From the Pastor's Desk

XVII SUNDAY O. T. Today's message could be summed up in psalm 145, "The hand of the Lord feeds us, he answers all our needs." Each reading shows how carefully God feeds and cares for us, in an up-close and personal fashion. Elisha fed the crowd from twenty barley loaves. Jesus blessed a few loaves and thousands were fed. Perhaps this seems far-fetched, but we read stories in the news about chefs taking the leftovers from fancy restaurants and feeding many people in a soup kitchen. As a schoolgirl, one of my favorite stories was "Stone Soup," the tale of a couple of war-weary soldiers convincing the people of a frightened and starving little country village to bring out their meager supplies and share them to make a marvelous soup to feed the town. The second reading asks us to "Consider well our call."

How do we respond to those in need around us?

MIRACLE OR MAGIC?

It can be easy to just say, "Oh yes, this is the story of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, when everybody decided to share the bits of food they had." But how much of it is really about feeding the crowds? "Jesus said to Philip, 'Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?' He said this to test him, because he knew what he was going to do." It must have been very hard to trust Jesus, especially when the disciples often didn't understand him. This year has been challenging for us, too, to trust that God will provide, and also challenging for us to ask for help. In the Rule of Saint Benedict, there is a chapter called "The assignment of impossible tasks." It says, in essence, that when your superior tells you to do something impossible, it is fine to go talk to them about it, but in the end you may still be asked to do this task. In what situations are we called to trust? When are we asked to act in faith or to do the impossible task?

HOW WILL WE KNOW WE ARE DOING THE RIGHT THING?

Miracles are seldom as obvious as the multiplication of loaves and fishes. Many years ago, I overheard a family conversation in a restaurant at the end of a long holiday weekend. At the register was one of those collection jars saying, "For just fifty cents a day you can feed a child." The little girl asked her folks about it and they explained it. She said, "I have money left from my weekend, could I put it in the jar?" The parents said yes and let her go on the adventure for herself. She came back and sat down, and they chatted some more. She said, "If fifty cents feeds a child for a day, then I was able to feed one for three days, because I had \$1.50 left from the weekend." When we follow this child's example and go beyond the minimum, when we give all we can, we know we are doing the right thing, and we have understood the test that Jesus posed to Philip so long ago. *Copyright © J. 128th FEAST OLMC CELEBRATION.



ONE LORD, ONE FAITH

Do you suppose the authors of the four Gospels were aware of today's first reading from the second book of Kings? Of course they were. The prophet Elisha fed a hundred men with twenty barley loaves in order to prove God's power. This same miracle, now multiplied by more people fed by fewer loaves, is attributed to Jesus in all four Gospels. In today's passage from John we even have the detail that the loaves were barley, reminding every pious Jew of that miracle that Elisha worked. Yet Jesus went into hiding when they wanted to make him king. It is the passage from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians that gives us the reason for this. The power of Jesus comes from God. It is not meant merely to feed us, or to provide one group with a king. There is one Lord, one faith, one God and Father of all who works through Jesus Christ and through us all.




XVII DOMINGO T.O. El mensaje de hoy podría resumirse en el salmo 145 "La mano del Señor nos alimenta, el Señor está cerca de los que lo invocan". Cada lectura muestra con qué cuidado Dios nos alimenta y cuida, de una manera cercana y personal. Eliseo alimentó a la multitud con veinte panes de cebada. Jesús bendijo unos pocos panes y alimentó a miles. Tal vez esto parezca inverosímil, pero en las noticias leemos historias de cocineros que toman lo que sobró en restaurantes de lujo y alimentan a muchas personas en un comedor comunitario. De niña, uno de mis cuentos favoritos fue Sopa de piedras, que era la historia de un par de soldados cansados por la guerra que convencen a los habitantes asustados y hambrientos de un pueblito para que saquen sus escasos alimentos y los compartan para hacer una maravillosa sopa que alimente al pueblo. La segunda lectura nos pide que

"consideremos bien nuestra llamada". ¿Cómo respondemos a las personas necesitadas que nos rodean?

¿MILAGRO O MAGIA?

Puede ser fácil decir simplemente "Oh sí, esta es la historia del milagro de la multiplicación de los panes y los peces, cuando todos decidieron compartir los pedazos de comida que tenían". Pero ¿qué tanto se trata de alimentar a las multitudes? Jesús le preguntó a Felipe en dónde podrían comprar suficiente comida para que todos comieran. Le hizo esta pregunta para ponerlo a prueba, porque sabía que era lo que iba a hacer. Debió haber sido muy difícil confiar en Jesús, especialmente cuando los discípulos a menudo no lo entendían. Este año también ha sido un reto para nosotros también, confiar que Dios proveerá, y también un reto para nosotros para pedir ayuda. En la Regla de san Benito hay un capítulo llamado "La asignación de tareas imposibles". En esencia dice que cuando el superior de la comunidad te dice que hagas algo imposible, está bien que vayas a hablar con él acerca de eso, pero al final puede que te pidan que hagas esa tarea. ¿En qué situaciones estamos llamados a confiar? ¿Cuándo se nos piden que actuemos con fe o que hagamos una tarea imposible?

