**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:**

My dear parishioners!

Is the world going to end? Are we seeing the end of it?

This weekend's Gospel responds to it on the passage of **Mark 13, 24-32**, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away. But, regarding that Day and that Hour, no one knows when it will come, not even the angels, not even the Son, but only the Father."

We live in a moment of change, values have been changing, people have changed, and it seems it is no longer the way it used to be. Does it mean that we are about to see the end? I do not know the answer to this question ... what I do know is that **only the Father** knows the Day and the Hour. If this period is the beginning of the end, I am not afraid because as a good Catholic I am supposed to be ready to meet my Creator.

Today, we recall how at the beginning of the liturgical year the Church prepared us for the first arrival of Christ that brings the salvation to us. Two weeks before the end of the year the Church prepares us for the second coming when the last and definitive word about each one of us will be said. Before today's Gospel we might think "we have a long wait to expect", but "the time is near" (Mk 13:29). But, nevertheless, in our society it bothers us —and it is even incorrect! — to mention death. Yet, we can hardly speak of resurrection without remembering we are to die. For each one of us the end of the world starts the day we pass away when the time allotted to each one to make our choice will be over. The Gospel is always Good News and Christ God is God of Life: why such fear? Perhaps for lack of trust?

On the other hand, I am concerned about those who preach the end of time to scare people and to impose guilt into the faithful. Our God does not want us to follow Him because we are afraid, and we are invited to love Him regardless of the bad signs of self-destruction we are noticing in humanity today. I am so thankful I was invited to be the Pastor of Our Lady of Mt Carmel Parish and Shrine. Moreover, I am here to pray with the community, to coordinate enriching spiritual moments, to visit the sick, to celebrate funerals, and to establish formation programs and retreats to the whole community.

If the end is here, I will welcome it by organizing a place where God will find us celebrating the Eucharist, praying the Holy Hour, attending novenas to the Blessed Virgin Mary, serving food to the poor at the food pantry, teaching catechism to our children and teens... and I hope that will please Our Lord and Savior. My dear community, do not be afraid. Let us pray that we may enter the process proposed by our cardinal Blase Cupich and we may **Renew our Church** and become authentic missionaries disciples of Jesus Christ.

This is the mind and heart of your new Pastor. This weekend we have the privilege to welcome amongst us our Vicariate IV Bishop, Kevin Birmingham for the celebration of the installation of the new pastor. What is that about? A pastor's installation service is an important event for both the pastor and his or her congregation. It is a festive, welcoming ceremony to recognize the calling of the pastor, to acknowledge his responsibilities and duties, and to celebrate the end of the interim period, and a new chapter in a congregation's life. An installation provides an opportunity for area pastors and other church leaders to welcome the new pastor and show support. The congregation can feel the presence of a community of congregations working together. This also provides a time for the entire congregation to worship together.



DEL ESOCRITORIO DEL PARROCO:

¡Mis queridos feligreses!

¿Se va a acabar el mundo? ¿Estamos viendo el final? Este fin de semana el Evangelio responde a él en el pasaje de Marcos 13, 24-32, "El cielo y la tierra pasarán, pero mis palabras no pasarán. Pero, con respecto a ese Día y esa Hora, nadie sabe cuándo vendrá, ni siquiera los ángeles, ni siquiera el Hijo, sino solo el Padre".

Vivimos en un momento de cambio, los valores han ido cambiando, las personas han cambiado, y parece que ya no es lo que costumbraba ser. ¿Significa eso que estamos a punto de ver el final? No sé la respuesta a esta pregunta... lo que sí sé es que **sólo el Padre** conoce el Día y la Hora. Si este período es el principio del fin, no tengo miedo porque como buen católico se supone que estoy listo para encontrarme con mi Creador.

