona, ridurla all'impotenza semplicemente non dandole fiducia, buttandole addosso un giudizio preconcelto. Quante energie soffocate, quanti scoraggiamenti, quanta gioia distrutta dai nostri giudizi decisi e inappellabili su coloro che crediamo di conoscere! Troppe volte nello sguardo che rivoliamo agli altri, non c'è posto per la speranza...

Ma c'è un altro insegnamento che dobbiamo raccogliere. Anche per parlare di noi. Dio non si serve di gente fuori del comune, ma di persone qualsiasi, in cui dobbiamo riconoscere la presenza imprevedibile del suo inviato: l'ospite, il vicino, l'ammalato, lo straniero, l'amico, il nostro prossimo insomma: l'incontro con l'altro può essere un momento di grazia, se il nostro cuore è aperto e disponibile. Per manifestarsi davvero, Dio ha bisogno degli uomini.

La vera parentela di Gesù — Gesù non aveva ancora annunciato il vangelo nella sua città. Egli vi suscita le stesse contraddizioni che aveva sollevato altrove. Alcuni si stupiscono della sua saggezza, altri sono sconvolti e lo rifiutano. Marco vede in ciò il segno che il vangelo esige delle scelte e delle rotture. La famiglia di Gesù, i suoi, la sua patria e la sua casa, non sono i conterranei o i parenti, ma coloro che credono. Il battesimo e l'Eucarestia rendono anche noi parte di questa famiglia.


