


Today, on the Ascension of our Lord, we once more remember the “mission” that we have been entrusted with: “You are **witnesses** of these things” (Lk 24:48). God's Word is still alive today: “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth” (Acts 1:8). Also today, there is a current and urgent demand for the Word of God: “**Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations**” (Mt 28:19); “He said to them, ‘Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature’” (Mk 16:15).

On this Solemnity, this commission from our Master strongly reverberates. Jesus — wrapped up in our humanity — has completed his mission in the world, left us to sit at the right hand of the Father, and sent us strength from above — the Holy Spirit.

I cannot but wonder: — Is the Lord acting through me? What are the signs attached to my testimony? And I remember the verse of the poet: “You cannot wait for God to tell you: ‘I am.’ A God that reveals his power does not make sense. You should know God blows through you from the very beginning, and if your chest burns and shows nothing, then God is working in it.”

And this must be our sign: the fire burning inside, the fire that — as with the prophet Jeremiah — cannot be stopped: *The Word of God is alive*. And one feels like saying: “All you peoples, clap your hands; shout to God with joyful cries... God has gone up with a shout; the LORD, amid trumpet blasts. Sing praise to God, sing praise; sing praise to our king, sing praise” (Ps 47:2.6-7).

His kingdom is germinating in people's hearts — in your heart — like a seed about to bear fruit: Sing, dance, for your Lord. And, if you do not know how to, place the Word in your lips until it comes down to your heart: God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, give me the spirit of wisdom and revelation so that I can get to know you.



JOHN BAPTIST SCALABRINI TO BE PROCLAIMED A SAINT

Dearly beloved,

"The Lord is good, and his love is everlasting."

It is with great joy that we share with you the news that the Holy Father, accepting the opinion of the cardinals gathered in assembly on May 17, has decreed that Blessed John Baptist Scalabrin will be venerated as a saint in the Church. The canonization ceremony will take place on a date to be established by the consistory to be convened by Pope Francis. We know how much migrants, refugees, seafarers and all people involved in human mobility are dear to the Holy Father's heart. Many times he has pointed out to the Church and society the duty to welcome them, protect them, promote their living conditions and value their contribution to common coexistence. In proclaiming John Baptist Scalabrin a saint, Pope Francis wants to indicate to the Church the model of a bishop who not only gave himself completely to the good of his people, but also extended his heart to the sisters and brothers whom life had taken far from home.

As we thank the Holy Father for this gift and rejoice that our Founder is recognized as a model to be imitated, we feel even more empowered to keep alive the charism he passed on to us and to dedicate ourselves to the service of fraternity, where people are not driven out of their country by violence and war, are not discarded because they are redundant to the system, but are appreciated and valued in their uniqueness and diversity.

Each community is invited to communicate to migrants that in Scalabrin they have a father and a patron to whom they can turn in difficulties so that he may plead the protection of God who turns his gaze of predilection on the little ones and the marginalized.

Together with the communities, let us first prepare our spirit for the great canonization event, in order to be worthy of the grace the Lord has given us and to be docile instruments towards the communion of those who are scattered.

"Al bendecirlos, se separó de ellos y fue llevado al cielo"

Hoy, en la Ascensión de nuestro Señor, recordamos una vez más la "misión" que se nos ha confiado: "Vosotros **sois testigos** de estas cosas" (Lc 24, 48). La Palabra de Dios sigue viva hoy: "Pero recibiréis poder cuando el Espíritu Santo venga sobre vosotros, y seréis mis testigos en Jerusalén, en toda Judea y Samaria, y hasta los confines de la tierra" (Hechos 1:8). También hoy hay una demanda actual y urgente de la Palabra de Dios: "Id, pues, y **haced discípulos** a todas las naciones" (Mt 28, 19); "Les dije: 'Id por todo el mundo y proclamad el evangelio a toda criatura'" (Mc 16,15).

En esta solemnidad, este encargo de nuestro Maestro repercute fuertemente. Jesús — envuelto en nuestra humanidad — ha cumplido su misión en el mundo, nos ha dejado para sentarse a la diestra del Padre y nos ha enviado fuerza desde arriba, el Espíritu Santo.

