

Second Sunday of Advent

December 6, 2020

Every valley shall be filled in,
every mountain and hill
shall be made low.

—Isaiah 40:4



II SUNDAY OF ADVENT. On this second Sunday of Advent, we begin the reading of the Gospel of Saint Mark that will accompany us in this liturgical year. The Gospel is the "good news" of Jesus Christ, and for all of us particularly in this time that we are struggling with the pandemic and other difficulties, we believe that the gospel's words enlighten us, liberate, motivate and transform us to continue walking confidently that "the one we hope to come is the "ONE" who will open for us to a new future of hopes and better times. On the eve of the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, I would like to leave you with the synthesis of Her apparitions, taken from "[queen of the American guilds](#)".

1st Apparition: At dawn on December 9, 1531, Juan Diego, an Indian convert, was going to Tlatelolco to attend catechism class and hear the Mass. As he was passing Tepeyac Hill, he saw a brilliant light on the summit and heard the strains of celestial music. Filled with wonder, he stopped. Then he heard a feminine voice asking him to ascend. When he reached the top, he saw the Blessed Virgin Mary standing in the midst of a glorious light, in heavenly splendor. The beauty of her youthful countenance and her look of loving kindness filled Juan Diego with unspeakable happiness as he listened to the words which she spoke to him in his native language. She told him she was the perfect and eternal Virgin Mary, Mother of the true God, and made known to him her desire that a shrine be built there where she could demonstrate her love, her compassion and her protection. "For I am your merciful Mother", she said, "to you and to all humankind who love me and trust in me and invoke my help. Therefore, go to the dwelling of the Bishop in Mexico City and say that the Virgin Mary sent you to make known to him her great desire."

2nd Apparition: The Bishop was reluctant to believe Juan Diego's story. Juan returned to Tepeyac Hill where he found the Blessed Virgin waiting for him, and told her of his failure. She bade him return to the Bishop the next day and repeat her wishes.

3rd Apparition: The Bishop then requested that the Lady give him a sign. Juan reported that evening and she promised to grant his petition on the following morning. But Juan was prevented from coming because of a sudden and severe illness of his uncle, Juan Bernardino.

4th Apparition: Two days later, on December 12, as he was going to the Church at Tlatelolco in order to bring a priest to his dying uncle, Juan Diego was stopped by the Lady, who had come down from Tepeyac Hill to meet him in the road. She listened quietly to Juan's excuse for not having kept his appointment with her the day before. When he had finished speaking, she said, "It is well, littlest and dearest of my sons, but now listen to me. Do not let anything afflict you and be not afraid of illness or pain. Am I not here who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Are you not in the crossing of my arms? Is there anything else you need? Do not fear for your uncle for he is not going to die. Be assured... he is already well."

Having heard these words, Juan Diego rejoiced and asked for the sign he was to take to the Bishop. He was told to climb to the top of the hill where she had spoken to him on three previous occasions. She said he would find many flowers blooming there which he was to cut and bring to her. Juan Diego did as he was told though he knew no flowers had ever bloomed before on the stony summit. He discovered a marvelous garden of dew-fresh blossoms which he cut as she had asked. Placing them in his rough cloak, or tilma, he brought the flowers to the Lady who rearranged them and told him to take them to the Bishop; that this was the sign to persuade him to carry out her wishes.

When Juan Diego, radiantly happy, stood before Bishop Fray Juan de Zumarraga and told him of the fourth encounter with the Lady, he opened his tilma to show the Bishop the sign; the flowers cascaded to the floor – but to the astonishment of the Bishop and Juan Diego, there appeared upon the coarse fabric of the Indian's mantle a marvelously wrought, exquisitely colored portrait of the Blessed Virgin, just as Juan Diego had previously described her.

5th Apparition: Earlier that same day, December 12, she had also appeared to Juan's uncle, Juan Bernardino, and restored him to health as she had told Juan Diego. Juan Diego was at that time fifty-seven years old; his uncle was sixty-eight. Both had been among the first of the natives to be baptized into the true faith several years before.

