From the Pastor's Desk

XXIII Sunday of the T.O. - We hear in today Gospel's passage the **healing of a deaf-mute**. Jesus performs this healing in a pagan land located beyond the borders of Israel. With this Mark emphasizes that the **Gospel is not reserved only to the people of Israel**, but that everyone has the right to know the mercy and love of God, he came to be the savior of all. Jesus takes the deaf-mute aside from the people, as if he wanted to stress that a personal, direct, intimate relationship between him and the sick person is necessary. Miracles always occur in the context of a deep and trusting friendship with God. Jesus looks up to heaven and says to the deaf-mute: "**Efatá!**", that is, "**Be open!**". It is a single word, but it comes from a deep prayer and from a heart full of God's love. "He opened his ears and instantly, he released the binding of his tongue and spoke correctly." The power of God was manifested only with "**one word**". Just one word of the Gospel is enough to change the needy person, to transform and save his/her life. What is necessary is that it springs from a **passionate heart** like that of Jesus and that it be received by a needy heart like that of the deaf-mute. Jesus, we might say, does not address the ear and the mouth, but the entire person, **the whole person**. To the deaf and not only to his ear he says: "**Open!**". It is by "**opening**" to God and to the entire world that **the person is healed**. Healing requires that both organs remain healthy. We could say that this is also true in the reality of Christian faith. Above all, it is necessary that the ear (that is, the person) be "opened" to listen to the Word of God.

Then the tongue breaks loose and you can talk. There is a direct connection between listening to the word and communicating. He who does not listen remains silent, also in faith. It is for us an invitation to pay attention to the weight of our words. At times, perhaps we are distracted or unprepared, we expressed with bad words or, worse, we misuse them. The Apostle James reminds us: "**From the same mouth come the blessing and the curse. This, my brothers, should not be like that**" (3,9-10). Also, we, deaf and dumb, need to listen, to speak and speak "correctly" and make our conversations illuminate and edify those who listen to us. That is why it is **necessary to listen to the "Word of God"** so that it purifies our "words - conversations", our language and our own way of expressing ourselves. That is our responsibility as Christians, because the word is the only means we have to communicate the Gospel message and transmit the message of the Kerygma, the message of the Good News of Jesus. **Assuring us that He is the savior, our savior, the one who gives us life. Amen.**

Del Escritorio del Párroco

XXIII Domingo del T.O. - Escuchamos hoy el pasaje evangélico de la **curación de un sordomudo**. Jesús lleva a cabo esta curación en una tierra pagana situada más allá de las fronteras de Israel. Con eso **Marcos destaca que el Evangelio no está reservado solo a los que son del pueblo de Israel**, sino que todos tienen derecho a conocer la misericordia y el amor de Dios que libra y salva. Jesús toma el sordomudo y lo aparta de la gente, como si quisiera subrayar que es necesaria una relación personal, directa, íntima, entre él y el enfermo. Los

