From the Pastor's Desk

II SUNDAY OF ADVENT. We continue our Advent journey vigilant, awake and attentive in anticipation of the coming of Baby Jesus our Savior with two Marian festivities: the IMMACULATE CONCEPTION tomorrow and on the 12th of December, NUESTRA SEÑORA DE GUADALUPE. I will propose to you a brief narration of the Guadalupe miracle. 10 years after the conquests of the Spaniards, this happened. On a Saturday of 1531 at the beginning of December, an Indian named Juan Diego, newly converted, was going very early in the morning from where he lived into Mexico City to attend his catechism classes and to hear the Holy Mass. When he reached the hill called Tepeyac, he was surprised with the gentle singing of birds and heard a voice calling him by name. He climbed to the summit and saw a marvel and beautiful Lady,

whose dress was bright as the sun, which with very kind and attentive words said: "Juanito: the smallest of my children, I am the most Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the true God, for whom one lives. I strongly wish that a temple be built here, to show and lavish all my love, compassion, help and defense to all the inhabitants of this land and to all who invoke me and put their trust in me. Go to the Bishop and tell him that I want a temple on this place. Go and put all your effort into it. Juan Diego visited the Bishop who did not believe to his words, then he returned to his town and met the Virgin Mary again and explained what happened. The Virgin asked him to go back to talk with the bishop the next day and propose the petition again. This time the bishop, after hearing Juan Diego told him that he should go and tell the Lady to give him some sign to prove that she is the Mother of God and that it is her will that a temple be built. On the way back, Juan Diego found Maria and told her the facts. The Virgin commanded him to return the next day to the same place because there she would give him the signal. The next day Juan Diego could not return to the hill because his uncle Juan Bernardino was very sick. The dawn of December 12 Juan Diego marched in a hurry to get a priest for his uncle as he was dying. When he arrived at the place where he had to meet the Lady, he preferred to take another path to avoid her. Suddenly Mary went out to meet him and asked where he was going. The embarrassed Indian explained what was happening. The Virgin told Juan Diego not to worry, that his uncle would not die and that he was already cured. Then the Indian asked for the signal that he should take to the bishop. Mary told him to climb to the top of the hill where he will find fresh roses from Castilla and putting them in his apron-tilma, bring some hear to me, where she touched them and then he took them to the bishop. Once before Mons. Zumárraga Juan Diego unfolded his apron, the roses fell to the ground and on the tilma remained impressed what is now known as the image of the Virgin Mary of Guadalupe. Seeing this, the bishop took the holy image to the Main Church and built a hermitage in the place indicated by the Indian. Pius X proclaimed her as "Patroness of all Latin America", Pius XI of all "Americas", Pius XII called her "Imperatrixes of the Americas" and John XXIII "The Celestial Missionary of the New World" and "the Mother of the Americas". The image of the Virgin Mary of Guadalupe is venerated in Mexico with great devotion and in many other countries. The miracles obtained by those who pray to the Virgin of Guadalupe are numerous (taken from ACIPRENSA). The Lady of Guadalupe helps us by venerating her with faith and devotion to prepare a little place in our Heart for her Son who will come as the Immanuel-God with us! Amen!



II DOMINGO de ADVIENTO. Continuemos nuestro camino velando, despierto y atento en la espera de la venida del Niño Dios nuestro Salvador con dos fiestas marianas: la INMACULADA CONCEPCION mañana y el día 12 Dic. NUESTRA SEÑORA DE GUADALUPE. En seguida una breve narración del milagro guadalupano. 10 años después de las conquistas de los españoles, esto sucedió. Un sábado de 1531 a principios de diciembre, un indio llamado Juan Diego, recién convertido, iba muy de madrugada del pueblo en que residía a la ciudad de México a asistir a sus clases de catecismo y a oír la Santa Misa. Al llegar junto al cerro llamado Tepeyac amanecía y escuchó una voz que lo llamaba por su nombre. Él subió a la cumbre y vio a una Señora de sobrehumana belleza, cuyo vestido era brillante como el sol, la cual con palabras

muy amables y atentas le dijo: "Juanito: el más pequeño de mis hijos, yo soy la siempre Virgen María, Madre del verdadero Dios, por quien se vive. Deseo vivamente que se me construya aquí un templo, para en él mostrar y prodigar todo mi amor, compasión, auxilio y defensa a todos los moradores de esta tierra y a todos los que me invoquen y en Mí confien. Ve donde el Señor Obispo y dile que deseo un templo en este llano. Anda y pon en ello todo tu esfuerzo". De regreso a su pueblo Juan Diego se encontró de nuevo con la Virgen María y le explicó lo ocurrido. La Virgen le pidió que al día siguiente fuera nuevamente a hablar con el obispo y le repitiera el mensaje. Esta vez el obispo, luego de oír a Juan Diego le dijo que debía ir y decirle a la Señora que le diese alguna señal que probara que era la Madre de Dios y que era su voluntad que se le construyera un templo. De regreso, Juan Diego halló a María y le narró los hechos. La Virgen le mandó que volviese al día siguiente al mismo lugar pues allí le daría la señal. Al día siguiente Juan Diego no pudo volver al cerro pues su tío Juan Bernardino estaba muy enfermo. La madrugada del 12 de diciembre Juan Diego marchó a toda prisa para conseguir un sacerdote a su tío pues se estaba muriendo. Al llegar al lugar por donde debía encontrarse con la Señora prefirió tomar otro camino para evitarla. De pronto María salió a su encuentro y le preguntó a dónde iba. El indio avergonzado le explicó lo que ocurría. La Virgen dijo a Juan Diego que no se preocupara, que su tío no moriría y que ya estaba sano. Entonces el indio le pidió la señal que debía llevar al obispo. María le dijo que subiera a la cumbre del cerro donde halló rosas de Castilla frescas y poniéndose la tilma, cortó cuantas pudo y se las llevó al obispo. Una vez ante Monseñor Zumárraga Juan Diego desplegó su manta, cayeron al suelo las rosas y en la tilma estaba pintada con lo que hoy se conoce como la imagen de la Virgen de Guadalupe. Viendo esto, el obispo llevó la imagen santa a la Iglesia Mayor y edificó una ermita en el lugar que había señalado el indio. Pio X la proclamó como "Patrona de toda la América Latina", Pio XI de todas las "Américas", Pio XII la llamó "Emperatriz de las Américas" y Juan XXIII "La Misionera Celeste del Nuevo Mundo" y "la Madre de las Américas". La imagen de la Virgen de Guadalupe se venera en México con grandísima devoción y en muchos otros países, y los milagros obtenidos por los que rezan a la Virgen de Guadalupe son extraordinarios. (de ACIPRENSA). ¡La Morenita nos ayude venerándola con fe y devoción a preparar un lugarcito en nuestro Corazón para su Hijo aquel por el cual vivimos!

