
**From the Pastor's Desk****XVI SUNDAY O.T. & SOLEMNITY OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL.**

It is with relief, joy, enthusiasm, devotion, and faith that we celebrate the 128th Feast, venerating our Lady of Mount Carmel as our patroness. We know that this turbulent time we are living with the epidemic, much violence and uncertainty; we, more than ever, need to come together and be embraced by the tender caring love and protection of our Blessed Mother. We, as children, are always reassured when we are in the company of our loving mother, as such, when we are under the garment of our Lady of Mt. Carmel, we are protected and reassured. Let us treasure the spirituality of the holy mountain, the Carmel. It is known as a place of prayer, holiness, contemplation, and time with God. Eight centuries B.C. the prophet Elijah has the powerful experience of God as he defended the true God of Israel against the proselytism of the false gods of Baal. In the 13th century, thanks to the Carmelite friars, it became a sacred holy place, where a tradition claims that Mary appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a leader of the Carmelites, and gave him a scapular, telling him to promote devotion to it. It is believed that the scapular is a modified version of Mary's own garment. It symbolizes her special protection and calls to those who wear it to consecrate themselves to her in a special way. The scapular reminds us of the gospel call to prayer, sacrifice, protection and penance, a call that Mary models in a splendid way in her life. The Carmelites have seen themselves specially related to Mary and some great holy members of the religious congregation such as Saint Teresa of Avila, Saint John of the Cross and Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus just to mention a few have been recognized special graces poured out on them through the intercession of Our lady of Mt. Carmel. We, devotees of Our Lady in Melrose Park, recognize with gratitude, admiration, and devotion that the tradition that was started by the faithful devotee Emanuela De Stefano has been incarnated in many of us who have experience through the years the powerful mediation of God's graces to many of our faithful parishioners through the intercession of the Virgin Mother Mary of Mt. Carmel. I am glad to testify the deep and firm conviction and spiritual relationship of many of our faithful parishioners to our Madonna. I can witness it through their trust, love, and deep devotion they manifest to Our Lady. 



Sabemos que este tiempo turbulento que vivimos con la epidemia, mucha violencia e incertidumbre; más que nunca, nos impulsa a unirnos y dejarnos abrazar por el tierno amor y la protección de nuestra Santísima Madre. Nosotros, como niños, siempre nos sentimos tranquilos cuando estamos en compañía de nuestra amada madre, como tal, cuando estamos bajo el manto de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo, estamos protegidos y tranquilos. Atesoremos la espiritualidad del Monte Santo, el Carmelo. Es conocido como un lugar de oración, santidad, contemplación y tiempo con Dios. El escapulario nos recuerda la llamada evangélica a la oración, el sacrificio, la protección y la penitencia, elección que María modeló de manera espléndida en su vida. Los Carmelitas se han visto especialmente relacionados con María y algunos grandes santos miembros de la congregación religiosa como Santa Teresa de Ávila, San Juan de la Cruz y Santa Teresita del Niño Jesús, solo por mencionar algunos, han sido reconocidos con gracias especiales derramadas sobre ellos a través de la intercesión de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo. 




