

From the Pastor's Desk

Sunday XIX of the O.T., continuing on our reflection of the cap.6 of St. John referring to the manna sent from heaven to the people of Israel in the desert. Jesus applies to himself the content of the biblical message by saying: "I am the bread that came down from heaven" for your salvation. It is understandable that such a statement cokes with those present who began to murmur. Of course, it is difficult, if not impossible, on the level of human logic, to think that salvation can be manifested from heaven and from a human person. In this mystery is enclosed the message of the Christian faith: the infinite chooses the finite to manifest himself. The Word that created the world chooses the human words to reveal himself. He who creates all things becomes present "really" in a simple bread and a simple wine. The Lord of heaven and earth is present where two or three people are together in his name. "I am the bread of life, your parents ate the manna in the desert and died. This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that whoever eats it does not die". In the same way that the manna was the salvation for the people of Israel, Jesus is for the people of today. "I am the living bread, that come down from heaven. If one eats this bread, he will live forever and the bread that I am going to give you is my flesh, for the life of the world". Whoever believes in Jesus and eats his flesh, has eternal life. St. John Paul II affirmed: "The Eucharist, the salvific presence of Jesus in the community of the faithful and his spiritual nourishment, is the most valuable thing that the Church can have in her spiritual journey of life". Let us pray that every Sunday Mass truly be the food that fills us with spiritual goods for a life of transparency, peace, generosity, love and hope. Amen.

Wednesday August 15- Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary – Day of Mass Obligation. The dogma of the Assumption refers to the fact that the Mother of God, after her earthly life, was elevated body and soul to heavenly glory. This Dogma was proclaimed by Pope Pius XII, on November 1, 1950, in the Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*: "After raising many repeated prayers to God and invoking the light of the Spirit of Truth, to the glory of Almighty God, who granted the Virgin Mary her peculiar benevolence, for the honor of her Son, immortal King of the centuries and winner of sin and death, to increase the glory of the august Mother herself and for the joy and joy of the whole Church, with the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the blessed apostles Peter and Paul and with ours, we pronounce, declare and define to be divinely revealed dogma that the Immaculate Mother of God and always Virgin Mary, finished the course of her earthly life, was assumed in body and soul to the glory of heaven. " The mystery of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven invites us to pause in the hectic life that we lead to reflect on the meaning of our life here on earth, on our ultimate goal: Eternal Life, together with the Most Holy Trinity, the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Angels and Saints of Heaven. The knowledge that Mary is already in the glorious Heaven in body and soul, as we have been promised to those who do the Will of God, renews us hope in our future immortality and perfect happiness forever. We believe that one day, we will enjoy the same beatitude. Amen

Del Escritorio del Párroco

Domingo XIX del T.O., continuando nuestra reflexión del cap.6 de San Juan referente al maná enviado desde el cielo para el pueblo de Israel que estaba en el desierto. Jesús aplica a sí mismo el contenido del mensaje bíblico diciendo: “Yo soy el pan que ha bajado del cielo” para nuestra salvación. Es comprensible que tal afirmación coque con los presentes que empezaron a murmurar. Claro es difícil, si no imposible en el plano de la lógica humana, pensar que del cielo y de un hombre humano se pueda manifestar la salvación. En este misterio se encierra el mensaje de la fe cristiana: lo infinito elige lo finito para manifestarse; la Palabra que creó el mundo elige las palabras humanas para revelarse; aquel que crea todas las cosas se hace presente “realmente” en un poco de pan y un poco de vino; el Señor del cielo y de la tierra se hace presente allí donde dos o tres personas se reúnen en su nombre. “Yo soy el pan de vida, sus padres comieron el maná en el desierto y murieron; este es el pan que baja del cielo, para que quien lo coma no muera”.

Del mismo modo que el maná fue la salvación para el pueblo de Israel, Jesús lo es para las personas de hoy. “Yo soy el pan vivo, bajado del cielo. Si uno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre y el pan que yo le voy a dar es mi carne, para vida del mundo”. Quien se une a Jesús, quien come su carne, tiene vida eterna. Afirmaba San Juan Pablo II: “La Eucaristía, presencia salvífica de Jesús en la comunidad de fieles y su alimento espiritual, es lo más valioso que la Iglesia puede tener en su camino a lo largo de la historia”. Pidamos al Señor que la Misa de cada domingo sea de verdad el alimento que nos llenas de bienes espirituales para una vida de transparencia, paz, generosidad, amor y esperanza. Amen.