II DOMINGO DE ADVIENTO. En este segundo domingo de adviento comenzamos la lectura del inicio del Evangelio de San Marcos que nos acompañará en este año litúrgico. El Evangelio es la "buena noticia" de Jesucristo, y para todos nosotros en este tiempo que estamos viviendo de pandemia y de dificultades creemos que sus palabras nos iluminan, libera motiva y transforma para seguir caminando confiado que "aquel que esperamos que venga es alguien que nos abrirá a un nuevo futuro con cierta esperanza de tiempo mejores. Quisiera dejarlo con la síntesis de las apariciones de la Virgen de Guadalupe, así como las presenta la revista VIDA NUEVA.

Las Apariciones de Nuestra Señora la Virgen de Guadalupe a Juan Diego, la milagrosa estampación de su Santa Imagen en el humilde ayate de su vidente y su mensaje de amor por nosotros, tienen como fin principal anunciar a su amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, a los pueblos que habitaban el "nuevo mundo".

PRIMERA APARICIÓN: sábado 9 de diciembre en la madrugada.

Juan Diego oye cantos de pájaros. Le llaman por su nombre; sube a la cumbre del cerro del Tepeyac y ve a la Niña que le ordena ir ante el Obispo para pedirle un templo en el llano. "Hijito mío el más amado: yo soy la perfecta siempre Virgen Santa María, Madre del verdad erísimo Dios..., mucho quiero tengan la bondad de construirme mi templecito... Allí estaré siempre dispuesta a escuchar su llanto, su tristeza, para purificar, para curar todas sus diferentes miserias, sus penas, sus dolores".

SEGUNDA APARICIÓN: sábado 9 de diciembre aproximadamente a las 5 de la tarde. Juan Diego vuelve a la cumbre y da cuenta de la

incredulidad del Obispo y pide que escoja otro mensajero. Pero la Virgen le confirma en su misión y le ordena insistir al día siguiente. "Hijito mío el más pequeño: es indispensable que sea totalmente por tu intervención que se lleve a cabo mi deseo. Muchísimo te ruego y con rigor te mando, que mañana vayas otra vez a ver al Obispo. Y hazle oír muy claro mi voluntad, para que haga mi templo que le pido".

TERCERA APARICIÓN: Domingo 10 de diciembre como a las 3 de la tarde.

Nuevamente en la cumbre, Juan Diego refiere su segunda entrevista con el Obispo. Aún no le cree y le ordena pedir a la Señora alguna señal. La Virgen ordena a Juan Diego que vuelva al cerro al día siguiente para recibir la señal que le dará. "Así está bien, hijito mío, el más amado. Mañana de nuevo vendrás aquí para que lleves al Gran Sacerdote la prueba, la señal que te pide. Con eso enseguida te creerá, y ya para nada desconfiará de ti". Juan Diego, no vuelve por la enfermedad de su tío Juan Bernardino.

CUARTA APARICIÓN: martes 12 de diciembre muy de madrugada.

Ante la gravedad de su tío, Juan Diego sale a México para buscar un sacerdote. Rodeó el cerro para que la Virgen no lo encontrara. Pero ella sale a su encuentro; lo tranquiliza de la enfermedad de su tío: "Te doy la plena seguridad de que ya sanó": Lo envía a la cumbre por las rosas que serán la señal, A su regreso, la Virgen le dice: "Hijito queridísimo: estas diferentes flores son la prueba, la señal que le llevarás al Obispo. De parte mía le dirás que por favor vea en ella mi deseo, y con eso, ejecute mi voluntad".

QUINTA APARICIÓN: martes 12 de diciembre muy de madrugada.

Al mismo tiempo que se aparece a Juan Diego, se aparece a Juan Bernardino, tío del vidente, en su casa le cura de sus enfermedades y le manifiesta su nombre y pide que, de ahora en adelante, a su preciosa imagen precisamente se le llame, se le conozca como la Siempre Virgen Santa María de Guadalupe".

LA ESTAMPACIÓN EN LA TILMA: martes 12 de diciembre al mediodía.

En la casa del Obispo Fray Juan de Zumárraga, Juan Diego muestra las rosas que llevaba en su ayate, señal dada por la Virgen. "Desplegó su tilma, donde llevaba las flores. Y así, al tiempo que se esparcieron las diferentes flores preciosas, en ese mismo instante... apareció de improviso en el humilde ayate la venerada imagen de la siempre Virgen María, Madre de Dios, tal como ahora tenemos la dicha de venerarla en lo que es su hogar predilecto, su templo del Tepeyac".
