

From the Pastor's Desk

I SUNDAY OF ADVENT - Year B. This weekend, we begin the new spiritual journey of Advent, illuminated by the First Gospel, the one of Saint Mark, which was written around the year 64 and which will accompany us throughout the year. It is known as Gospel of discipleship. I believe, it will help us strengthen and renew our faith as true disciples of Jesus. We are coming out of the THANKSGIVING celebrations, that we lived in a sober and familiar way with the few members of our family. But, with much gratitude, affection and love with the Lord and with each other. No doubt, we hope that this epidemic will disappear soon.

The theme that this Sunday presents to us, it is a strong invitation from Jesus to be **attentive, prepared, vigilant** for when the "hour" will come. The first Christians took this admonition of Jesus very seriously and lived almost obsessively waiting for the second coming of Jesus at the end of time. They believed that the Risen one would not delay. The challenges began when they realized that time was passing and the coming of the Lord was occurring and that one by one the apostles were entering eternity. We notice, often in the gospels the **call to be vigilant, to be on the alert, to stay awake**. According to Mark, Jesus' command is not only for the disciples who were listening to him: "**What I say to you, I say to everyone: be vigilant**". It is an exhortation for all of us followers of Jesus to live on alert. Undoubtedly, these days of epidemic have challenged us more than a few times with alarming data and news from relatives and family members who are suffering from the calamity of the virus. I believe **that this season of Advent while help us to prepare for the coming of the Messiah-Savior, it is a favorable time of grace to be able to contemplate the living face of Jesus, which attracts, calls, challenges, enlightens, strengthens and can also awaken a new meaning and path in our lifetime**. Let us make this season of Advent an opportunity to renew our journey with a living experience of faith as disciples of Jesus in a true commitment, participating in the celebration of the sacraments, reading the Bible, offer our daily prayer within the family and in person along with true experiences of love and charity. Remember, every Tuesday and Thursday, we have the Holy Mass at 8:00AM. **Ask yourself: Could I, at least once a week, nurture myself on the Word of Jesus and His Most Precious Body?**

Del Escritorio del Párroco

I Domingo de ADVIENTO – Año B. Este fin de semana comenzamos un nuevo camino espiritual, el Adviento, iluminado del Primer Evangelio, el de San Marco, que fue escrito alrededor del año 64 y que nos acompañará a lo largo de todo el año. Es conocido como el evangelio del discipulado. Nos ayudará a fortalecer y renovar nuestra fe como verdaderos discípulos de Jesús. Vamos saliendo de las celebraciones de ACCION DE GRACIAS que vivimos en una manera sobria y familiar con los pocos miembros de la familia. Pero, cierto con **muchísima gratitud, afecto y cariño con el Señor** y los unos con los otros. Sin duda en la esperanza que esta epidemia desaparezca pronto. El tema que nos presenta este domingo es una invitación fuerte de Jesús a **estar atento, preparado, vigilante** para cuándo llegará “**la hora**”. Los primeros cristianos tomaron muy a pecho esta admonición de Jesús y vivían casi de una manera obsesionada la espera de la segunda llegada de Jesús al final de los tiempos. Ellos creían que el resucitado no podía tardar. Los retos comenzaron cuando se dieron cuenta que el tiempo pasaba y la venida del Señor se demoraba y que uno a uno los apóstoles entraban en la eternidad. Notamos, frecuentemente en los evangelios el llamado a ser: vigilantes, en estar en alerta, en vivir despiertos. Según Marcos, la orden de Jesús no es sólo para los discípulos que le estaban escuchando. “**Lo que les digo a ustedes se los digo a todos: velen!**”! Es una exhortación por todos nosotros los seguidores de Jesús de vivir en alerta. Sin duda, estos días de epidemia nos ha desafiado a más de una vez con datos alarmantes y noticias de familiares y conocidos que están sufriendo por la calamidad del virus. **Creo que este tiempo de Adviento preparándonos a la llegada del Mesías -Salvador es un tiempo favorable de gracias para poder recuperar el rostro vivo de Jesús, que atrae, llama, interpela, ilumina, fortalece y también puede despertar un sentido y camino nuevo en nuestra vida.** Hagamos que este tiempo de Adviento sea una oportunidad para renovar nuestro caminar con una viva vivencia de fe como discípulos de Jesús, en un compromiso verdadero participando en la celebración de los sacramentos, lectura de la Biblia, rezo cotidiano en familia y personal y, con vivencias de amor y caridad. Recuerden, todos los días tememos la Santa Misa a las 6:30PM. Pregúntate: ¿Podría yo almeno una vez a la semana alimentarme de la Palabra de Jesús y de Su Preciosísimo Cuerpo?

I domenica di AVVENTO - Anno B. In questo fine settimana iniziamo un nuovo cammino spirituale, l'Avvento, illuminato dal Primo Vangelo, quello di San Marco, che è stato scritto intorno all'anno 64 e che ci accompagnerà durante tutto l'anno. È il vangelo conosciuto come quello del discepolato. Ci aiuterà certamente a rafforzare e rinnovare la nostra fede come veri discepoli di Gesù. Stiamo uscendo dai festeggiamenti del RINGRAZIAMENTO che viviamo in una maniera sobria e familiare con i pochi membri della famiglia. Sono stati giorni di gratitudine, affetto e amore che abbiamo trascorso con il Signore e con i nostri cari. Senza dubbio tutti aneliamo con speranza che questa epidemia scompaia presto. Il tema che ci presenta questa domenica è un forte invito di Gesù ad **essere attenti, preparati, vigilanti per quando "l'ora" verrà**. I primi cristiani presero molto sul serio questo ammonimento di Gesù e vissero quasi ossessivamente aspettando la seconda venuta di Gesù alla fine dei tempi. Credevano che il Risorto ritornasse pronto per la glorificazione eterna. I problemi iniziarono quando si resero conto che il tempo stava passando e la seconda venuta del Signore non arrivava ed uno ad uno gli apostoli entravano nell'eternità. Notiamo, spesso nei Vangeli, la chiamata ad essere: **vigilanti, nell'allerta e rimanere svegli**. Secondo Marco, il comando di Gesù non è solo per i discepoli che lo stavano ascoltando, ma anche per tutti noi: "**Quello che dico a voi lo dico a tutti: vegliate!**" È un'esortazione a tutti noi seguaci di Gesù a vivere in allerta. Indubbiamente, questi giorni di epidemia ci hanno sfidato più di qualche volta con numeri allarmanti e notizie di parenti e conoscenti che stanno soffrendo o che sono morti per la calamità del virus.
