

Thank You

"Jesus said to them, 'Come and have breakfast'"

Today, 3rd Sunday of Easter, we contemplate another apparition of Christ Resurrected, this time after evangelist Joan's most impressive chapter twenty-first, all of it full of sacramental references, totally alive for the Christian community of that first generation, the same one that collected the evangelical testimony of the very Apostles.

After the Easter events, the Apostles seemed to go back to their usual chores, as if they had forgotten the Master had transformed them into "fishers of men." A mistake the Evangelist willingly admits when he says that — despite having tried their best — "They caught nothing that night" (Jn 21:3). It was the disciples' night. All the same, the appearance, at dawn, of the Lord completely overturned everything. Simon Peter, who had previously taken the responsibility for the unprofitable fishing, now pulls the net completely full: one hundred and fifty-three fishes is the outcome, a figure which is the addition of the numeric values of Simon (76) and of *Ikhthys* (= fish, 77). Quite significant!

And, when, under the glorified Lord's protective gaze and with his authority, the Apostles exert, with Peter's primacy — explicit in the triple avowal of his love for the Lord — their own evangelizing mission, the miracle happens: "They fish men." If out of their living environment, fish die, human beings also die if nobody brings them out of the darkness and of the asphyxia of an existence away from God and surrounded by absurdity, and take them to the light, the air and the warmth of life. Of Christ's life that He, himself, nourishes from the beach of his Glory, splendid figure of the Church sacramental life and, primarily, of the Eucharist. It is in the Eucharist the Lord gives us personally the bread and, with it, He also gives himself to us, as the presence of the fish suggests; fish, which for the first Christian community, was a symbol of Christ and, therefore a Christian symbol, too.



PRAYER TO SAINT PEREGRINE

"Jesús les dijo: 'Venid a desayunar'"

Hoy, 3er Domingo de Pascua, contemplamos otra aparición de Cristo Resucitado, esta vez después del vigésimo primer capítulo más impresionante del evangelista Juan, todo lleno de referencias sacramentales, totalmente vivo para la comunidad cristiana de esa primera generación, la misma que recogió el testimonio evangélico de los propios Apóstoles.

Después de los acontecimientos de Pascua, los Apóstoles parecían volver a sus asuntos habituales, como si hubieran olvidado que el Maestro los había convertido en "pescadores de hombres". Un error que el evangelista admite con gusto cuando dice que, aunque hizo todo lo posible, "no hicieron nada esa noche" (Jn 21, 3). Era la noche de los discípulos. Sin embargo, la aparición, al amanecer, del Señor lo volcó todo por completo. Simón Peter, que anteriormente había asumido la responsabilidad de la pesca no rentable, ahora tira de la red completamente llena: ciento cincuenta y tres peces es el resultado, una cifra que es la suma de los valores numéricos de Simón (76) y ikhthys (= peces, 77). ¡Bastante significativo!

Y cuando, bajo la mirada protectora del Señor glorificado y con su autoridad, los Apóstoles ejercen, con la primacía de Pedro -explícita en la triple declaración de su amor al Señor- su propia misión evangelizadora, tiene lugar el milagro: "los hombres peces". Si los peces mueren fuera de su entorno de vida, también lo hacen los seres humanos si nadie los saca de la oscuridad y la asfixia de una existencia lejos de Dios y rodeada de absurdo, y los lleva a la luz, el aire y el calor de la vida. De la vida de Cristo que él mismo alimenta de la playa de su Gloria, espléndida figura de la vida sacramental de la Iglesia y, en primer lugar, de la Eucaristía. Es en la Eucaristía donde el Señor nos da personalmente el pan y, con él, también se entrega a nosotros, como sugiere la presencia del pez; el pez, que para la primera comunidad cristiana era un símbolo de Cristo y, por lo tanto, también un símbolo cristiano.

"Gesù disse loro: 'Venite a fare colazione'"

Oggi, 3^a domenica di Pasqua, contempliamo un'altra apparizione di Cristo Risorto, questa volta dopo il ventunesimo capitolo più impressionante dell'evangelista Giovanna, tutto pieno di riferimenti sacramentali, totalmente vivo per la comunità cristiana di quella prima generazione, la stessa che raccolse la testimonianza evangelica degli stessi Apostoli.

Dopo gli eventi pasquali, gli Apostoli sembravano tornare alle loro solite faccende, come se avessero dimenticato che il Maestro li aveva trasformati in "pescatori di uomini". Un errore che l'evangelista ammette volentieri quando dice che - pur avendo fatto del loro meglio - «non colsero nulla quella notte» (Gv 21,3). Era la notte dei discepoli. Tuttavia, l'apparizione, all'alba, del Signore rovesciò completamente tutto. Simon Pietro, che in precedenza si era assunto la responsabilità della pesca non redditizia, ora tira la rete completamente piena: centocinquantatré pesci è il risultato, una cifra che è l'aggiunta dei valori numerici di Simone (76) e di ikhthys (=pesce, 77). Abbastanza significativo!

E quando, sotto lo sguardo protettivo del Signore glorificato e con la sua autorità, gli Apostoli esercitano, con il primato di Pietro - esplicito nella triplice dichiarazione del suo amore per il Signore - la propria missione evangelizzatrice, avviene il miracolo: "pescano gli uomini". Se fuori dal loro ambiente di vita muoiono i pesci, muoiono anche gli esseri umani se nessuno li tira fuori dalle tenebre e dall'asfissia di un'esistenza lontana da Dio e circondata dall'assurdità, e li porta alla luce, all'aria e al calore della vita. Della vita di Cristo che Egli stesso nutre dalla spiaggia della sua Gloria, splendida figura della vita sacramentale della Chiesa e, in primo luogo, dell'Eucaristia. È nell'Eucaristia che il Signore ci dona personalmente il pane e, con esso, dona se stesso anche a noi, come suggerisce la presenza del pesce; il pesce, che per la prima comunità cristiana era un simbolo di Cristo e, quindi, anche un simbolo cristiano.