Continuiamo il nostro cammino vigilando, svegli e attenti in attesa della venuta del Bambino Gesù, nostro Salvatore, con due festeggiamenti mariani: l'IMMACOLATA CONCEZIONE domani e il 12 dicembre, NUESTRA SEÑORA DI GUADALUPE. Vi propongo una breve narrazione del miracolo di Guadalupe. 10 anni dopo le conquiste-invasioni degli spagnoli, questo è successo. Un sabato del 1531, all'inizio di dicembre, un indiano di nome

Juan Diego, recentemente convertito, andava molto presto la mattina dalla città in cui viveva a Città del Messico (40km) per frequentare le sue lezioni di catechismo e ascoltare la Santa Messa. Quando raggiunse la collina chiamata Tepeyac, se sorprendió del canto dei passeri e sentì una voce che lo chiamava per nome. Salì sulla vetta e vide una Signora di bellezza sovrumanica, il cui vestito era luminoso come il sole, che con parole molto gentili gli disse: "Juanito: il più piccolo dei miei figli, sono la Santissima Vergine Maria, Madre del vero Dio, per il quale si vive. Desidero fortemente che qui venga costruito un tempio, per mostrare e prodigare tutto il mio amore, compassione, aiuto e difesa a tutti gli abitanti di questa terra e a tutti coloro che mi invocano e si affidano a me. Vai dal signor Vescovo e digli che voglio un tempio in questa pianura. Vai e applica tutti i tuoi sforzi". Juan Diego tornò nella sua città e incontrò di nuovo la Vergine Maria e le spiegò cosa era successo, non gli aveva creduto. La Vergine le chiese di tornare a parlare con il Vescovo il giorno dopo e riproporre il messaggio. Questa volta il Vescovo, dopo aver ascoltato Juan Diego, gli disse che doveva andare e dire alla Signora di dargli qualche segno per dimostrare che Lei era la Madre di Dio e che era sua volontà che fosse costruito un tempio. Sulla via del ritorno, Juan Diego trovò Maria e gli raccontò i fatti. La Vergine gli ordinò di ritornare il giorno dopo nello stesso posto perché lì le avrebbe dato il segnale. Il giorno dopo Juan Diego non poté tornare sulla collina perché suo zio Juan Bernardino era molto malato. Siamo all'alba del 12 dicembre, Juan Diego si è incamminato in fretta per cercare un prete per l'unzione per suo zio gravemente ammalato. Quando arrivò nel luogo in cui doveva incontrare la Signora, preferì prendere un'altra strada per evitarla. All'improvviso Maria uscì per incontrarlo e gli chiese dove stesse andando. L'indiano imbarazzato spiegò cosa stava succedendo. La Vergine disse a Juan Diego di non preoccuparsi, che suo zio non sarebbe morto e che si incontrava già in buona salute. Quindi l'indiano chiese il segnale che avrebbe dovuto portare al Vescovo. Maria gli disse di salire sulla cima della collina lì troverà rose fresche di Castilla, raccogli quante più potrai, passa a mostrarmele e poi ce le porterai al Vescovo. Davanti a monsignor Zumárraga, Juan Diego aperse il grembiule-tilma, le rose caddero a terra e sulla tilma restò stampato il dipinto con quella che oggi è conosciuta come l'immagine della Vergine di Guadalupe. Vedendo ciò, il Vescovo portò l'immagine sacra alla chiesa principale e costruì un eremo nel luogo indicato dall'indiano. Pio X la proclamò "Patrona di tutta l'America Latina", Pio XI di tutte le "Americhe", Pio XII la chiamò "Imperatrice delle Americhe" e Giovanni XXIII: "La Celeste Missionaria del Nuovo Mondo" e "La Madre delle Americhe". L'immagine della Vergine di Guadalupe è venerata in Messico con grande devozione e in molti altri paesi, e i miracoli ottenuti da coloro che pregano la Vergine di Guadalupe sono numerosissimi. (da ACIPRENSA). La Signora di Guadalupe ci aiuti, venerandola con fede e devozione a preparare un piccolo posto nel nostro cuore per suo Figlio Gesù, colui per il quale viviamo!