No puedo dejar de preguntarme: — ¿Está actuando el Señor a través de mí? ¿Cuáles son las señales adjuntas a mi testimonio? Y recuerdo el verso del poeta: "No puedes esperar a que Dios te diga: 'Yo soy'. Un Dios que revela su poder no tiene sentido. Debes saber que Dios sopla a través de ti desde el principio, y si tu pecho arde y no muestra nada, entonces Dios está obrando en ello".

Y esta debe ser nuestra señal: el fuego que arde en su interior, el fuego que — como con el profeta Jeremías — no se puede detener: *La Palabra de Dios está viva*. Y uno tiene ganas de decir: "Todos ustedes pueblos, aplaudan; gritar a Dios con gritos alegres... Dios ha subido con un grito; el Señor, en medio de trompetas. Canta alabanza a Dios, canta alabanza; canta alabanza a nuestro rey, canta alabanza" (Sal 47:2.6-7).

Su reino está germinando en los corazones de las personas — en tu corazón — como una semilla a punto de dar fruto: Canta, baila, para tu Señor. Y, si no sabes cómo hacerlo, coloca la Palabra en tus labios hasta que llegue a tu corazón: Dios, Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, dame el espíritu de sabiduría y revelación para que pueda conocerte.

Al agradecer al Santo Padre este don y alegrarnos de que nuestro Fundador sea reconocido como un modelo a seguir, nos sentimos aún más responsables de mantener vivo el carisma que nos transmitió y de dedicarnos al servicio de la fraternidad, donde las personas no son expulsadas por la violencia y la guerra, no son descartadas porque son inútiles para el sistema, sino apreciadas y valoradas en su singularidad y diversidad.

Se invita a cada comunidad a decir a los migrantes que en Scalabrinini tienen un padre y un patrón a quien dirigirse en los momentos de dificultad para que les interceda la protección de Dios y vuelva su mirada de predilección a los pequeños y a los marginados.

Junto con las comunidades, preparamos ante todo nuestro espíritu para el gran acontecimiento de la canonización, para que seamos dignos de la gracia que el Señor nos ha concedido y para ser instrumentos dóciles al servicio de la comunión de los que están lejos y dispersos.

Oggi, nell'Ascensione del Signore, ricordiamo ancora una volta la "missione" che ci è stata affidata: "Voi siete testimoni di queste cose" (Lc 24,48). La Parola di Dio è ancora viva oggi: "Ma riceverete potenza quando lo Spirito Santo scenderà su di voi, e sarete miei testimoni a Gerusalemme, in tutta la Giudea e la Samaria, e fino ai confini della terra" (At 1,8). Anche oggi c'è una domanda attuale e urgente della Parola di Dio: "Andate, dunque, e fate discepoli tutte le nazioni" (Mt 28,19); "Disse loro: 'Andate in tutto il mondo e annunciate il Vangelo ad ogni creatura'" (Mc 16,15).

In questa solennità, questa commissione del nostro Maestro riverbera fortemente. Gesù – avvolto nella nostra umanità – ha completato la sua missione nel mondo, ci ha lasciato per sederci alla destra del Padre e ci ha mandato la forza dall'alto: lo Spirito Santo.

Non posso fare a meno di chiedermi: — Il Signore agisce attraverso di me? Quali sono i segni allegati alla mia testimonianza? E ricordo il versetto del poeta: "Non puoi aspettare che Dio ti dica: 'Io sono'. Un Dio che rivela il suo potere non ha senso. Dovresti sapere che Dio soffia attraverso di te fin dall'inizio, e se il tuo petto brucia e non mostra nulla, allora Dio sta operando in esso".

E questo deve essere il nostro segno: il fuoco che brucia dentro, il fuoco che – come con il profeta Geremia – non può essere fermato: *la Parola di Dio è viva*. E ci si sente come dire: "Tutti voi popoli, battete le mani; gridare a Dio con grida gioiose... Dio è salito con un grido; il SIGNORE, tra gli squilli di tromba. Canta lode a Dio, canta lode; canta lode al nostro re, canta lode" (Sal 47,2-6-7).

Il suo regno sta germogliando nel cuore delle persone – nel vostro cuore – come un seme che sta per portare frutto: cantate, danzate, per il vostro Signore. E, se non sai come fare, metti la Parola nelle tue labbra fino a quando non arriva al tuo cuore: Dio, Padre di nostro Signore Gesù Cristo, dammi lo spirito di saggezza e di rivelazione in modo che io possa conoscerti.