Hoy recordamos cómo, al comienzo del año litúrgico, la Iglesia nos preparó para la primera llegada de Cristo que nos trae la salvación. Dos semanas antes de fin de año la Iglesia nos prepara para la segunda venida cuando se dirá la última y definitiva palabra sobre cada uno de nosotros. Antes del Evangelio de hoy podríamos pensar que "tenemos que esperar mucho", pero "el tiempo está cerca" (Mc 13, 29). Pero, sin embargo, en nuestra sociedad nos molesta —y incluso es incorrecto!— mencionar la muerte. Sin embargo, difícilmente podemos hablar de resurrección sin recordar que vamos a morir. Para cada uno de nosotros el fin del mundo comienza el día en que fallecemos cuando el tiempo asignado a cada uno para hacer nuestra elección habrá terminado. El Evangelio es siempre una Buena Nueva y Cristo Dios es Dios de Vida: ¿por qué tanto temor? ¿Quizás por falta de confianza?

Por otro lado, me preocupan aquellos que predicen el fin de los tiempos para asustar a la gente e imponer culpas a los fieles. Nuestro Dios no quiere que lo sigamos porque tenemos miedo, pero si porque estamos invitados a amarlo independientemente de las malas señales de autodestrucción que estamos notando en la humanidad de hoy. Estoy muy agradecido de haber sido invitado a ser el Pastor de la Parroquia y Santuario de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo. Además, estoy aquí para orar con la comunidad, coordinar la liturgia, visitar a los enfermos, celebrar funerales y establecer programas de formación y retiros para toda la comunidad. Si el final está aquí, lo acogeré organizando un lugar donde Dios nos encuentre celebrando la Eucaristía, rezando la Hora Santa, asistiendo novenas a la Santísima Virgen María, sirviendo comida a los pobres en la despensa de alimentos, enseñando catecismo a nuestros niños y adolescentes ... y espero que eso agrade a Nuestro Señor y Salvador.

Mi querida comunidad, no tengan miedo. Oremos para que podamos entrar en el proceso propuesto por nuestro Cardenal Blase Cupich y podamos **renovar nuestra Iglesia** y convertirnos en auténticos discípulos misioneros de Jesucristo. Esta es la mente y el corazón de su nuevo Párroco. Este fin de semana tenemos el privilegio de dar la bienvenida entre nosotros a nuestro Obispo del Vicariato IV, Kevin Birmingham, para la celebración de la instalación del nuevo pastor. ¿De qué se trata? El servicio de instalación de un pastor es un evento importante tanto para el pastor como para su congregación. Es una ceremonia festiva y acogedora para reconocer el llamado del pastor, reconocer sus responsabilidades y deberes, y para celebrar el final del período interino y un nuevo capítulo en la vida de una congregación. Una instalación brinda una oportunidad para que los pastores del área y otros líderes de la iglesia den la bienvenida al nuevo pastor y muestren su apoyo. La congregación puede sentir la presencia de una comunidad de congregaciones que trabajan juntas. Esto también proporciona un tiempo para que toda la congregación adore junta.

Il mondo sta per finire? Stiamo assistendo alla fine di tutto questo? A tal proposito, il Vangelo di questa Domenica (Marco 13, 24-32,), risponde ad i nostri quesiti; "Il cielo e la terra passeranno, ma le mie parole non passeranno". Ma, riguardo "in quale Giorno e in quale Ora, nessuno sa' quando avverrà, negli angeli, ne il Figlio sanno in merito, **solo il Padre**".

Viviamo in una società dove tutto è in piena evoluzione, dove tutto è cambiamento, le persone, le cose, tutto!!!!!! Tutto è cambiato da un lato in bene, ma dall' altro in male, i valori sono cambiati e sembra che non sia più come una volta. Tutto ciò significa che stiamo per vedere la fine del mondo? D'altra parte, sono preoccupato per coloro che predicano la fine dei tempi per spaventare le persone e imporre colpe ai fedeli. Il nostro Dio non vuole che lo seguiamo perché abbiamo paura e siamo invitati ad amarlo indipendentemente dai cattivi segni di autodistruzione che avvertiamo nell'umanità di oggi. Sono così grato di essere stato invitato ad essere il Pastore della Parrocchia e del Santuario di Nostra Signora del Monte Carmelo.
