From the Pastor's Desk

SUNDAY OF HOLY FAMILY AND LAST SUNDAY OF THE YEAR.

On this last Sunday of the year and Christmas time, the Church invites us to rejoice with the Child Jesus who assumed our reality and has chosen to be born and be accompanied in his journey by "his parents". Let us embrace, as Pope Francis says this great mystery contemplating the Holy Family of Bethlehem, as the Gospel invites us today when it presents the Virgin Mary and Saint Joseph at the moment in which, guided in dream Saint Joseph listens to the voice of the angel who tells him: **"Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you. Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him"**. We can imagine this small family, in the middle of the night migrating to foreign land. What obedience and faith do Joseph and Maria testify to us. There is no doubt that the message that comes from the Holy Family is, above all, a message of faith. In the family life of Mary and Joseph, God is truly at the center, in the person of Jesus. This is why the Holy Family is indeed holy. Why? Because, it is centered on Jesus. When parents and children breathe together this climate of faith, they have an energy that allows them to face difficult tests, as the experience of the Holy Family shows. For instance, in the dramatic event described in today's Gospel of the flight to Egypt: what a hard test? The Infant Jesus with his Mother Mary and with Saint Joseph are really a unique family icon, but above all are a bright sign of family life. This light that they radiate, it is a light of mercy and salvation for the entire world, a light of truth for every human family and for every family. This light that comes from the Holy Family encourages us to offer human warmth to those families that live tough situations for various reasons; sometimes for lack of peace, harmony, forgiveness and love. In this Christmas time and the end of the year, our thoughts go gratefully to all those families that have walked with us committed and with love throughout the entire year. May the HOLY FAMILY bless all of you abundantly. Likewise, we want to accompany all those families that have lived or are facing very difficult times and situations due to illness or lack of work or discrimination or forced to migrate or any other hardships. I invite you to stop for a moment and take a positive look to the journey you have made in this year 2019. Silently also pray for all those families who are going through difficult times, asking the Holy Family to embrace them and make them experience and feel God's love close them, so that they enjoy the same virtues of the Holy Family of Bethlehem.