Miercoles Agosto 15- Solemnidad de la Asunción de María – Día de Obligo a la Misa. El dogma de la Asunción se refiere a que la Madre de Dios, luego de su vida terrena fue elevada en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celestial. Este Dogma fue proclamado por el Papa Pío XII, el 1º de noviembre de 1950, en la Constitución Munificentissimus Deus: "Después de elevar a Dios muchas y reiteradas preces y de invocar la luz del Espíritu de la Verdad, para gloria de Dios omnipotente, que otorgó a la Virgen María su peculiar benevolencia; para honor de su Hijo, Rey inmortal de los siglos y vencedor del pecado y de la muerte; para aumentar la gloria de la misma augusta Madre y para gozo y alegría de toda la Iglesia, con la autoridad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, de los bienaventurados apóstoles Pedro y Pablo y con la nuestra, pronunciamos, declaramos y definimos ser dogma divinamente revelado que La Inmaculada Madre de Dios y siempre Virgen María, terminado el curso de su vida terrenal, fue asunta en cuerpo y alma a la gloria del cielo". El misterio de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María al Cielo nos invita a hacer una pausa en la agitada vida que llevamos para reflexionar sobre el sentido de nuestra vida aquí en la tierra, sobre nuestro fin último: la Vida Eterna, junto con la Santísima Trinidad, la Santísima Virgen María y los Ángeles y Santos del Cielo. El saber que María ya está en el Cielo gloriosa en cuerpo y alma, como se nos ha prometido a aquéllos que hagamos la Voluntad de Dios, nos renueva la esperanza en nuestra futura inmortalidad y felicidad perfecta para siempre, cierto que un día gozaremos de la misma bienaventuranza.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Diciannovesima Domenica del T. O. — Anno "B" — «*Io sono il pane disceso dal cielo.*» Questa frase enigmatica suscita il mormorio scandalizzato della folla, e ancora oggi non manca di provocare un moto di protesta da parte dello scettico, che si nasconde dentro ciascuno di noi: «*Io non sono migliore dei miei padri*»

(1 Re 19,4)

Tra Gesù e i suoi ascoltatori si è creato un tragico malinteso. Prima di indicare se stesso come il pane della vita, Gesù ha voluto condividere il pane degli uomini. Trent'anni di intensa preparazione, in cui ha partecipato ai pasti quotidiani, ai pranzi di festa e ai pranzi di lutto. Trent'anni per cercare di far sentire agli uomini la loro fame essenziale e di far intuire loro il cibo che egli avrebbe dato. Trent'anni per arrivare a questo punto: «*Costui non è il figlio di Giuseppe. Come può dire: Sono disceso dal cielo?*» Il nocciolo della incredulità di questa gente, e forse anche della nostra, consiste nel vedere in Gesù soltanto colui che ha condiviso il pane degli uomini, non accogliendolo come colui che ci vuole donare, col pane, anche la propria vita.

«*Il pane che io darò è la mia carne per la vita del mondo.*» Noi siamo sempre tentati di ridurre l'esperienza religiosa all'iniziativa dell'uomo che, a un certo punto, decide di occuparsi di Dio. Nella religione di Gesù, invece, è il Padre che ci attira al Figlio, che ci viene incontro attraverso il Figlio, parola e pane disceso dal cielo, e che ci offre di condividere la sua vita, prima di qualsiasi iniziativa da parte nostra. Per mezzo del Figlio, che ha mangiato per trent'anni il pane degli uomini, Dio stesso ci insegna la differenza tra il nostro pane, che non può sottrarci alla morte, e il suo, che ci dona la vita eterna. Sapremo lasciarci attirare e istruire da Dio, che attraverso l'incarnazione del suo figlio e il dono dell'eucarestia, pane del nostro pellegrinaggio terreno, vuole condurci all'immortalità?

Io sono il pane vivo disceso dal cielo, dice il Signore: se uno mangia di questo pane vivrà in eterno. I farisei mormorarono contro Gesù considerato troppo poco prestigioso per essere un messia, come i loro padre avevano mormorato contro Mosé nel deserto. Sono sordi all'insegnamento del Padre, non ascoltano il suo vangelo, disprezzano la Vita che parla loro. Se l'eucarestia lascia scettico anche noi, non è forse perché cerchiamo, nella parola e nei gesti liturgici, i nostri luoghi comuni, anziché lasciarci attirare e interpellare dal messaggio di Dio? o perché la comunione con Dio ci interessa di meno delle chiacchiere che facciamo con noi stessi?


