

From the Pastor's Desk

XVI Sunday of the O.T. STILL REJOICING IN THE SPIRIT OF OUR FEAST. We celebrated our anniversaries-jubilees (50 and 125 years) and we remained - I believe - with a heart filled, satisfied and excited by the significant, beautiful and participative celebrations we had. The faces of many and the comments I have received were very motivating. No doubt we all ended up very tired; nonetheless, super satisfied and motivated. **It was all worth it.** To all those who with their participation, commitment and work made it a successful GREAT FEAST, I offer my most sincere gratitude. The GOSPEL this Sunday fits properly in the context of our celebration. Jesus sent His disciples to an evangelizing-missionary experience two by two and when they enthusiastically returned, for all they have done and taught. Jesus wants to spend time alone with them. He desires to listen to them calmly and invites them to go away into a deserted place: "Come aside, to a solitary place, to rest a little". So, they take the boat and head to the other shore. However, people change their entire plan, because all the multitude ran to look for them. So the quiet meeting that Jesus had planned alone with his closest disciples, it is no longer possible. When they arrived at the place, the crowd had already invaded the area. What was Jesus' reaction?

The evangelist highlights the gaze of Jesus. Jesus does not get upset, because they have interrupted His plans. Instead, he stirs at them closely and is emotionally moved. Jesus is never bothered by the presence of people. His heart grasps the disorientation and the abandonment in which the people find themselves and he felt compassion for them, because "they were like sheep without a shepherd, and He began to teach them many things." In the Church we have to learn to look at the people as Jesus looked at them: capturing the suffering, the loneliness, the bewilderment, the anxieties and the abandonment that many suffer. Compassion does not come from the obedience to the norms or the remembrance of our obligations; rather it awakes in us when we look at those who suffer. From that encounter Jesus discovers the deepest need of those people and states: "**they were like sheep without a shepherd**". They live without anyone really taking care of them. They do not have a shepherd to guide and defend them. Moved with compassion for them, "**Jesus began to teach them many things**". Calmly and patiently He taught them the Good News of God. Jesus forgot about His own needs, instead He gave of Himself to them preaching the Word of God. He was moved by their need of guidance and especially of a spiritual nourishment. Let us ask the Lord, to help us not to remain indifferent to the many people who today seek out for compassion and thirst for love.



Las caras de muchos y los comentarios nos han llenado y motivado bastante. No cabe duda todos terminamos súper cansados, pero también súper satisfechos y motivados. **Todo valió la pena.** A todos los que con su participación, compromiso y trabajo hicieron posible la realización de la GRAN FIESTA les ofrecemos nuestra más alta gratitud. El EVANGELIO de este domingo nos llega como anillo al dedo. Jesús envió sus discípulos a una experiencia evangelizadora-misionera de dos en dos y vuelven entusiasmados, por todo lo que han hecho y enseñado. Jesús quiere escucharlos con calma y los invita a retirarse en un lugar a sola con ellos: “Venid aparte, a un lugar solitario, para descansar un poco”.

Toman el barco y se dirigen en la otra orilla. Sin embargo, la gente les cambia todo su plan, porque de todas las aldeas corren a buscarlos. Ya no es posible aquella reunión tranquila que había proyectado Jesús a solas con sus discípulos más cercanos. Cuando llegó al lugar, la muchedumbre le había ya invadido todo. ¿Cuál fue la reacción de Jesús? El evangelista destaca la mirada de Jesús. Jesús no se irrita porque hayan interrumpido sus planes. Los mira detenidamente y se commueve. A Jesús nunca le molesta la gente. Su corazón intuye la desorientación y el abandono en que se encuentran los habitantes de aquellas aldeas. **“Al desembarcar, Jesús vio un gran gentío, sintió compasión de ellos, pues eran como ovejas sin pastor, y se puso a enseñarles muchas cosas”.** En la Iglesia hemos de aprender a mirar a la gente como la miraba de Jesús: captando el sufrimiento, la soledad, el desconcierto, las inquietudes o el abandono que sufren muchos. La compasión no brota de la atención a las normas o el recuerdo de nuestras obligaciones, sino se despierta en nosotros cuando miramos atentamente a los que sufren. Desde esa mirada Jesús descubre la necesidad más profunda de aquellas gentes: **“andan como ovejas sin pastor”**. Viven sin que nadie cuide realmente de ellos. No tienen un pastor que los guíe y los defienda. Movido por su compasión, Jesús “se pone a enseñarles muchas cosas”. Con calma, sin prisas, se dedica pacientemente a enseñarles la Buena Noticia de Dios. No lo hace por obligación. No piensa en sí mismo. Les comunica la Palabra de Dios, conmovido por la necesidad que tienen de un pastor y sobre todo de un alimento espiritual.

Pidamos también nosotros al Señor, nos ayude a no permanecer indiferentes ante tanta gente hoy en día necesitada de compasión y sedienta de amor.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Sedicesima Domenica del T.O. — Anno “B”. «*Venite in disparte, in un luogo solitario, e riposatevi un poco*» (Mc 6,31) Finalmente! Al ritorno dalla missione in Galilea, dopo avere riferito a Gesù quello che è avvenuto durante la prima grande avventura missionaria, viene per i Dodici il momento delle vacanze. Sono appena tornati, e già le folle si sono precipitate loro incontro. Non è possibile avere un momento di tranquillità: meglio fuggire attraverso il lago per ritirarsi con Gesù in un luogo deserto. Fatica sprecata! La gente è più svelta di loro ed è già pronta ad attenderli prima ancora che sbarchino sull'altra riva. Allora Gesù, preso da compassione di fronte a queste *pecore senza pastore*, si ferma e si mette ad insegnare.

«Vacanze» apostoliche andate a monte? Dopo il lungo viaggio missionario, i discepoli aspiravano senza dubbio al riposo contemplativo che avrebbero trovato presso il Maestro: lui solo poteva dare un senso alla loro vita, un contenuto alle loro parole, una dimensione nuova ai loro gesti più quotidiani. Ma non respingendo la folla che vengono ad importunarli anche in questo momento, Gesù rivela ai suoi ciò che devono cercare presso di lui: non un confortevole rifugio per esteti o per anime devote in cerca di sensazioni particolari, ma la partecipazione all'amore di Dio per il suo popolo, nella consapevolezza che nella sua missione non è altro che il dilagare della carità del Cristo, nei confronti delle folle abbandonate a se stesse. Il medesimo amore incalza l'apostolo: come il Maestro, egli deve accettare di essere senza tregua a disposizione di tutti.

Allora niente vacanze per gli apostoli, per i cristiani? In ogni caso, niente vacanze per l'amore. L'intimità col Cristo, deve portarci a condividere la sua sollecitudine per le folle. Durante le nostre vacanze, che cosa offriamo agli altri, sulle orme di Gesù?




