### MISSIONARIES OF ST. CHARLES - Scalabrinians

The Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Charles – Scalabrinians – is an International community of religious serving migrants and refugees of different cultures, religions and ethnicities in 32 countries and on five continents.

The Congregation was founded on November 28, 1887, by Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini (1839-1905), bishop of Piacenza (Italy). It was the period of massive emigration from Italy and Europe toward the Americas. It was a far-reaching phenomenon whose importance Bishop Scalabrini was able to grasp in both its social and religious dimensions.

Our missionary focus has been to be migrants with the migrants and to be in mission with people on the move along with a special priority for the poorest migrants. What has become very obvious is that as we have taken more missionary risks and made an effort to clarify our Charism we have been blessed with more and more vocations.



We probably didn't even recognize at the time that we were letting go of anything, but in retrospect, we see God's hand and loving presence. It is our awareness of these moments that gives us the courage and initiative to let go again later on. It is this courage and initiative that are highlighted in today's readings. We come to call it "faith."







### Fr. Feccia's Reflection



**Gesù ha appena invitato i suoi a perdonare senza misura** (Lc. 17,4). Il vangelo non riporta la loro reazione, ma possiamo pensare che la cosa sembri loro impossibile. Comunque sia, si rivolgono a Gesù e noi con loro: «*Aumenta la nostra fede!*» Il «piccolo gregge» degli apostoli, che il vento della Pasqua sospingerà nel campo del mondo, per seminarvi il Cristo, ha compreso subito che la fede è prima di tutto un dono, una grazia. Nessuno può conquistarla, guadagnarla o comprarla: si può soltanto chiederla, implorarla da un altro, dal «Signore» da cui la stessa fede si rivolge.

Senza rispondere direttamente alla loro preghiera, Gesù ricorre ad un'immagine paradossale per esprimere l'incredibile vitalità della fede. Come una leva che solleva molto più del proprio peso, un pizzico di fede è in grado di compiere cose impossibili, straordinarie, come sradicare un grande albero e trapiantarlo nel mare. Per convincersi di questo e cogliere dal vivo la forza fondamentale della fede, basta vedere che cosa può diventare l'esistenza umana più banale di un autentico credente. «*Per me vivere è Cristo*», dice san Paolo (Fil. 1,21): la fede gli ha donato un modo del tutto gratuito, di partecipare alla vita del Signore risorto. È veramente tutto l'uomo, corpo, spirito e cuore, che viene afferrato, trasformato, innalzato, in modo che possa vivere fin d'ora, nel mondo, la realtà del Regno di Dio. La fede è l'ascolto sempre nuovo della Parola: è la fede in espansione, è il tentativo di far rifiorire il vangelo in ogni epoca della storia.

Riconoscendo l'azione stessa del risorto nei frutti straordinari della prima fatica, il credente sa di non potersi vantare della propria fedeltà. Non è forse il Cristo che suscita dentro di lui la fede, la sostiene, e, se vuole, la premia?


**Contro i calcoli interessati**—Dio non è messo particolarmente in buona luce da questa parola, in cui prende l'aspetto di un padrone esigente e poco riguardoso della fatica dei suoi servi. Ma Gesù non intende qui parlarcì di Dio, quanto piuttosto denunciare il fariseismo che abita nei più nascosti ambiti del nostro cuore. I farisei lavorano e molto, ma calcolano tutto anche i diritti e i meriti che hanno dinanzi a Dio per le loro «*buone azioni*». I loro conti e calcoli non saranno convalidati da Dio; lui vuole nei suoi solo un po' di fede, fosse pure così piccola come un granello di senape.

### Il giusto vivrà per la sua fede

La storia della fede comincia con Abramo. Il suo atteggiamento di fronte a Dio è un atteggiamento di fede. Anche se il nostro padre nella fede non ne ha percepito distintamente l'oggetto, tuttavia ha avuto tutte le condizioni personali necessarie alla fede. Egli ha risposto prontamente «sì» alla chiamata di Dio, che sconvolgeva i suoi piani, disposto a dare tutto a lui, anche il figlio, abbandonando ogni calcolo umano.

Egli ha superato le apparenti contraddizioni per rimettersi soltanto alla parola di Dio, e ha visto in essa la verità che salva.

I profeti, durante tutta la storia del popolo di Dio, sono stati gli araldi della fede; lo hanno invitato a superare le assicurazioni e le alleanze umane per attaccarsi con fiducia alla parola data da Dio. Credere è darsi a Dio. Lo vediamo nella prima lettura: Dio «sembra» assente dalla storia. Il profeta lo interroga sull'enigma della oppressione e della ingiustizia che dilagano nella società in cui vive sia all'interno di Israele sia nel gioco delle nazioni per il quale i deboli sono schiacciati. Dio risponde che la fede è l'unica via per comprendere il mistero della storia. La risposta di Dio non è però una facile consolazione: egli parla di una ancor lunga attesa. Ciò che conta è restare saldamente ed unicamente ancorati a Dio; credere al suo amore nonostante ogni apparenza contraria, perché la sua parola non ci può ingannare.

## Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

### FAITH IN ACTION


Today's scriptures are situated in the midst of a long lesson on the vocation of discipleship. Over the last several weeks we have heard about our calling to be humble, to detach ourselves from worldly possessions, to give and receive forgiveness, and to care for those in need. In the next two weeks we will hear about our calling to give thanks in all things and to persevere in faithfulness until the end.

This Sunday our attention is focused on the gift of faith, a gift that is meant not to be put on a shelf, but to be put into action. Habakkuk offers us a good example. He believes that God will answer prayers and intervene on behalf of the suffering. He puts this faith into action in the form of an urgent plea to God, and receives a vision that his faith will surely be rewarded. In the Gospel, the image of faith the size of a mustard seed illustrates the power of faith well used. The story of the faithful servants reminds us that putting our faith into action is an essential requirement of the vocation of discipleship.

### "STIR INTO FLAME THE GIFT YOU HAVE FROM GOD"

The Spirit has many means of enkindling and tending the flame of faith within us—nature, life experiences, our Christian companions, the sacraments, the scriptures, Church teaching, and the life of service. We are indeed blessed to receive such a gift. Yet that precious flame can fade into a mere ember unless we stoke it into a blazing fire from which others can derive warmth and light. The reading from Timothy encourages us to put our faith into action "with the help of the Holy Spirit that dwells within us" (2 Timothy 1:14). The Spirit will increase not only our faith, but our "power and love and self-control" (2 Timothy 1:7) when we respond to the Christian vocation to put the gift of faith into action.
