From the Pastor's Desk

XXXI SUNDAY OF THE O.T. This Sunday, the Church invites us to reflect on the two commandments of Jesus' love: "love God with all your heart and your neighbor as yourselves. For our reflection, I am going to propose the life of our Patron Saint and the words of Pope Francis of this past Monday to the Scalabrinians Missionaries.

1. The life of St. Charles Borromeo, Patron of the Missionaries of San Carlos, Scalabrinians. St. Charles Borromeo, a saint who took the words of Jesus very seriously: "**He who saves his life loses it, but he who spends his life for Me will save it.**" He was from a very wealthy family, and his older brother, to whom most of the inheritance corresponded, died suddenly when he fell from a horse. He considered the death of his brother as a warning sent from heaven, to be prepared, because the least expected day God comes to demand accountability and bring you to heaven. He renounced his riches and was ordained priest and later Archbishop of Milan. There were accusations that his election was due to nepotism (he was the nephew of the Pope), his enormous fruits of holiness show that it was the election of the Holy Spirit. As bishop, of a huge diocese that brought together the peoples of Lombardy, Venice, Switzerland, Piedmont and Liguria, he attended to them all, he made several synods and pastoral visits to his parishioners. His episcopal shield bore a single word: "Humilitas", humility, being noble and very rich, living among the people, depriving himself of luxuries, rightly so was called: "**father of the poor**". He said that a bishop too careful of his health can not become a saint and that every priest and every apostle should be able to do more work, then enjoying leisure time. During the plague he remained to serve and care for the sick. With the needy he was supremely understanding. To his collaborators he was very friendly and attentive, but demanding. To himself he was very demanding and severe. He was the first Secretary of State of the Vatican (in the modern sense). He was the target of a vile attack. While praying in his chapel he was shot, but he was unharmed. He forgave the aggressor generously. He was the protagonist in the implementation of the Council of Trent and of the reform of the Catholic Church. He founded seminars to train and prepared priests, and wrote wise regulations for these institutes, that many bishops copied them to organize accordingly their own seminars. He was a friend of several Saints like St. Pius V, St. Francis of Borja, St. Felipe Neri, St. Felix of Cantalicio and St. Andrew Avellino and more. He died young and poor, having greatly enriched many with grace ... **He died saying: "I'm coming, Lord, I'm coming".** In Milan nobody slept that night, hearing the tremendous news that his beloved Cardinal Archbishop, was dying. Scalabrini gave him to us as an example of apostolic zeal, to care for migrants.

Pope Francis in the Consistory's Hall, met with the 45 Missionaries of San Carlos, "Scalabrinians", whom he received in audience on the occasion of their General Chapter, and pleaded to them: **"Always find new ways of evangelization and closeness, with the purpose to carry out with dynamic fidelity the charisma that puts yourselves at the service of migrants"**. Please, announce the Word and walk with the migrants. **"Carry out with brave spirit and persevering apostolic enthusiasm the love of Christ to those who, far from their homeland and their families, run the risk of feeling distant from God"**. Listen to them with com-passion and sincere closeness. **"Evangelization is done by walking with people,"** stresses Francisco, because: **"first of all we must listen to the people, listen to the history of the communities, especially the disappointed hopes, the expectations of hearts, the trials of faith"**. Please, help the migrant not to become a person without an identity. There is a risk, the Holy Father warns, that the migrant becomes an uprooted person, without a face, without identity, and this, he says, is **"a very serious loss, that can be avoided by listening, walking by the people and communities of migrants, being able to do it is a grace, and it is also a resource for the Church and for the world"**. **"Carry out your mission faithfully to the charism your beloved founder John Baptist Blessed Scalabrini has entrusted to you. Finally, I encourage you to carry out your mission "with your own style matured in the fruitful encounter between the charism of Blessed Scalabrini and the historical circumstances of today"**. The Holy Father explains: **"place your attention on the dignity of the human person, especially there were their dignity experienced the most harms and betrayals" and so bring "educational commitment to the new generations, the catechesis and family ministry "**. I encourage you to accompany **"the exodus" of these days. My Apostolic Blessings to all.**

XXXI DOMINGO DEL T.O. En este domingo que la Iglesia nos invita a reflexionar sobre los dos mandamientos del amor de Jesús: amar a Dios con todo nuestro ser y al prójimo como a nosotros mismo. Le voy a proponer la vida de nuestro Santo Patrono y las palabras del Papa Francisco a los scalabrinianos capitolares del lunes pasado.

