

From the Pastor's Desk

XX Sunday of O.T. continuing our meditation on chap. 6 of St. John, Jesus continues to insist on his reality as the Son of God who came from on heaven to realize the Father's mission: "**I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If one eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I am going to give him is my flesh, for the life of the world**". Jesus affirms that the bread of the banquet is Himself, His body. Bewildered people ask, "**How can this give us to eat his flesh and drink his blood?**" They argued about what he meant by those words. But Jesus, who knows his thoughts, reiterates: "**If you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man, and do not drink his blood, you will not have life in you**". The words that follow do nothing but emphasize its fundamental and indispensable character: "**My flesh is true food and my blood is true drink**". Jesus reminds us, if we, the disciples do not feed on him, we can do and say many things, but we must not forget his words: "**We will not have life in ourselves**". In order to have life within us, we need to nourish ourselves with Jesus, nourish ourselves with His vital spirit, interiorized his attitudes and criteria of life. This is the secret and strength that we find in Holy Mass - The Eucharist. This is well known to those who regularly receive Communion from Him and feed on His passion for the Father and His love for others. This is the gift of the Eucharist, which is "**a source of life**" for all those who feed on Him. We remember, the Eucharist is the admirable gift that the Lord has left to his Church as St. Paul, with energy, told the Christians of Corinth: "**The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not perhaps communion with the blood of Christ? And the bread that we break, is not communion with the body of Christ?** Therefore, the attitude we should have when we approach the Eucharist should be almost like that of the beggar: who reaches out and ask, who seeks love, who seeks for healing, who yearns for hope and consolation, who needs help The Eucharist is the essential food for the life of the Christian, because it is Jesus himself nurturing as He affirms: "**Just as the Father, who lives, has sent me and I live for the Father, also the one who eats me will live for me**". It seems the Lord asks us only to respond to His invitation and to enjoy the sweetness and strength of the eucharistic bread that He continues to offer us freely and abundantly. Our Christian experiences and witnesses consist fundamentally in nourishing our life in Jesus, which always infuses us with an immense desire to live and make us live fully, that is, to offer us a desire to live our life truthfully and with more love for the good of ourselves and others.

Del Escritorio del Párroco

XX Domingo de T.O. continuando nuestra meditación del cap. 6 de San Juan, Jesús sigue insistiendo sobre su realidad de Hijo de Dios, venido de lo Alto a realizar la misión del Padre: “Yo soy el pan vivo, bajado del cielo. Si uno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo le voy a dar es mi carne, para vida del mundo”. Jesús afirma que el pan del banquete es Él mismo, su cuerpo. La gente desconcertada se pregunta: “¿Cómo puede este darnos a comer su carne y beber su sangre?” Discutían sobre lo que quería decir con aquellas palabras. Pero Jesús, que conoce su pensamiento, reitera: “Si no comen la carne del Hijo del Hombre, y no beben su sangre, no tendrán vida en ustedes”. Las palabras que siguen no hacen sino destacar su carácter fundamental e indispensable: “**Mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida**”. Nos recuerda Jesús, si nosotros los discípulos no nos alimentamos de Él, podremos hacer y decir muchas cosas, pero no hemos de olvidar sus palabras: “**No tendrán vida en ustedes**”. Para tener vida dentro de nosotros necesitamos alimentarnos de Jesús, nutrirnos de su aliento vital, interiorizar sus actitudes y sus criterios de vida. Este es el secreto y la fuerza que encontramos en la Santa Misa - La Eucaristía. Esto lo conocemos bien aquellos que regularmente comulgamos de Él y nos alimentamos de su pasión por el Padre y de su amor por los demás. Esto es el regalo de la Eucaristía, que es “**fuente de vida**” para todos aquellos que se alimentan de Él. Recordamos, la Eucaristía es el don admirable que el Señor nos ha dejado a su Iglesia como Pablo, con energía, decía a los cristianos de Corinto: “**La copa de bendición que bendecimos, ¿no es acaso comunión con la sangre de Cristo? Y el pan que partimos, ¿no es comunión con el cuerpo de Cristo?**” Por lo tanto, la actitud que debemos tener cuando nos acercamos a la Eucaristía debe ser casi como la del mendigo: que tiende la mano, que busca amor, que pide curación, que anhela esperanza y consuelo, que necesita ayuda.... La Eucaristía es el alimento esencial para la vida del creyente, es incluso su misma vida, como Jesús mismo, que, concluyendo su discurso, afirma: “**Lo mismo que el Padre, que vive, me ha enviado y yo vivo por el Padre, también el que me coma vivirá por mí**”. El Señor parece no pedirnos más que responder a su invitación y gozar de la dulzura y la fuerza de este pan eucarístico que Él continúa dándonos gratuita y abundantemente. Nuestra vivencia y experiencia cristiana consiste fundamentalmente en alimentar nuestra vida en Jesús, Él cual nos infunde siempre un deseo inmenso de vivir y hacernos vivir plenamente, es decir ofrecernos un deseo de vivir con más verdad, más amor para el bien nuestro y de los demás.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Ventunesima Domenica del T.O. — Anno “B” — Al termine del discorso del pane della vita, Gesù ha ripetuto con insistenza: «*Chi mangia la mia carne e beve il mio sangue ha la vita eterna.*» A questo punto l'incredulità si insinua anche nel gruppo dei discepoli, e molti se ne vanno, rinuncian-do a seguirlo.

