

Dear Parishioners!

“They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don’t know where they put him.” These are the words of Mary Magdalene after realizing that the stone of the tomb is removed, words of fear, concern, desperation, and anxiety.

Glory to God in the Highest. We have waited for 40 days to sing the glory and now we rejoice because our Lord and Savior is risen alleluia, alleluia. We have lived for months in fear, anxiety, and concern because of the war in Ukraine and the uncertainty of Covid-19. Some people are still afraid to get out of their home, others are mourning the departure of a dear family member, still others are living in a foreign country because their homes have been destroyed.

The resurrection of Jesus Christ means that He is alive, and we no longer die because of our sins. We are so accustomed to hearing that Jesus is risen and we might say “I know all about it” and miss the whole mystery of Easter. It is because of Easter that the Roman Catholic Church exists, it is on the HOLY NIGHT that Eucharist becomes the center of our liturgies and the sure hope that DEATH is not the end.

Easter is a celebration of life. And as the psalm says, “Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good, for His mercy endures forever. Let the house of Israel say, His mercy endures forever. His mercy has conquered darkness and His mercy is the sign that we celebrate life today. My dear friends, today we proclaim that poverty, war, political chaos, distrust, misunderstanding, indifference... have no power over God’s Resurrection. Jesus Christ is risen today so that the poor and those in the outskirts of society may have Hope.

Jesus Christ is risen today so that we pray for the end of abortion in America.

Jesus Christ is risen today so that people who have become refugees may find a better world and may reach the hope that their country is not offering.

Jesus Christ is risen today so our elders may hope to receive what they deserve in their retirement years: love, company, and human presence.


Jesus Christ is risen today so our veterans may hope that they have not fought a lost battle but are important for today’s freedom.


Gloria a Dios en lo alto del cielo. Hemos esperado 40 días para cantar la gloria y ahora nos regocijamos porque nuestro Señor y Salvador ha resucitado aleluya, aleluya. Hemos vivido durante meses con miedo, ansiedad y preocupación por la guerra en Ucrania y la incertidumbre del Covid-19. Algunas personas todavía tienen miedo de salir de su hogar, otras están de luto por la partida de un querido miembro de la familia, y otras viven en un país extranjero porque sus hogares han sido destruidos.

La resurrección de Jesucristo significa que Él está vivo, y ya no morimos a causa de nuestros pecados. Estamos tan acostumbrados a escuchar que Jesús ha resucitado y podríamos decir "Lo sé todo" y perder todo el misterio de la Pascua. Es debido a la Pascua que existe la Iglesia Católica Romana, es en la NOCHE SANTA que la Eucaristía se convierte en el centro de nuestras liturgias y la esperanza segura de que la MUERTE no es el final.

Jesucristo ha resucitado hoy para que nuestros veteranos puedan esperar que no hayan librado una batalla perdida, sino que sean importantes para la libertad de hoy.

Mis queridos amigos, Jesucristo ha resucitado hoy, y Él ofrece lo que este mundo no puede: vida en abundancia. Y este es el día que el Señor ha hecho, que toda la tierra se regocije.