1. Vida de San Carlos Borromeo, Patrono de los Misioneros de San Carlos, Scalabrinianos. San Carlos Borromeo, un santo que tomó muy en serio las palabras de Jesús; "Quien ahorra su vida, la pierde, pero el que gasta su vida por Mí, la ganará". Era de familia muy rica. Su hermano mayor, a quien correspondía la mayor parte de la herencia, murió repentinamente al caer de un caballo. El consideró la muerte de su hermano como un aviso enviado por el cielo, para estar preparado porque el día menos pensado llega Dios por medio de la muerte a pedirnos cuentas. Renunció a sus riquezas y fue ordenado sacerdote y más tarde Arzobispo de Milán. Aunque no faltan las acusaciones de que su elección fue por nepotismo (era sobrino del Papa), sus enormes frutos de santidad demuestran que fue una elección del Espíritu Santo. Como obispo, su diócesis que reunía a los pueblos de Lombardía, Venecia, Suiza, Piamonte y Liguria. Los atendía a todos. Hizo varios sínodos y visitas pastorales a su feligreses. Su escudo llevaba una sola palabra: "Humilitas", humildad. El, siendo noble y riquísimo, vivía cerca del pueblo, privándose de lujos. Fue llamado con razón "padre de los pobres". Decía que un obispo demasiado cuidadoso de su salud no consigue llegar a ser santo y que a todo sacerdote y a todo apóstol deben sobrarle trabajos para hacer, en vez de tener tiempo de sobra para perder. Durante la peste se quedó a servir y atender a los enfermos. Para con los necesitados era supremamente comprensivo. Para con sus colaboradores era muy amigable y atento, pero exigente. Y para consigo mismo era exigentísimo y severo. Fue el primer secretario de Estado del Vaticano (en el sentido moderno). Fue blanco de un vil atentado, mientras rezaba en su capilla, pero salió ilesa, perdonando generosamente al agresor. Fue el protagonista en la implementación del Concilio de Trento y su debida reforma de la Iglesia Católica. Fundó seminarios para formar sacerdotes bien preparados, y redactó para esos institutos unos reglamentos tan sabios, que muchos obispos los copiaron para organizar según ellos sus propios seminarios. Fue amigo de varios Santos como San Pío V, San Francisco de Borja, San Felipe Neri, San Félix de Cantalicio y San Andrés Avelino y más. Murió joven y pobre, habiendo enriquecido enormemente a muchos con la gracia.murió diciendo: "Ya voy, Señor, ya voy". En Milán casi nadie durmió esa noche, ante la tremenda noticia de que su queridísimo Cardenal arzobispo, estaba agonizando. Scalabruni nos lo dio como ejemplo de celo apostólico, para cuidar a los migrantes.

Papa Francisco en la Sala del Consistorio, a los 45 Misioneros de San Carlos, "scalabrinianos", a quienes recibió en audiencia con ocasión de su Capítulo General, les pidió: "Encontrar siempre nuevos caminos de evangelización y de cercanía, con el fin de realizar con dinámica fidelidad el carisma que los pone al servicio de los migrantes". Además, anuncie la Palabra y caminen con los migrantes. "Lleven con valiente y perseverante entusiasmo apostólico el amor de Cristo a quienes, lejos de su patria y de su familia, corren el riesgo de sentirse lejos también de Dios". Escuche con con-pasión y cercanía sincera. "La evangelización se hace caminando con la gente", subraya Francisco, porque "ante todo hay que escuchar a la gente, escuchar la historia de las comunidades; sobre todo las esperanzas decepcionadas, las expectativas de los corazones, las pruebas de la fe". Que el migrante no se convierta en una persona sin identidad. Hay el riesgo, advierte el Santo Padre, que el migrante se convierta en una persona desarraigada, sin rostro, sin identidad. Y ésta -señala- es "una pérdida muy grave, que puede evitarse escuchando, caminando al lado de las personas y las comunidades de migrantes. Poder hacerlo es una gracia, y es también un recurso para la Iglesia y para el mundo". Lleven adelante la misión con el carisma de su amado fundador el Beato Scalabrini.

Finalmente, los aliento a llevar adelante la propia misión "con el propio estilo madurado en el encuentro fecundo entre el carisma del Beato Scalabrini y las circunstancias históricas". Estilo del cual – explica el Santo Padre – "forma parte la atención que ponen a la dignidad de la persona humana, especialmente allí donde ha sido mayormente herida y amenazada" y del cual forman parte también "el compromiso educativo con las nuevas generaciones, la catequesis y la pastoral familiar". Acompañen las holas de éxodos de estos días. Bendiciones Apostólicas a todos.

Fr. Feccia's Reflection

Trentunesima Domenica del T.O.. Anno "B" — Come orientarsi nell'intrico di problemi e di comandamenti della legge? La domanda che lo scriba rivolge a Gesù è sincera. La risposta che gli viene data è doppiamente originale. Dalla confessione di fede che ogni giudeo devoto recita due volte al giorno, Gesù riprende in primo luogo il comandamento dell'amore di Dio, sottolineando così tutta l'importanza. Se Dio è l'unico Signore, e nessuno è pari a lui, di modo che nulla ha valore se non in rapporto a Lui, il precezzo di amarlo sopra ogni cosa va indubbiamente collocato al primo posto. Ma Gesù richiama l'attenzione dello scriba anche su un altro comanda-mento. Sebbene al secondo posto, l'amore del prossimo, per Gesù è inseparabile dall'amore di Dio. Infatti è l'amore per gli altri che rende l'uomo simile a Dio e lo fa partecipare alla vita divina: non è forse questa la meta a cui deve condurre la legge? C'è un segno inequivocabile che contraddistingue chi non è lontano dal regno di Dio: la capacità di amare. Non la pratica religiosa, non la fedeltà all'osservanza, ma i gesti concreti che esprimo l'amore, nelle sue dimensioni inseparabili: amore di Dio e amore del prossimo. Non c'è altro comandamento più grande di questi. Basta cancellarli perché tutto l'edificio morale crolla.

La risposta di Gesù è sufficiente a chiudere la bocca ai farisei di tutti i tempi, che ignorano troppo spesso lo spirito della legge a vantaggio della lettera. E deve far riflettere molte istituzioni che si preoccupano talmente dell'ordine e della virtù da non lasciare più spazio alla gratuità dell'amore. Alla voce di queste parole, non è difficile orientarsi nei doveri verso Dio e verso gli uomini. «Se devi recarti alla preghiera e tuo fratello ha bisogno di una tisana, preparagli prima la tisana...» (Ruysbroek)

Un solo comandamento — Matteo e Luca faranno dire a Gesù i due comandamenti dell'amore (verso Dio e verso il prossimo), non sono altro che due aspetti di un unico atteggiamento, vivere con e per gli altri, in comunione con Dio. Marco nel vangelo di oggi apre un orizzonte non meno ricco, presentando l'amore come contenuto essenziale della nuova alleanza. Tutta la vita, quando è animata dall'amore, diventa un «culto», cioè il luogo della vera religione.