Per la verità, Gesù è un maestro sconcertante. Ha costruito tutto il suo discorso sulla parola «*carne*», la sua carne che bisogna mangiare per ricevere la vita, ed ora conclude: «*E' lo Spirito che dà la vita, la carne non giova a nulla.*» Nè la carne né il sangue non giova a nulla. Nè la carne né il sangue bastano a condurre alla professione di fede: «*Tu sei il Cristo, il figlio del Dio vivente*»

(Mt. 16,16). Bisogna infatti attendere che la carne e il sangue acquistino il loro significato definitivo nella Pasqua di Gesù, perché sia possibile l'adesione decisiva. «*Questo vi scandalizza? e se quando vedrete il figlio dell'uomo salire là dov'era prima...? E' lo Spirito che dà la vita, la carne non giova a nulla; le parole che vi ho dette sono spirito e vita. Ma ci sono ancora tra voi alcuni che non credono.*» Gesù infatti sapeva fin da principio chi erano quelli che non credevano e chi era colui che lo avrebbe tradito. E continuò «*Per questo vi ho dettato che nessuno può venire a me, se non gli viene concesso dal Padre mio.*» da allora molti dei suoi discepoli si tirarono indietro e non andavano più con lui.

Disse allora Gesù: «*Forse anche voi volete andarvene?*» La domanda di Gesù è carica di tristezza, ci costringere a prendere posizione di fronte a lui. Dobbiamo decidere se allontanarci anche noi con i discepoli, che smettono di seguirlo, o se rimanere con il gruppo dei Dodici, che si esprime attraverso le parole di Pietro: «*Signore, da chi andremo? Tu hai parole di vita eterna. Noi abbiamo creduto e conosciuto che tu sei il Santo di Dio.*»

È il rischio della fede, che non è mai una certezza evidente e scontata, ma è piuttosto la decisione di seguire il Cristo ogni giorno, sostenuti dal pane che egli ci dona, affidandoci a lui solo. Se un cristiano si sforza davvero di essere credente, non potrà non toccare con mano la distanza che separa la sua professione di fede da ciò che egli riesce tradurre nella realtà concreta della sua esistenza. Ma la fragilità stessa di questa fede è come un'invocazione che il Padre ascolta in modo particolare che ci dona, nell'eucarestia, la vita del suo figlio «*per correre insieme il rischio dell'amore*» (M. Noel)

Da chi andremo? Il linguaggio del vangelo è troppo forte: se presa sul serio, la parola di Cristo inquieta e disorienta. Non accarezza gli uditori. Se la parola del «*pane di vita*» resta impressa e scandalizza, cosa sarà della croce? Chi comprenderà che elevato sulla croce il Cristo si eleva anche nella gloria? Credere non è comprendere, ma rischiare un impegno. E per chi impegnarsi, se non per colui che ha parole di vita eterna?