Milagros se producen siempre en el contexto de una amistad profunda y confiada en Dios. Jesús levanta la mirada al cielo y le dice al sordomudo: **“¡Efatá!”**, es decir, **“¡Ábrete!”**. Es una sola palabra, pero sale de una oración y de un corazón lleno del amor de Dios. “Se abrieron sus oídos y al instante, se soltó la atadura de su lengua y hablaba correctamente”. La fuerza de Dios se manifestaba solo con “una palabra”. Basta una sola palabra del Evangelio para cambiar al hombre, para transformar y salvar una vida. Lo que es necesario es que brote de un corazón apasionado como el de Jesús y que sea acogida por un corazón necesitado como el del sordomudo. Jesús, podríamos decir, no se dirige a la oreja y a la boca sino al hombre entero, a toda la persona. Al sordo y no solo a su oreja le dice: **“¡Ábrete!”**. Es **“abriéndose” a Dios** y al mundo entero que todo el hombre queda curado. La curación requiere que ambos órganos queden sanos. Podríamos decir que eso es cierto también en el campo de la fe cristiana. Hace falta, ante todo, que la oreja (es decir el hombre) **se “abra” para escuchar la Palabra de Dios**. Luego la lengua se desata y puede hablar. Hay un vínculo directo entre escuchar la palabra y comunicar. Quien no escucha se queda mudo, también en la fe. Es para nosotros una invitación a prestar atención al peso que tienen nuestras palabras. A veces quizá distraído o poco prevenido malgastamos nuestras palabras o, peor aún, las utilizamos mal. El apóstol Santiago nos recuerda: **“De una misma boca proceden la bendición y la maldición. Esto, hermanos míos, no debe ser así”** (3,9-10). También nosotros, sordos y mudos, necesitamos escuchar para poder hablar y hablar “correctamente” y hacer que nuestras conversaciones iluminen y edifiquen quienes nos escuchan. **Por eso es necesario escuchar la “Palabra de Dios” para que purifique y fecunde nuestras “palabras – conversaciones”**, nuestro lenguaje y nuestro mismo modo de expresarnos. Esa es nuestra responsabilidad de cristianos, porque la palabra es el único medio que tenemos para comunicar el mensaje del Evangelio y transmitir el anuncio del Kerigma, el mensaje de la Buena Nueva de Jesús que nos salva y da vida. Amen.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Ventitreesima domenica del T. O. «Anno B». — Ci sono casi tragici di bambini condannati alla solitudine perché ciechi, sordi e muti dalla nascita. L'impegno e l'abilità degli specialisti del linguaggio riescono a volte ad aprire loro il mondo dei segni e delle parola. Ma quando gli occhi, le orecchie e la lingua del cuore sono bloccati?... Quante persone, quante coppie che non si capiscono, che non si parlano più! Quanti «dialoghi fra sordi», tra individui, tra gruppi, istituzioni o nazioni, quando viene meno la fiducia reciproca e non si è più capaci di accettare gli altri con la loro fragilità, ma anche con ciò che portano in sé di più prezioso.

Pensando a tutte queste situazioni, possiamo cogliere più facilmente il valore simbolico della guarigione del sordomuto. Dopo essersi scontrato col popolo eletto, sordo alla sua predicazione e ai suoi inviti a cambiar vita, Gesù è passato in terra pagana. Il messia è venuto per occuparsi delle orecchie e della lingua degli uomini (Is. 35, 5-6): li vuole responsabili, capaci di ascoltare ed entrare nel dialogo della salvezza avviato dall'alleanza di Dio col suo popolo. Di fronte a tutti gli atteggiamenti di chiusura e di ripiegamento su se stessi— la reazione dei ricchi, degli orgogliosi, di quelli che non vogliono rinunciare al potere, e anche la nostra, ogni volta che il vangelo chiama la nostra leggerezza, la nostra presunzione, e il nostro egoismo — Gesù ordina «apriti!»

Apriti ad ascoltare, ad accogliere gli insegnamenti del vangelo. Apriti a dire la tua fede con tutta la tua vita. Apriti a tradurre in pratica il Padre nostro che ripeti ogni giorno! Se questo avvenisse, la nostra esistenza diventerebbe trasparente e rimanderebbe senza fatica a Gesù Cristo. Tutti allora potrebbero dire, con le folle del vangelo: «Ha fatto bene ogni cosa: fa udire i sordi e fa parlare i muti».

Il sordo e i sordi— Gesù si è recato nella regione pagana di Tiro perché i Farisei, sordi al vangelo, gli impedivano di parlare. In questo contesto si svolge il miracolo del sordo, che quindi ha il valore di simbolo contro i farisei: non c'è peggior sordo di chi non vuol sentire. Le folle riconoscono in questo gesto di Gesù la parola di Isaia (29, 18-23), che predicava la guarigione della sordità come un'apertura alla parola di Dio. Ecco il mistero di tale parola: come segno di contraddizione, chiude le orecchie; come messaggio di liberazione, slega e muove la lingua.