¿CÓMO SABREMOS QUE ESTAMOS HACIENDO LO CORRECTO?

Los milagros rara vez son tan evidentes como la multiplicación de los panes y los peces. Hace muchos años, cuando terminaba un fin de semana festivo, por casualidad escuché una conversación familiar en un restaurante. En la caja registradora había una de esas alcancías con un letrero que decía: "Con cincuenta centavos al día puedes alimentar a un niño". Una pequeña niña les preguntó a sus padres y ellos le explicaron. Ella dijo: "Me quedó algo de mi dinero que tuve para gastar este fin de semana, ¿puedo ponerlo en la alcancía?" Los padres dijeron que sí y ella misma puso el dinero dentro de la alcancía y luego fue a sentarse a la mesa con ellos y siguieron charlando. Ella les dijo: "Si cincuenta centavos sirven para alimentar a un niño al día, entonces pude alimentar a uno por tres días, por que me quedaban \$1.50 de mi dinero". Al seguir el ejemplo de esta niña y vamos más allá de lo mínimo, cuando damos todo lo que podemos, sabemos que estamos haciendo lo correcto, y hemos comprendido la prueba que Jesús le hizo a Felipe hace mucho tiempo.

XVII DOMENICA T.O. Il messaggio delle letture odierne potrebbe essere riassunto col salmo 145: «La mano del Signore ci nutre e risponde a tutti i nostri bisogni». Ogni lettura mostra con quanta cura Dio nutre e si prende cura di noi, in modo di vicinanza e personale. Eliseo sfamò la folla con venti pani d'orzo. Gesù benedisse alcuni pani e migliaia furono nutriti. Forse questo sembra inverosimile, ma leggiamo storie nei giornali di cuochi che prendono gli avanzi di ristoranti di lusso e danno da mangiare a molte persone in una mensa dei poveri. Quando ero una studentessa, una delle mie storie preferite era "Stone Soup", la storia di una coppia di soldati stanchi della guerra che convincono la gente di un piccolo villaggio di campagna spaventato e affamato a tirare fuori le loro scarse provviste e condividerle per fare una zuppa meravigliosa per sfamare la città. La

seconda lettura ci chiede di «considerare bene la nostra vocazione e missione». Come rispondiamo a chi ha bisogno intorno a noi?

MIRACOLO O MAGIA?

Può essere facile dire semplicemente: "Oh sì, questa è la storia del miracolo della moltiplicazione dei pani e dei pesci, quando tutti decisero di condividere i pezzi di cibo che avevano". Però, quanto si tratta davvero di nutrire le folle? "Gesù disse a Filippo: 'Dove possiamo comprare cibo a sufficienza per dare da mangiare a tanta gente?' Disse questo per metterlo alla prova, perché sapeva cosa avrebbe fatto". Deve essere stato molto difficile fidarsi di Gesù, soprattutto quando i discepoli spesso non lo capivano. Quest'anno è stata una sfida anche per noi, a fidarci che Dio provvederà, e anche sforzarci di chiedere aiuto. Nella Regola di san Benedetto c'è un capitolo chiamato "L'assegnazione dei compiti impossibili". Dice, in sostanza, che quando il tuo superiore ti dice di fare qualcosa di impossibile, va bene parlarne con lui, ma alla fine ti potrebbe comunque chiedere di fare realizzare quel compito. In tali situazioni siamo, così, chiamati a fidarci? Quando ci viene chiesto di agire con fede o di compiere il compito impossibile?

COME SAPREMO CHE STIAMO FACENDO LA COSA GIUSTA?

I miracoli sono raramente così ovvi come la moltiplicazione dei pani e dei pesci. Molti anni fa, ho sentito per caso una conversazione di una famiglia in un ristorante alla fine di un lungo weekend di vacanza. Alla cassa c'era un salvadanaio di raccolta che diceva: "Per soli cinquanta centesimi al giorno puoi dare da mangiare a un bambino". La bambina le chiese ai suoi genitori, e loro le spiegarono. Disse lei: "Ho dei soldi rimasti dal mio fine settimana, potrei metterli nel salvadanaio?" I genitori dissero di sì e la lasciarono fare la buona opera. Tornò e si sedette, e conversarono ancora un po'. Affermò la bambina: "Se cinquanta centesimi danno da mangiare a un bambino per un giorno, allora sono stata in grado di nutrirne uno per tre giorni, perché mi erano rimasti \$ 1,50 dal fine settimana".
